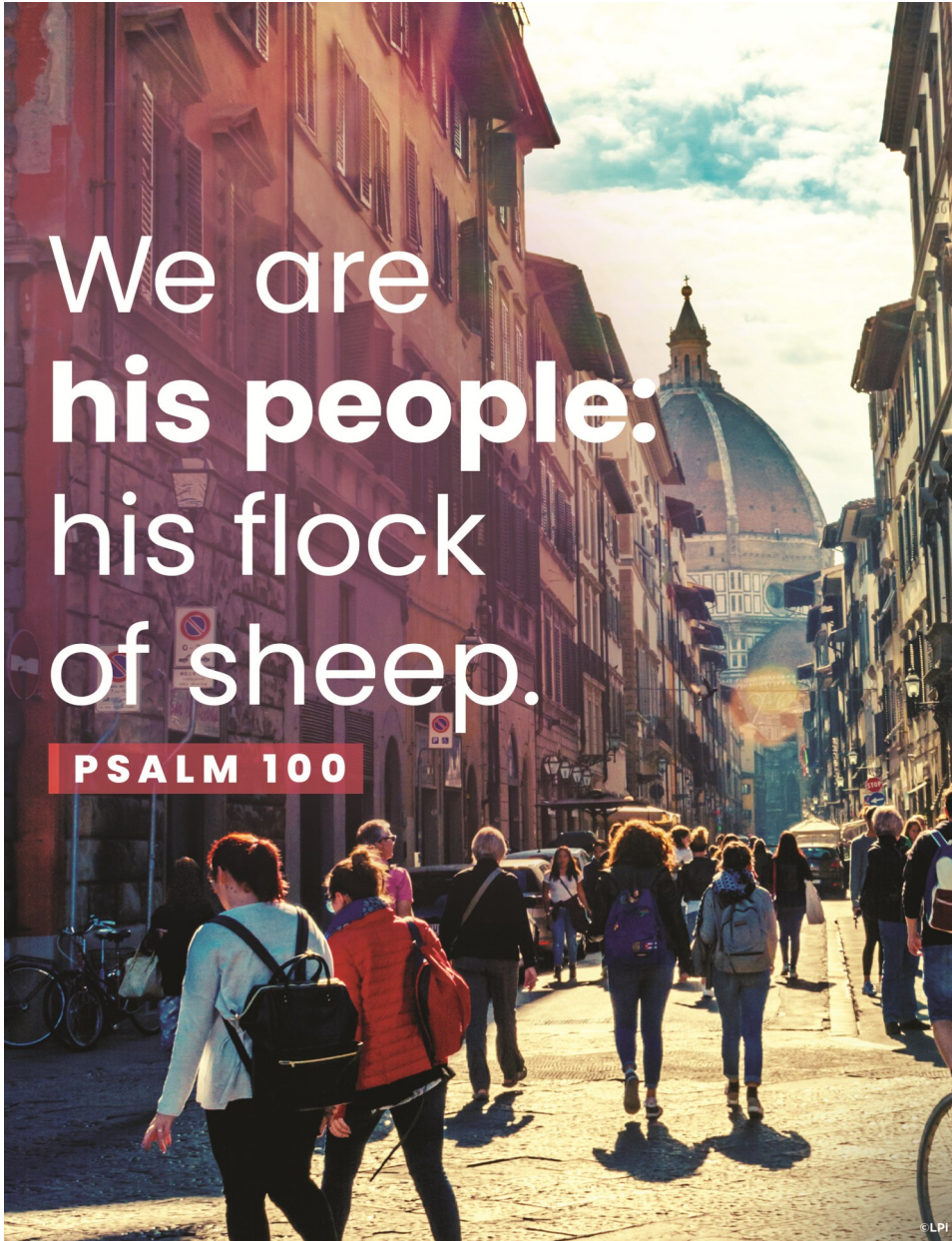

Our Mission - We, as members of Our Lady of the Desert Church, through the guidance of our Blessed Mother Mary, are a community of believers in Jesus Christ, from whom we have the mission of making His Gospel alive in our parish and in the world. By living out His Gospel, we help to shape a society with greater respect for human life, economic and environmental justice, cultural diversity, and global solidarity, so that we will build a church where everyone feels welcome and through it will find happiness and salvation.

