

**Our Mission** - We, as members of Our Lady of the Desert Church, through the guidance of our Blessed Mother Mary, are a community of believers in Jesus Christ, from whom we have the mission of making His Gospel alive in our parish and in the world. By living out His Gospel, we help to shape a society with greater respect for human life, economic and environmental justice, cultural diversity, and global solidarity, so that we will build a church where everyone feels welcome and through it will find happiness and salvation.

**Nuestra Misión** - Nosotros, como miembros de la Iglesia de Nuestra Señora del Desierto, con la dirección de Nuestra Madre María, somos una comunidad de creencia en Jesús Cristo, que tenemos la misión de hacer su evangelio vivo en nuestra parroquia y en el mundo. Viviendo su evangelio, ayudamos a formar una sociedad con mayor respecto a la vida humana, a la economía y justicia al ambiente, diversidad cultural, y la solidaridad global, de modo que construyamos una iglesia donde todos se sientan bienvenidos con felicidad y salvación.

Why did the disciples ask Jesus: *Lord, teach us [how] to pray?* Because they knew there was something special about the way Jesus prayed. And Jesus did not disappoint. He taught us, what to say:

When we say "Our Father," we are saying we are children of God and brothers and sisters in Christ. When we say "Hallowed be Thy name," we are saying God will be glorified in and through us. When we say "Thy Kingdom come," we are saying we will bring God's values of love, compassion, truth and justice into the world. When we say "Thy will be done," we are saying we want, what God wants.

When we say "Give us this day our daily bread," we are asking not only for food, but for the spiritual nourishment that comes from His Word, and His Body and Blood on that altar, in the Holy Eucharist. When we say "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us," we are telling God to limit His forgiveness: if we won't forgive, then don't forgive us. And, when we say "Lead us not into temptation and deliver us from evil," we are asking God to protect us from future trials and from the devil.

Jesus also gave us some practical advice: First, we must be persistent. Never give up. Like a friend who bangs on his neighbor's door for some bread, in the middle of the night (Lk 11:5-6). At first, he may resist, but if he persists, the neighbor will give him all he wants (Lk 11:7-8). The message is quite clear: if you want something from God: *Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you* (Lk 11:9). But what if God delays? That may be for our own good. Because we are perfected when we have to prove our faith and trust Him. What if our prayers go unanswered? Actually, the answer may be "no." It may be that what we are asking for, is bad for us. Or else God wants to grant us something far better.

Second, we must pray with a child-like trust in God. Like Jesus prayed "Abba" father. We should pray the same way. Because, if human parents who are inclined to sin, can be generous to their children, how much more will Our Father in heaven who is perfect love, be generous and give us what we ask for (Lk 11:13).

By the way, the greatest prayer Jesus gave us is not only the Lord's prayer. It is also the Holy Mass. Because in this mass we are going to pray everything Jesus taught us to pray:

We will join with Jesus to pray to Our Father in heaven. We will hallow and honor the Father's name. We will do the Father's will as we celebrate this mass in memory of Him. We will glorify the Father in and through us when we offer up our sacrifice with Jesus' sacrifice on that cross for the salvation of the world.

We asked God to forgive us our sins at the beginning of mass. And our venial sins will be forgiven when we consume the consecrated host. We will be reconciled with the sign of peace. And, God will nourish us with our daily bread from heaven in His Word and in the Holy Eucharist. That will be our strength. God will be our strength for our battle against temptation and the devil.

¿Por qué los discípulos le preguntaron a Jesús: *Señor, enséñanos a orar?* Porque sabían que había algo especial en la forma en que Jesús oraba. Y, Jesús no decepcionó. Él nos enseñó, qué decir:

Cuando decimos "Padre nuestro", estamos diciendo que somos hijos de Dios y hermanos y hermanas en Cristo. Cuando decimos "Santificado sea tu nombre", estamos diciendo que Dios será glorificado en ya través de nosotros. Cuando decimos "Venga a nosotros tu Reino", estamos diciendo que traeremos los valores de Dios--de amor, compasión, verdad y justicia--al mundo. Cuando decimos "Hágase tu voluntad", estamos diciendo que queremos, lo que Dios quiere.

Cuando decimos "Danos hoy nuestro pan de cada día", estamos pidiendo no solo el alimento, sino el alimento espiritual que proviene de Su Palabra, y Su Cuerpo y Sangre en ese altar, en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Cuando decimos "Perdona nuestras ofensas como también nosotros perdonamos a los que nos ofenden", le estamos diciendo a Dios que limite Su perdón: si no perdonamos, entonces no nos perdonará. Y, cuando decimos "No nos dejes caer en la tentación y líbranos del mal", estamos pidiendo a Dios que nos proteja de pruebas futuras y del diablo.

Jesús también nos dio algunos consejos prácticos: Primero, debemos ser persistentes. Nunca rendirnos. Como un amigo que llama a la puerta de su vecino para pedir pan, en medio de la noche (Lc 11, 5-6). Al principio puede resistir, pero si persiste, el vecino le dará todo lo que quiera (Lc 11, 7-8). El mensaje es bastante claro: si quieren algo de Dios: Pidan y se les dará, busquen y encontrarán, toquen y se les abrirá (Lc 11,9).

Pero, ¿que si Dios se demora? Eso puede ser por nuestro propio bien. Porque somos perfeccionados cuando tenemos que probar nuestra fe y confiar en Él. ¿Qué si Dios no contesta nuestras oraciones? En realidad, puede ser que la respuesta es "no". Puede ser que lo que estamos pidiendo, sea malo para nosotros. O bien Dios quiere concedernos algo mucho mejor.

Segundo, debemos orar con la confianza de un niño en Dios. Como Jesús oró "Abba" padre. Deberíamos orar de la misma manera. Porque si los padres humanos, inclinados al pecado, pueden ser generosos con sus hijos, cuánto más nuestro Padre celestial, quien es el amor perfecto, será generoso y nos dará lo que le pidamos (Lc 11,13).

Sabes que la oración más grande que Jesús nos dio no es solo el Padre Nuestro. Es también la Santa Misa. Porque en esta misa vamos a rezar todo lo que Jesús nos enseñó a rezar:

Nos uniremos a Jesús para orar a Nuestro Padre que está en los cielos. Santificaremos y honraremos el nombre del Padre. Haremos la voluntad del Padre mientras celebramos esta misa en memoria de Él. Glorificaremos al Padre en ya través de nosotros cuando ofrezcamos nuestro sacrificio con el sacrificio de Jesús en esa cruz por la salvación del mundo.

Le pedimos a Dios que nos perdone nuestros pecados al comienzo de la misa. Y nuestros pecados veniales serán perdonados cuando consumamos la hostia consagrada. Seremos reconciliados con la señal de la paz. Y, Dios nos alimentará con nuestro pan diario del cielo en Su Palabra y en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Esa será nuestra fuerza. Dios será nuestra fortaleza para nuestra batalla contra la tentación y el diablo.


