What does it mean to be meek? To be meek is to be patient and gentle. It does not mean being a coward. But it does mean forgiving and not seeking vengeance. What does it mean to be humble? To be humble means dying to our self interests and rising up to a new life of living for others.

That is the purpose of life. And that was the way Jesus Christ lived his life and died on the cross for us. On the cross Jesus endured his passion with patience and without resentment. Jesus became meek and humble, offering his life as a sacrifice of love to God for us.

What does that mean for us? It means if we really want it, when we come up to receive Holy Communion, Jesus Christ is going to come inside of us. And by the power of grace our heart will be transformed into the meek and humble heart of Jesus Christ. And with a meek and humble heart we are going to receive something very powerful.

We are going to receive the powerful wisdom of God. It isn't the kind of wisdom you can learn from books or by going to college. This is a wisdom that comes directly from God. Some call it divine intuition. But it is more like just knowing and nothing more-- just knowing God's truth in our heart.

And we can get it only one way—by living it—by making a sacrifice of our lives to serve others. Is that really necessary? Yes. Because it is a wisdom that comes only into a heart that is pure, meek and humble and without pride—like the heart of a child. And to have the heart of a child we need to live to serve others. Then like Jesus said: "whoever humbles himself will be exalted" (Mt. 23:12). How will we be exalted?

We will be exalted as children of God when we live our life in the spirit of Jesus Christ. St. Paul talked about it in his letter to the Romans. He compared life in the Spirit with life in the flesh. Both lives are heading in opposite directions. Life in the flesh leads us to death and eternal damnation. Life in the spirit will exalt us because it leads us to everlasting life in the Kingdom of God. Do you know the difference?

To live in the flesh, is to live in sin. It is a life of self-centeredness and selfishness, and the pursuit of the wealth and the temporary pleasures of this world that are lies, and a rejection of God. The works of the flesh are: "fornication, impurity, licentiousness, idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, anger, quarrels, dissensions, factions, envy, drunkenness, carousing, and things like that (Gal. 5:16-21).

In contrast, to live in the spirit, is what we really want. Living in the spirit is to live with Jesus Christ inside of us. The works of the spirit are love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Gal. 5:22-23). We can live this life in the spirit by making ourselves meek and humble, and vulnerable like a child by opening our hearts to love others, the way Jesus loves us!

¿Qué significa ser sufrido? Ser sufrido es ser paciente y manso. Eso no quiere decir, ser un cobarde. Pero sí quiere decir perdonar y no buscar la venganza. ¿Qué significa ser humilde? Ser humilde significa morir a nuestros propios intereses y levantarnos a una nueva vida de vivir por los demás.

Ese es el propósito de la vida. Y es la misma manera en que Jesucristo vivió su vida y murió en la cruz por nosotros. En la cruz, Jesús sufrió su pasión con paciencia y sin resentimiento. Jesús se hizo manso y humilde ofreciendo su vida como sacrificio de amor por Dios para nosotros.

¿Qué significa eso para nosotros? Significa que, si de veras lo queremos, cuando venimos a recibir la Sagrada Comunión, Jesucristo va a venir dentro de nosotros. Y con el poder de la gracia nuestro corazón se va a convertir en el corazón sufrido y humilde de Jesucristo. Y con un corazón sufrido y humilde vamos a recibir algo muy poderoso.

Lo que vamos a recibir es la poderosa sabiduría de Dios. No es la sabiduría que se aprende en los libros o en atender al colegio. Sino se trata de una sabiduría que viene directamente de Dios. Algunos lo llaman la divina intuición. Pero es más como solo saber y nada más—solo saber en nuestro corazón, la verdad de Dios.

Y podemos conseguirlo de solo una manera -viviéndolo-haciendo un sacrificio de nuestras vidas para servir a los demás. ¿De veras es necesario? Si. Porque es una sabiduría que solo viene dentro de un corazón que es puro, manso y humilde y sin orgullo-como el corazón de un niño.

Y para tener el corazón de un niño tenemos que vivir para servir a los demás. Entonces como dijo Jesús: "el que se rebaja, será exaltado" (Mt. 23:12). ¿Cómo vamos a ser exaltados?

Vamos a ser exaltados como hijos de Dios cuando vivimos nuestra vida en el espíritu de Jesucristo. San Pablo hablo de ello en su carta a los Romanos. Comparó la vida en el Espíritu con la vida en la carne. Ambas vidas van en direcciones opuestas. La vida en la carne, nos trae a la muerte y la condenación eterna. La vida en el espíritu nos exaltará porque nos lleva a la vida eterna en el Reino de Dios. ¿Saben la diferencia? Vivir en la carne, es vivir en el pecado. Es una vida de egoísmo en busca de la riqueza y los placeres temporales de este mundo que son puras mentiras, y el rechazo de Dios. Las obras de la carne son: "fornicación, impurezas, libertinaje, idolatría, hechicerías, enemistades, pleitos, celos, iras, rencillas, disensiones, herejías, envidias, borracheras, orgías, y cosas semejantes (Gálatas 5:16-21 )

Por el contrario, vivir en el espíritu es lo que de veras queremos. Vivir en el espíritu es vivir con Jesucristo dentro de nosotros. Las obras del espíritu son: caridad, alegría, paz, comprensión de los demás, generosidad, bondad, fidelidad, mansedumbre y dominio de sí mismo (Gálatas 5:22-23).

Podemos vivir la vida en el espíritu si nos hacemos mansos y humildes, y vulnerables como un niño abriendo nuestros corazones para amar a los demás, como Jesús nos ama a nosotros!
