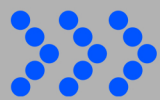
We **STRONGLY** recommend getting to the venue between **12pm — 2pm.**

## HAPPY BUS (CITY CENTRE SHUTTLE)

Our bus partner, Happy Bus, is providing a convenient and hassle-free shuttle bus service this festival weekend, running their city centre shuttle from Slessor Gardens in the city centre straight to the festival site, with departures throughout the day and night.

Whether you're heading to the festival site or returning to the city centre, the happy bus shuttle is your easy way to travel.

We recommend pre purchasing your tickets in advance to confirm your place on the bus.

## GOING TO THE FESTIVAL

Bus will depart from the bus stops in Slessor Gardens, Dundee.  
Running on a loop.

Departing every **20 minutes**  
between **12:30hrs** and **16:30hrs**

## LEAVING THE FESTIVAL

Return Shuttle Service will be departing from Camperdown  
Park at **21:00hrs, 21:30hrs, 22:00hrs, 22:30hrs**. Followed by  
a full frequent service between **23:00hrs and Midnight**.



## CAR & BUS PICK UP AND DROP OFF

Our dedicated pick up and drop off point for those travelling by car to doof in the Park is located on **Faraday Street (DD2 3QQ)**, to the East of the festival site. **Accessed from Macalpine Road end only.**

From there, it is a short walk to the festival. Please follow signs and instructions from stewards and remember that they are there to help should you require it.

We kindly request that drivers adhere to speed limits and limit dwell times.

Temporary closures of the Coupar Angus Interchange slip roads will be in place from **12:00pm–5:00pm** and from **9:00pm onwards**. Please use the next available slip road and follow diversion signage.

Access to the pick up and drop off area will be via Macalpine Road and Harrison Avenue.

Those travelling via Bus services such as Happy Bus can expect to be dropped off and picked up to the North East of the festival site. From there, you can expect a short walk to the entrance to doof in the Park.



## HAPPY BUS

If you're travelling from across Scotland to and from doof in the Park, look no further than Happy Bus for a safe and reliable journey to and from doof's Camperdown Park. Secure a ticket from one of many cities and towns across the country via the link below.

## NATIONAL BUS

There are regular bus services to Dundee via Megabus & Citylink from all main cities in Scotland.

Under-22-year-olds with a Scottish National Entitlement Card or a Young Scot National Entitlement Card are able to travel on the buses for free (this does not include the Slessor shuttle service)



## BY TRAIN

There are excellent links from across Scotland and the UK to Dundee via train.

We highly recommend taking the Festival Shuttle after arriving at either of these stations, getting you straight to the event.

## ROAD CLOSURES

Please be aware there are some road closures around the site. Camperdown Retail Park is accessible throughout the day, please follow diversions.

