Included in the mailing was a summary of hours submitted by contributing contractors for the 2022-2023 plan year, and an estimate of your pension benefit at age 65. Please note that while the Normal Retirement Age is considered to be 65, many members are eligible to take an unreduced early pension benefit at age 62. 
