Our Mission - We, as members of Our Lady of the Desert Church, through the guidance of our Blessed Mother Mary, are a community of believers in Jesus Christ, from whom we have the mission of making His Gospel alive in our parish and in the world. By living out His Gospel, we help to shape a society with greater respect for human life, economic and environmental justice, cultural diversity, and global solidarity, so that we will build a church where everyone feels welcome and through it will find happiness and salvation.

Nuestra Misión - Nosotros, como miembros de la Iglesia de Nuestra Señora del Desierto, con la dirección de Nuestra Madre María, somos una comunidad de creencia en Jesús Cristo, que tenemos la misión de hacer su evangelio vivo en nuestra parroquia y en el mundo. Viviendo su evangelio, ayudamos a formar una sociedad con mayor respecto a la vida humana, a la economía y justicia al ambiente, diversidad cultural, y la solidaridad global, de modo que construyamos una iglesia donde todos se sientan bienvenidos con felicidad y salvación.

Someone asked Jesus, "Lord, will only a few people be saved?" Jesus answered, "Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I tell you will attempt to enter but will not be strong enough." What is the narrow gate? The narrow gate is Jesus Christ. It is the gate through the cross to the resurrection. And it is very narrow. Why? Because the only way through it is through our trials, sufferings and sacrifices.

What might keep us from passing through the narrow gate? Self-love...Selfishness. Because we are weak. Our human nature is inclined toward pride. It is easy for us to believe that we are special and better than others. We can start to believe we deserve heaven more than someone who doesn't pray as much as we do, who doesn't come to church as much as we do, and who hasn't been a Catholic as long as we have. We fall in love with ourselves.

So what can we do to avoid it? Jesus told us: "For behold, some are last who will be first, and some are first who will be last." What can we do to become the last who will be first?

Look at the story of Jesus Christ. He made himself last. Though he was God he emptied himself and took the form of a slave to suffer and die for our sins (Phil. 2:5). That is the key. We have to learn to live like Jesus: to take up our cross and to live for others. It means we will die a little each day, slowly dying to our selfish interests. But we will also rise a little each day, slowly rising to live for the interests of others.

You might say, "wait a minute, this is way too difficult." But it isn't. Jesus told us we have to "strive" for it. We have to struggle and push ourselves to imitate Jesus and follow what he told us: *Be compassionate as your Father is compassionate. Do not judge and you will not be judged. Forgive 70 times 7, as your Father does. Love one another as I have loved you.* And if we push ourselves to "strive" for it, God and Jesus will give us a special power in the Holy Spirit we call grace.

Why is this important? Because in today's psalm God is telling us to "Go out to all the world and tell the Good News." It means we are being sent to bring others through the narrow gate to God. How will we do it? By the way we live our life. And by picking up the cross for our brothers and sisters and following Jesus through the narrow gate.

Alguien le preguntó a Jesús: "Señor, ¿es verdad que son pocos los que se salvan?" Jesús le respondió: "Esfuércense por entrar por la puerta, que es angosta, pues yo les aseguro que muchos tratarán de entrar y no podrán." ¿Cuál es la puerta angosta? La puerta angosta es Jesucristo. Es la puerta a través de la cruz a la resurrección. Y es muy angosta. ¿Por qué? Porque la única manera a travesarla es a través de nuestras pruebas, sufrimientos y sacrificios.

Que nos detiene en pasar por la puerta angosta? El egoísmo...el amor a sí mismo. Porque somos débiles. Nuestra naturaleza humana se inclina hacia el orgullo. Es fácil creer que somos especiales y mejor que los demás. Podemos empezar a creer que nos merecemos el cielo más que alguien que no reza tanto como nosotros, que no viene a la iglesia tanto como nosotros, y que no ha sido católico por el mismo tiempo que nosotros.

Entonces, ¿qué podemos hacer para evitarlo? Jesús nos dijo: "Pues los que ahora son los últimos, serán los primeros; y los que ahora son los primeros, serán los últimos." ¿Qué podemos hacer para ser el último que será el primero?

Mira la historia de Jesucristo. Se hizo el ultimo. A pesar de que era Dios, se despojó a sí mismo y tomó la condición de un esclavo para sufrir y morir por nuestros pecados (Fil. 2:5). Esa es la clave. Tenemos que aprender a vivir como Jesús: levantar nuestra cruz y vivir para los demás. Quiere decir que vamos a morir un poco cada día, muriendo poco a poco a nuestros intereses egoístas. Pero también vamos a resucitarnos un poco cada día, poco a poco llegando a vivir por los intereses de los demás.

Quizás dices: "Espera un minuto, esto es demasiado difícil." Pero no lo es. Jesús nos dijo que tenemos que "esforzarnos" por entrar por la puerta angosta. Tenemos que luchar y esforzarnos para imitar a Jesús y seguir lo que nos dijo: *Sean compasivos como su Padre es compasivo. No juzguen y no serán juzgados. Perdona 70 veces mas 7, como su Padre lo hace. Ámense los unos a los otros como yo los he amado.* Y si nos "esforzarnos," Dios y Jesús nos darán un poder especial en el Espíritu Santo que llamamos la gracia.

¿Por qué es tan importante? Porque en el salmo de hoy, Dios nos dice que "Vayan por todo el mundo y prediquen el Evangelio." Quiere decir que Dios nos envía para traer los demás a través de la puerta angosta a Dios. ¿Cómo vamos a hacerlo? Por la manera en que vivimos nuestra vida. Y cargando la cruz por nuestros hermanos y hermanas y siguiendo a Jesús por la puerta que es angosta.