Nuestra Misión - Nosotros, como miembros de la Iglesia de Nuestra Señora del Desierto, con la dirección de Nuestra Madre María, somos una comunidad de creencia en Jesús Cristo, que tenemos la misión de hacer su evangelio vivo en nuestra parroquia y en el mundo. Viviendo su evangelio, ayudamos a formar una sociedad con mayor respecto a la vida humana, a la economía y justicia al ambiente, diversidad cultural, y la solidaridad global, de modo que construyamos una iglesia donde todos se sientan bienvenidos con felicidad y salvación.

Do you know what line should really touch us in today's gospel? "At the sight of the crowds, [Jesus'] heart was moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd." Their religious leaders have abandoned them because they look after their own interests instead of truly caring for the people. Jesus is the Good Shepherd and Jesus is our model because His compassion for the people is more powerful than anything else. And it shows us that with Jesus...teaching, and doing, and compassion are always connected. Because wherever Jesus traveled, he was always teaching, proclaiming, and healing—with compassion. That kind of compassion...means seeing through the eyes and the heart of the other person. Jesus can see into their hearts. Jesus knows the people are suffering and lost because their own religious leaders excluded them and condemned them. They taught them that God was punishing them for their sins with poverty and sickness!

Do you have that kind of compassion? Jesus is asking you for it. "The Harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest." He isn't talking only about priests and nuns. Jesus is talking about you. You are that laborer. And He is asking you to pray to God—the master of the harvest—to send you—full of His power and grace—for his harvest. That is God's dream...for you...in your heart. Jesus cannot do it alone. God wants you to help God and Jesus bring His sheep into His kingdom. Do you remember the great commission? The Risen Christ said to you "As the Father has sent me, so I send you" (Jn 20:21). The Risen Christ said to you "Go therefore and make disciples...teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age" (Mt 28:19-20).

How are you going to do that? Just remember this: wherever you see someone in need, physically or spiritually, that is where God is calling you. And yes, that applies to strangers and enemies. And yes, that applies whether you are too young or too old. If you see someone suffering trials and difficulties, offer them spiritual guidance—share your faith, be present to them, listen to them, hug them, give them hope in the resurrection, and help them in any way you can to heal their emotional wounds. Stay focused on your model—the tireless Jesus Christ.

Always on the move, teaching and healing anyone in need. His every breath was to serve anyone in need. He was always placing the needs of others before His own. Now that you put His body and His blood into your body and your blood—that tireless and compassionate Jesus is living inside of you. Like He said, I am with you always, to the end of the age" (Mt 28:19-20). You will never be alone. So let us pray for Jesus to send out laborers for the harvest...because the first ones He will send...

will be us.

¿Sabes qué frase del evangelio de hoy debería conmovernos profundamente? «Al ver la gente, sintió compasión de ellos, porque estaban cansados y desorientados como ovejas sin pastor». Sus líderes religiosos los habían abandonado porque velaban por sus propios intereses en lugar de preocuparse verdaderamente por el pueblo.

Jesús es el Buen Pastor y nuestro modelo, porque su compasión por la gente es más poderosa que cualquier otra cosa. Y nos muestra que con Jesús... enseñar, actuar y la compasión siempre están conectados. Porque dondequiera que Jesús iba, siempre estaba enseñando, proclamando y sanando, con compasión.

Ese tipo de compasión... significa ver a través de los ojos y el corazón del otro. Jesús puede ver en sus corazones. Jesús sabe que la gente sufre y está perdida porque sus propios líderes religiosos los excluyeron y condenaron. ¡Les enseñaron que Dios los castigaba por sus pecados con pobreza y enfermedad!

