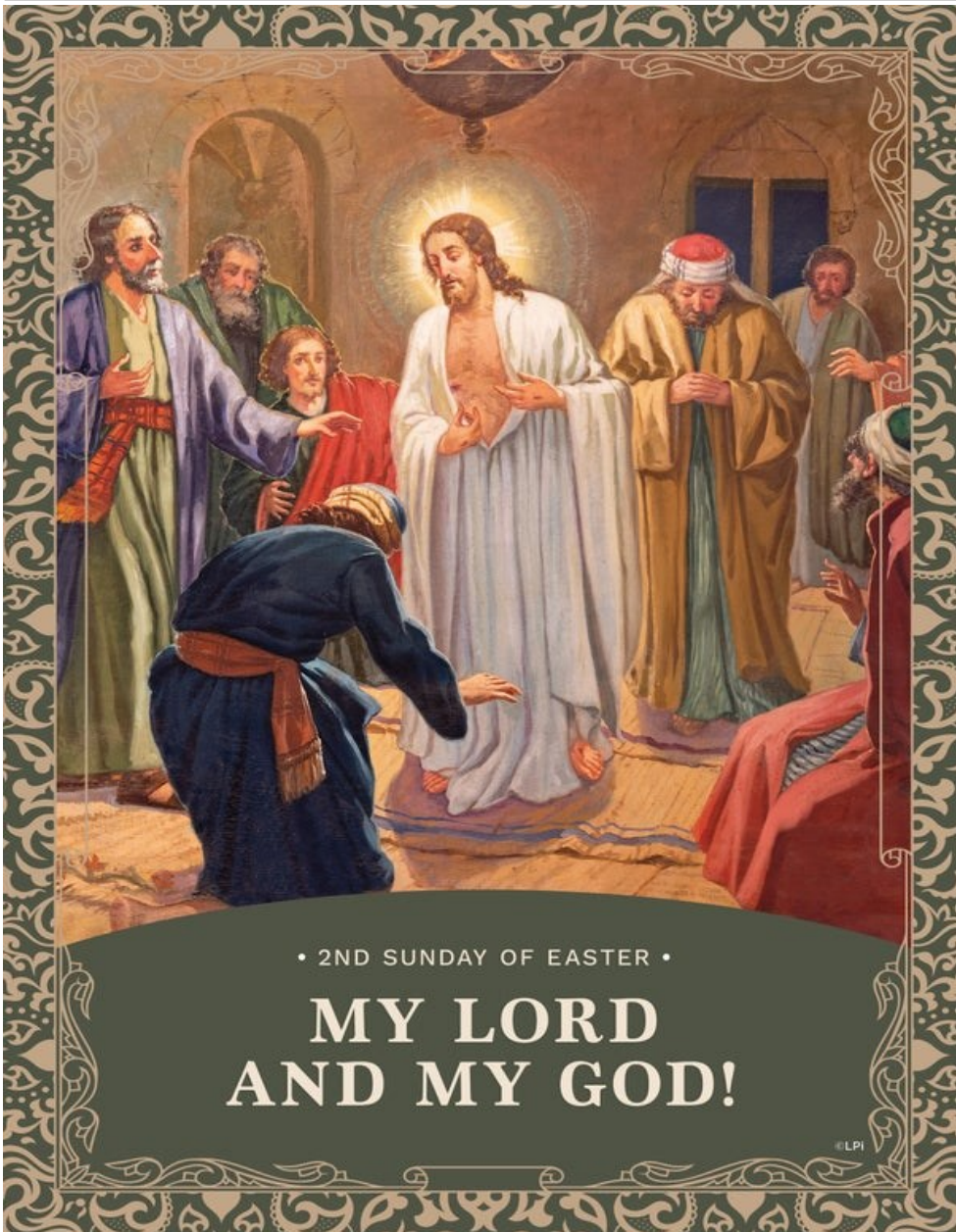

Our Mission - We, as members of Our Lady of the Desert Church, through the guidance of our Blessed Mother Mary, are a community of believers in Jesus Christ, from whom we have the mission of making His Gospel alive in our parish and in the world. By living out His Gospel, we help to shape a society with greater respect for human life, economic and environmental justice, cultural diversity, and global solidarity, so that we will build a church where everyone feels welcome and through it will find happiness and salvation.

Viviendo su evangelio, ayudamos a formar una sociedad con mayor respecto a la vida humana, a la economía y justicia al ambiente, diversidad cultural, y la solidaridad global, de modo que construyamos una iglesia donde todos se sientan bienvenidos con felicidad y salvación.

There are plenty of doubting Thomas's out there. So how will I show someone who doubts the mercy of Christ? How will I show them his wounds? How will I show them Christ suffered and died to save them? How will I show them that now every time they suffer Christ is still here suffering with them?

Are we being called to personally invite others, in everything we say and do, to experience the mercy of Christ? Yes, I say Yes. And if they ask me, this is what I will say: I know love. I have experienced love. In my heart, I have experienced, really, really experienced the fullness of love. The fullness of love is God came into the world as a human, Jesus Christ. He was innocent. But he suffered and was crucified for our sins so we could be saved. Through him our sins are forgiven. Through him we have the power to free ourselves from sin. And through him and like him we will be resurrected from the dead in the end of times. But that's not all. After Jesus was resurrected, he came back to us. He still had the wounds from his crucifixion. He took bread in his wounded hands and offered it to his disciples. He took his doubting friend's hand and offered his wounded heart. The message is loud and clear. Jesus did not come to suffer and just leave us behind in our suffering. Jesus did not come to die, and just leave us behind in our dying. Instead, Jesus transformed suffering and death for us.

