DETAILS OF SPONSOR REQUIREMENTS

- Must fill out the "Confirmation Sponsor Form", have it signed by the Sponsor's priest as well as have the official parish seal stamped on the form AND mailed or turned in to the church no later than November 2nd.
- The Sponsor must have received all of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Communion, and Confirmation)
- If married, the sponsor must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- He or she may not be the Candidate's mother or father
- The Sponsor must have the intentions of fulfilling the duties of a sponsor
 - Being selected as a sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation is a great honor and a special privilege. You are entrusted with the sacred duty of witnessing, promoting, and enhancing the spiritual development of another Christian.
 - It is important that the student you are sponsoring, your candidate, experience your presence and support, especially as they prepare to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Your interest and involvement in the preparation process will send a powerful message that you are working in solidarity with your candidate.
 - Pray for your candidate and his/her family regularly, ask him/her to pray for you, and be assured that the parish community of St. Andrew is keeping you in our prayers.
 - The Sponsor should be a person who is prayerful, open, dependable, loving, and comfortable sharing his or her faith with young people

These are rules set forth from the Archdiocese/ Canon law and therefore St. Andrew does not have the authority to change them.

Important Information:

- Be sure to eat dinner before arrival as we will not have dinner at Camp Friday night.
- In order for our teens to have a truly one-on-one experience with Christ that goes uninterrupted this weekend, we would ask that all those participating hand over their cell phones at the beginning of the retreat. Seeing as we will be up in the beautiful mountains of Georgia, there is no signal to connect any network anyways. Furthermore, we guarantee that the phones taken will be safely secured. This is not a punishment by any means, it is merely to help our teens free their minds of the outside world while we take genuine time with our Lord. If you have any questions on the matter, please feel free to contact Loral Leach.
- If you have not done so, please remember to bring the Medical Form and Retreat Permission slip. If your student registered for Confirmation this year, we should have a current medical form on file. No Student can attend without these items.
- If your child has any medication, please bring all supplies with you including directions in how to use them if confusing, or if another might be needed to administer on behalf of the teen if they are unable to administer it themselves (ex: Epi-Pen). These medical supplies **MUST** be with the teen at all times! No exceptions! We recommend bringing a small backpack or other container so it will never leave their side.
- We are still confirming our Sunday Mass. If we are unable to have Sunday Mass on retreat, your teen **MUST** stay at St. Andrew for the 1 PM Mass.

YEAR TWO RETREAT PACKING LIST

What to Pack:

- Drugs/ alcohol/ inappropriate materials

Because Christian service is integral to mature Christian faith, candidates for Confirmation are required to participate in service, justice, and/or outreach projects with the intention of stimulating a lifelong habit of awareness and service to others. A single project or a combination of projects, totaling a minimum of 10 hours per year are required for Confirmation.

Below are Catholic teachings that may give you some starting ideas. Some of these works have very obvious ways to do service, while others are more subtle. Have fun with these: there are tons of opportunities in LifeTeen, our parish, and our community to serve others! Loral includes upcoming opportunities in her weekly email.

DETAILS OF SPIRITUAL GROWTH REQUIREMENT

Since Confirmation is a special Sacrament where the Holy Spirit blesses us with spiritual gifts, we want to be sure that we are equipped to use these gifts for God and to build up His Holy Church beyond our Confirmation. That is just where the story begins!

Because of this, we want to encourage our teens to regularly be a part of various activities in the Church (both St. Andrew and the world-wide Church) that encourages the stretching of our spiritual muscles. Good exercise isn't doing the occasional elliptical, but constantly working out and mixing up the equipment that helps us do that. We encourage you to get involved in several different ways to make sure we are all growing spiritually and challenging ourselves to always be maturing in our love, knowledge, and fun with God.

We encourage each teen to pick at least 3 different, activities (and do them regularly!) They only need to write a reflection on one. Remember: Confirmation is just the beginning! We are called to continue our growth as Catholics: the journey never ends!

- Be a lector, usher, or altar server
- Come to Bible Studies regularly on Wednesday Nights at 7:00PM in the LifeTeen Room!!

DETAILS OF CONFIRMATION INTERVIEW REQUIREMENT

Father Juan and Father Abel would love the opportunity to speak to our teens before receiving the sacrament of confirmation.

We ask that the teen (not the parent) calls Yolanda Guevara at 770-641-9720 ext. 233 to set up an appointment with a priest. Appointments can be done any time from October to early January. Please make your appointment early! This is a busy time of year for our clergy and they want to be able to devote an appropriate amount of time to each teen.

Below is the "study guide" I suggest teens look over before Confirmation. I would encourage the same before their interview.

1. Why you chose your saint
2. Why you chose your sponsor
3. Your saint's feast day
4. A brief bio about your saint
5. Seven Sacraments- Baptism, Penance, Eucharist, Confirmation, the Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders, and Matrimony
6. Gifts of the Holy Spirit- wisdom, understanding, counsel, knowledge, fortitude, piety, fear of the Lord
7. Holy Days of Obligation- Christmas (December 25th), Immaculate Conception (December 8th), Mary, Mother of God (January 1st), Assumption of Mary (August 15th), and All Saints Day (November 1st)
8. What is Confirmation- "by the sacrament of Confirmation, [the baptized] are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Hence they are, as true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and deed" CCC 1285 (You do not need to know the exact definition word for word)

Also, the "obvious" - Why do you want to be confirmed? Why are you Catholic? Etc.