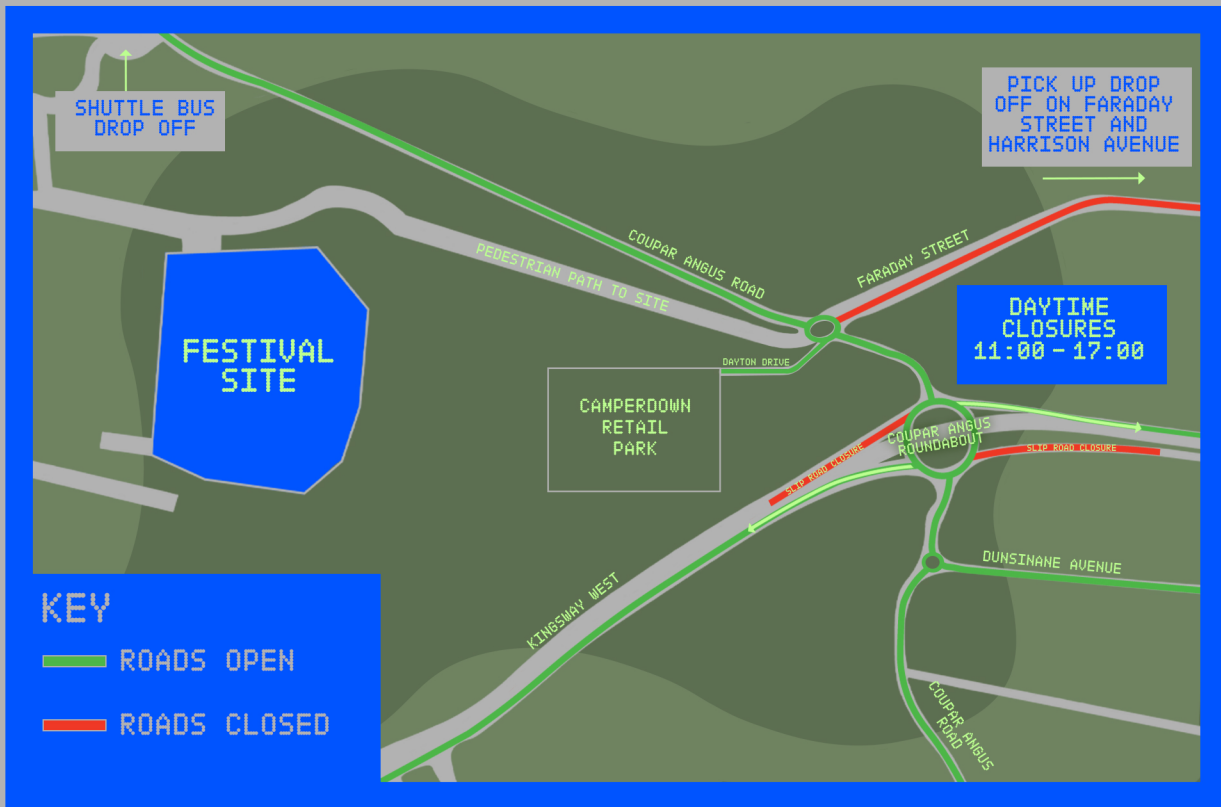

# IDENTIFICATION

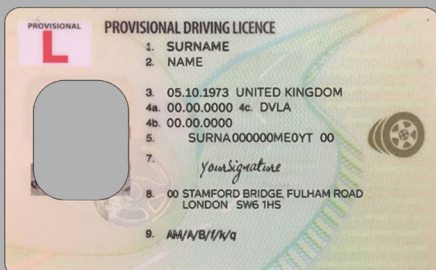
## AGE POLICY

This event is strictly for those aged **18+**. You will be asked to show photographic I.D. and any ticket holders who are unable to verify their age will not be permitted entry to the event.

We operate a Challenge 25 policy on our entrance and our bars, so please bring identification and cooperate with staff who may wish to check your age.

The only forms of ID that are accepted to ensure festival entry are:

VALID PROVISIONAL DRIVING LICENCE  
VALID FULL DRIVING LICENCE  
VALID PASSPORT



You may need an additional form of ID (e.g. bank card) to prove your identity if your ID does not appear to be valid.

Please read our prohibited items list and be warned those in possession of these items will have entry delayed or denied. This is for the protection of our audiences, artists and staff.