For us, suffering and death are no longer punishment. Instead they have become for us a sacrifice that causes us to turn and trust completely in God. We turn to God. We pray to God. We offer our sacrifice to God for the benefit of others. We show God we still love God despite our suffering. And we don't have to do it alone. When we suffer, Christ suffers with us. When we die, Christ has his arms around us. Thanks to Jesus, it is in these moments of weakness, that we are the strongest. We are closest to God. And when we are closest to God our soul grows in holiness. It is purified and resurrected.

Today in this Second Sunday of Easter, we celebrate the Divine Mercy. We remember that the Risen Christ appeared to Sister Faustina Kowalska and He told her to paint his image with the words "Jesus, I Trust in You." I know you have all seen that painting. Have you noticed anything unusual about it? Jesus is pointing to his heart. There are two rays of divine mercy flowing from his heart. The lighter ray stands for water and our baptism in the Holy Spirit who makes us righteous before God. The red ray stands for the blood sacrifice of Jesus on the cross which brought us the forgiveness of sins and the Holy Eucharist to give life back to our souls.

Jesus promised us a plenary indulgence so that our sins will be forgiven and all temporal punishment will be completely removed. The soul will be as pure as it was on the day of your baptism. These are the requirements:

1. Go to confession 8 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday.
2. Receive communion during those 16 days.
3. Pray for the intentions of the Pope.
4. Pray the Chaplet and other devotions venerating the sacred image of divine mercy, or in the presence of the blessed sacrament pray the Our Father and the Creed, adding "Merciful Jesus I trust in you!"

So today we pray with Sister Faustina: "Jesus, I trust in you!"

Hay muchos que dudan como santo Thomas. Entonces, ¿cómo voy a mostrar la misericordia de Cristo a alguien que duda? ¿Cómo voy a mostrarles sus heridas? ¿Cómo voy a mostrarles que Cristo sufrió y murió para salvarlos? ¿Cómo voy a mostrarles que ahora cada vez que sufren, Cristo sufre con ellos?

¿Sera una llamada para nosotros, para invitar a los demás, en todo lo que decimos y hacemos, para que experimenten la divina misericordia de Cristo? Sí, digo que sí. Y si me preguntan, esto es lo que voy a decir: Yo conozco el amor. Yo he experimentado el amor. En mi corazón, realmente, realmente, he experimentado la plenitud del amor. La plenitud del amor es que Dios vino al mundo como humano, Jesucristo. Fue inocente. Pero sufrió y fue crucificado por nuestros pecados y para nuestra salvación. A través de él, nuestros pecados son perdonados. Al través de él tenemos el poder para liberarnos del pecado. Y a través de él y como él, seremos resucitados de entre los muertos al final de los tiempos. Pero eso no fue todo. Después de que Jesús resucitó, se nos regreso. Todavía tenía las heridas de su crucifixión. Tomó pan en sus manos heridas y se lo ofreció a sus discípulos. Tomó la mano de su amigo lleno de dudas, y le ofreció su corazón herido. El mensaje es fuerte y claro. Jesús no vino para sufrir y luego abandonarnos cuando sufrimos. Jesús no vino para morir y luego dejarnos morir solos. Al contrario, Jesús transformo el sufrimiento y la muerte para nosotros. Para nosotros, el sufrimiento y la muerte ya no son un castigo. Al contrario, se han convertido para nosotros en un sacrificio que nos da vuelta para confiar completamente en Dios. Nos dirigimos a Dios. Oramos a Dios. Le ofrecemos nuestro sacrificio a Dios por el beneficio de otros. Le mostramos a Dios que todavía lo amamos a pesar de nuestro sufrimiento. Y no tenemos que hacerlo solo. Cuando sufrimos, Cristo sufre con nosotros. Cuando morimos, Cristo tiene sus brazos alrededor de nosotros. Gracias a Jesús, en estos momentos de debilidad, somos lo más fuertes. Estamos más cerca a Dios. Y cuando estamos más cerca de Dios, nuestra alma crece en santidad. Se purifica y se resucita.

Hoy en este segundo domingo de Pascua, celebramos la Divina Misericordia. Recordamos que el Cristo resucitado se le apareció a la hermana Faustina Kowalska y le dijo que pinte su imagen con las palabras "Jesús, en Ti confío." Sé que todos han visto ese cuadro. ¿Has notado algo raro en esa pintura? Jesús esta apuntando a su corazón. Hay dos rayos de la divina misericordia que fluyen de su corazón. El rayo ligero significa agua y nuestro bautismo en el Espíritu Santo que nos hace justos ante Dios. El rayo rojo simboliza el sacrificio de la sangre de Jesús en la cruz que nos trajo el perdón de los pecados y la Santa Eucaristía para dar vida de nuevo a nuestras almas. Jesús nos prometió una indulgencia plenaria para que nuestros pecados sean perdonados y toda la pena temporal sea eliminada por completo. El alma será tan puro como lo fue en el día de tu bautismo. Estos son los requisitos: 1. Ve a confesión 8 días antes o después del Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. 2. Recibe la comunión durante esos 16 días. 3. Ora por las intenciones del Papa. 4. Reza la coronilla y otras devociones para venerar la sagrada imagen de la divina misericordia, o en vez de eso--en la presencia del Santísimo Sacramento reza el Padre Nuestro y el Credo, añadiendo que "Jesús Misericordioso en ti confío!" Así que hoy oramos con la Hermana Faustina: "Jesús, confío en ti!"
