Life is about sharing and helping. It is about becoming humble so we can love each other. It is about putting yourself in another's place. It is about forgiving those who offend us. It is about praying for each other. It is about becoming humble so the other person is more important.

Maybe Jesus is giving us a new beatitude: Blessed are those who live for others without expecting anything back in return. The question is, can we love without expecting anything back in return?

Jesus is telling us: Yes we can do it. How? Here's the secret: the key is in Jesus' words: "Everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and everyone who humbles himself will be exalted. What does that mean? It means the way to be great in the eyes of God, (and God wants us to do this), is to follow Jesus in humility. St. Paul told us how to do it in the letter to the Philippians. "Treat others as more important than yourself" (Phil. 2:3). Jesus did it when he suffered the shame of the cross for each one of us, to save us from our sins. Jesus made us more important than himself!

To encourage us, Jesus gave us a parable. If we are invited to a wedding banquet, we should not presume to sit in a place of honor. Instead, we should sit in the lowest place. That way we won't be embarrassed when the host tells us to take a lower seat, and we will be exalted when the host tells to take a higher seat. It means all we have to do is make an effort to humble ourselves and take the lowest seat. Then Jesus will exalt us with the power of grace to do it. We just have to act like we already have the grace of humility.

You're probably wondering: why is this so important for Jesus? First of all, it's God's will. Second, it's the way to save our soul. But do we have to become humble? Yes. This is the key. Only if you and I become humble can we receive God's love and share it with others. Why? Because otherwise, our human nature is too proud. That is because of original sin. When someone gives us something, our pride takes over. Then we have an incredible need to give them something back in return. And it has to be something of an equal or greater value so everyone is even. The problem is, it doesn't work that way with God and Jesus. We need their love and grace for our salvation. But we can't possibly pay them back anything of an equal or greater value. So in order for us to be able to accept their gifts of love and grace, we have to become humble. Now that we are humble, Jesus is calling us on a mission. Now that we have been helped, we can help others. We have received the gifts of love, grace, forgiveness, and salvation from Jesus, which we know we can never pay back. We didn't deserve them. We know how that feels. Now we are being commissioned and sent into the world to be as generous as Jesus. He sends us to share the gifts we received with all the unwanted persons who do not deserve them. We know how that feels. And the beauty of it is, that it is not going to cost them anything. Just like Jesus, we aren't going to expect anything back in return.

Tal vez Jesús nos está dando una nueva bienaventuranza: Bendito sean los que vienen para los demás sin esperar nada a cambio. La pregunta es, ¿Podemos amar sin esperar nada a cambio? Jesús nos dice: Sí, podemos hacerlo. ¿Cómo? Este es el secreto: la clave está en las palabras de Jesús: "el que se engrandece a sí mismo, será humillado; y el que se humilla, será engrandecido." ¿Qué significa eso? Significa que la manera de ser grande en los ojos de Dios, (y Dios quiere que lo hagamos), es seguir a Jesús en la humildad. San Pablo nos dijo cómo hacerlo en la carta a los Filipenses. "Trata a los demás como si fueran mejores que tú" (Fil. 2:3). Jesús lo hizo cuando sufrió la vergüenza de la cruz por cada uno de nosotros, para salvarnos de nuestros pecados. Jesús nos hizo más importante que a sí mismo! Para animarnos, Jesús nos dio una parábola. Si nos invitan a un banquete de bodas, no debemos presumir a sentarnos en un lugar de honor. Por el contrario, debemos sentarnos en el lugar más bajo. De esa manera no nos va dar vergüenza cuando el que nos invito nos dice que tomemos otro asiento más bajo. Y vamos a ser exaltados cuando nos dice que tomemos un asiento mas honrado. Esto significa que todo lo que tenemos que hacer es hacer un esfuerzo para humillarnos y tomar el asiento más bajo. Entonces Jesús nos exaltará con el poder de la gracia para hacerlo. Sólo tenemos que actuar como si ya tenemos la gracia de la humildad.

Probablemente se preguntan: ¿por qué es esto tan importante para Jesús? En primer lugar, es la voluntad de Dios. En segundo lugar, es la manera de salvar nuestra alma. Pero tenemos que ser humildes? Sí. Está es la clave. Sólo si tú y yo nos hacemos humildes podemos recibir el amor de Dios y compartirllo con los demás. ¿Por qué? Porque de otros modos, nuestra naturaleza humana es demasiado orgulloso. Es por causa del pecado original. Cuando alguien nos da algo, nuestro orgullo toma cargo. Entonces tenemos una necesidad increíble para darles algo a cambio. Y tiene que ser algo con un valor igual o de mas valor, para que todos nos quedemos iguales. El problema es que no trabaja de esa manera con Dios y Jesús. Necesitamos su amor y su gracia para nuestra salvación. Pero nunca podríamos pagarles algo con un valor igual o de mas valor. Así que, para poder aceptar sus dones de amor y gracia, tenemos que hacernos humildes. Ahora que somos humildes, Jesús nos llama para una misión. Ahora que hemos sido ayudados, podemos ayudar a los demás. Hemos recibido los dones del amor, la gracia, el perdón y la salvación de Jesús, que sabemos que nunca vamos a poder pagar. No lo merecimos. Sabemos como se siente. Ahora somos encargados y mandados al mundo para ser tan generosos como Jesús. Nos envía para compartir los dones que recibimos con toda la gente que no se lo merecen. Sabemos como se siente. Y la belleza de esto es, que no les va a costar nada. Así como Jesús, no vamos a esperar nada a cambio.