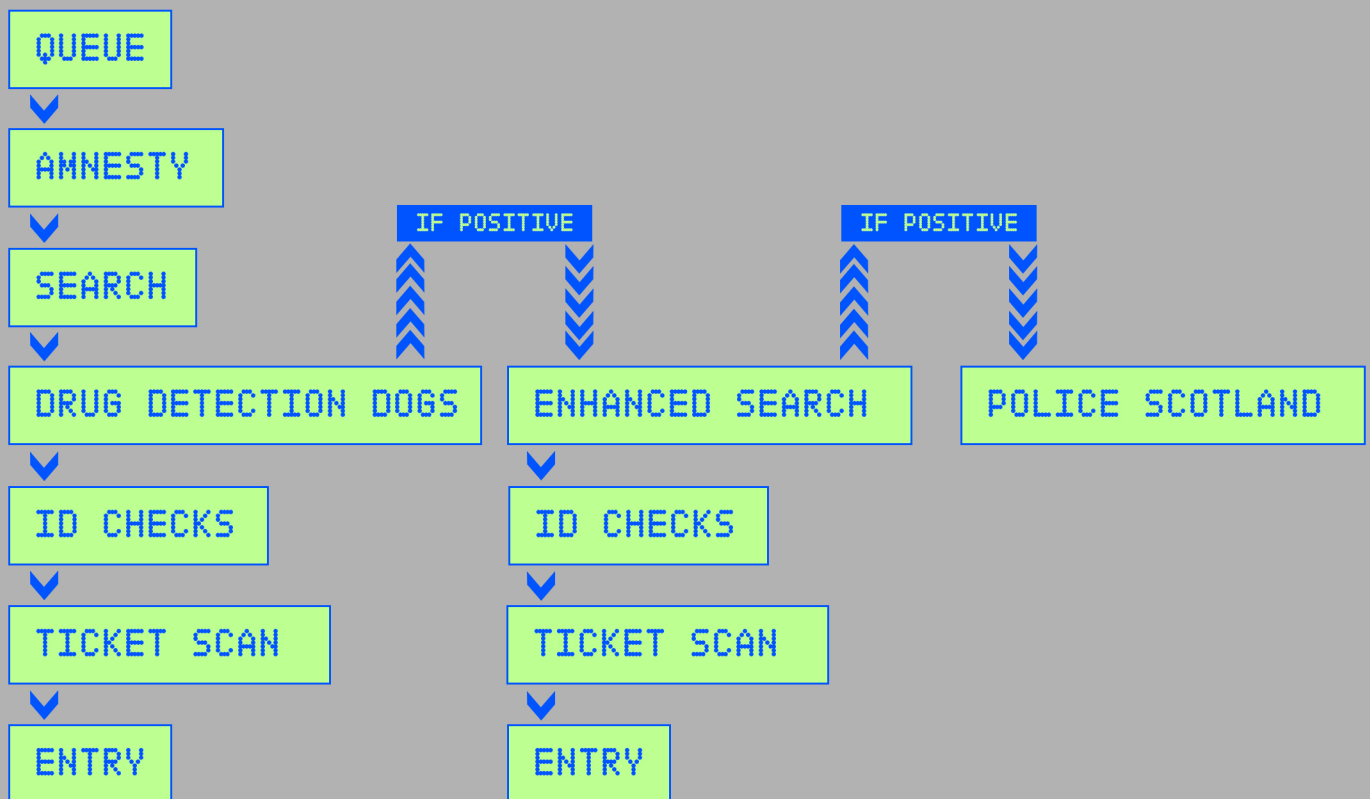

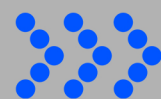
# SEARCH ON ENTRY

All customers entering the event will be subject to a robust search process delivered in partnership with Police Scotland. These measures protect you - our customers, prevent the chance of organised crime and help make doof in the Park a safe place to attend.





# PASSOUTS



Tickets and wristbands are **non-transferable** and **non-refundable**. There is no 'pass-out' system.

Once you enter the festival site for the day you **CANNOT** leave and then re-enter.



# DRUGS POLICY

We want you to have a brilliant time at doof in the Park and can't wait to see you but we want you to be safe — and be aware of our **ZERO TOLERANCE DRUGS POLICY**.

Please look after yourself and your friends and if at any point you or anyone in your party feels unwell, please attend our medical area, security stewards or event staff can assist you.

Our zero tolerance approach to drugs is supported by detection dogs and CCTV. Anyone found in possession of drugs will be passed over to our partners at Police Scotland.

Amnesty Bins offer a chance to discreetly surrender any drugs you may have before entering our event — and will be available outside our entrance and search lanes.

We reserve the right to confiscate any potentially harmful items or substances at our discretion.

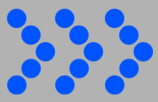

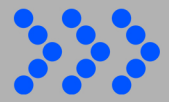

## WELLBEING & WELFARE



The doof community has a great reputation for customer behaviour and safety, we want to keep it this way. Our aim is to give every one of you a fun and amazing experience to remember, but we want you to do this safely.

Look after the wider doof community too - we're all here to have a great experience. If you see someone who looks worse for wear or needs help, do what is right and check on them, stay calm and alert one of our security or event staff if it's needed and they will be able to get in touch with our medical and welfare teams to come and support you.

## SECURITY & ASSISTANCE

There are security stewards on site throughout the festival, as well as a presence from Police Scotland. They work with us to create a safe event and are here to assist you.

If you or someone around you needs help, please don't hesitate to ask any member of staff.