¿Tienes esa clase de compasión? Jesús te la pide. «La cosecha es abundante, pero los obreros son pocos. Rueguen por tanto al dueño de la cosecha que envíe obreros a recogerla». Él no está hablando solo de sacerdotes y religiosas. Jesús está hablando de ti. Tú eres ese obrero. Y Él te pide que ores a Dios —el dueño de la cosecha— para que te envíe—lleno de su poder y gracia, para su cosecha. Ese es el sueño de Dios... para ti... en tu corazón. Jesús no puede hacerlo solo. Dios quiere que tú ayudes a Dios y a Jesús a llevar a sus ovejas a su Reino.

¿Recuerdas la Gran Comisión? Cristo Resucitado te dijo: «Como el Padre me envió, yo también los envío a ustedes» (Jn 20, 21). Cristo Resucitado te dijo: «Vayan y hagan discípulos...enseñándoles a poner por obra todo lo que les he mandado. Y sepan que yo estoy con ustedes todos los días hasta el final de los tiempos» (Mt 28, 19-20).

¿Cómo vas a hacerlo? Solo recuerda esto: dondequiera que veas a alguien necesitado, física o espiritualmente, ahí es donde Dios te llama. Y sí, eso se aplica a desconocidos y a enemigos. Y sí, eso se aplica tanto si eres muy joven como si eres muy mayor. Si ves a alguien sufriendo pruebas y dificultades, ofréceles guía espiritual: comparte tu fe, acompáñalos, escúchalos, abrázalos, dales esperanza en la resurrección y ayúdalos en todo lo que puedas a sanar sus heridas emocionales.

Mantén la mirada fija en tu modelo: el incansable Jesucristo. Siempre en movimiento, enseñando y sanando a todo aquel que lo necesitaba. Cada una de sus respiraciones estaba dedicada a servir a los necesitados. Siempre antepone las necesidades de los demás a las suyas propias. Ahora que has acogido su cuerpo y su sangre en tu propio cuerpo y sangre, ese Jesús incansable y compasivo vive dentro de ti. Como Él dijo: «Yo estoy con ustedes todos los días hasta el final de los tiempos» (Mt 28, 19-20). Nunca estarás solo.

Así pues, oremos para que Jesús envíe obreros a recoger la cosecha... porque los primeros a quienes enviará... seremos nosotros.

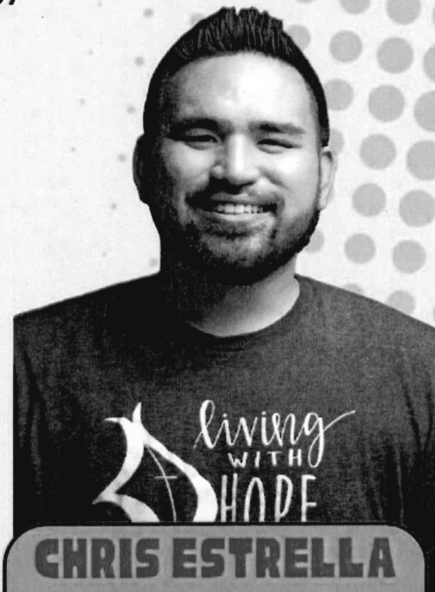

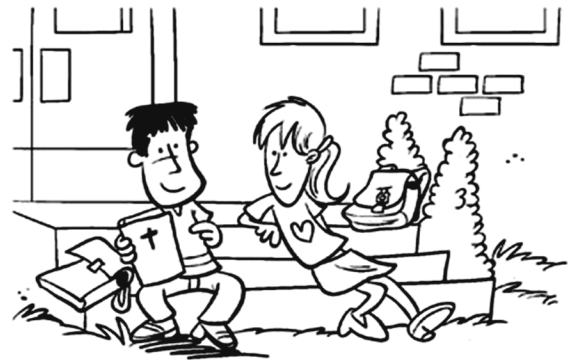
