This award is made possible by the Des Fleurs Garden Club Oxford, Ohio, with a mission to promote and create activities involving living plants and trees or gardening activities, which add to the aesthetic values of the City of Oxford. The scholarship is funded by the Des Fleurs Beautification Fund of the Greater Oxford Community Foundation.

The Des Fleurs Garden Club recognizes a Nontraditional student (18 years or over and not in high school), who is enrolled in an accredited vocational, trade, technical or academic school studying in the in the fields of Agriculture, Botany, Conservation, Floral Design, Horticulture, or Environmental Science.

Additional consideration will be given to those who work or volunteer in the areas of farming, gardening, mowing, or landscaping.

Eligibility

- Must reside in the service area of the Greater Oxford Community Foundation, which includes the City of Oxford and the townships of Hanover, Milford, Oxford and Reily
- Accepted to an accredited vocational, trade, technical, or academic school in pursuit of a degree or certificate
- Award based on a combination of financial need, work experience and volunteer work.

Amount to be Awarded

- One, one-time \$2,000 scholarship