## WATER POINTS

It's not a race, make sure you drink responsibly and hydrate too!

Drinking water is available at all bars on site plus there are lots of free drinking water stations throughout the event, so make sure you keep a refillable bottle with you and drink plenty of water.

## FIRST AID & MEDICAL

We have First Aid teams throughout the site on hand to help, as well as a dedicated medical centre. The teams are here to help, so if you or a friend are feeling unwell, please visit the medical team. We encourage you to be honest with the Medics and Welfare Team so that they know how best to help you.

You can find First Aid and Welfare on the **south of the site**, behind the Waltzers. Located next to that is the Chill out zone which can be used to touch base with our TLC Welfare and Accessibility team, or as a relaxing space to chill while at the event.

If you or someone else needs help, ask us! We are here to help.



## NOISE

Exposure to prolonged loud music can damage your hearing; ear plugs are available on request from Welfare or the Security team at all stages.

Feel free to ask for them, to protect your ears for years to come.

## LOST PROPERTY

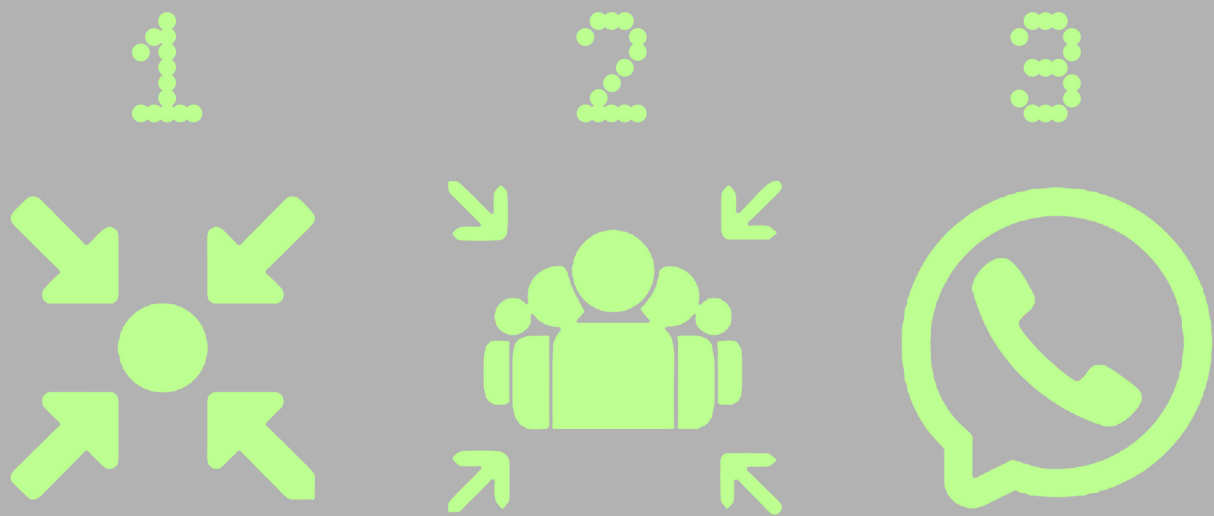
Any lost or found property should be taken to or collected from our Info Point.

Lost property not collected by the end of the event will be handed to Police Scotland a few days after the event. Please contact Police Scotland for further information.



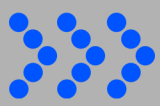
# LOOK OUT FOR EACH OTHER

It's important to stay together and look after each other. Here are some tips on staying in contact with your friends;

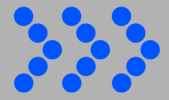


- 1. The Meeting Point:** In case you lose your friends and your phone runs out of battery, agree on an easy place to meet up at the end, before the event starts.

Accessible portaloos will be available at each toilet block onsite and additional toilets can be found in the medical and welfare area.

Our welfare team is on hand to help any customers who require assistance to get around the site, find facilities or to take a break during the event.

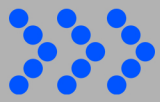

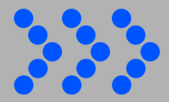
## VIP AREA

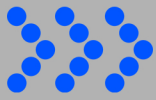

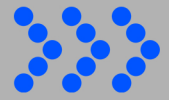
