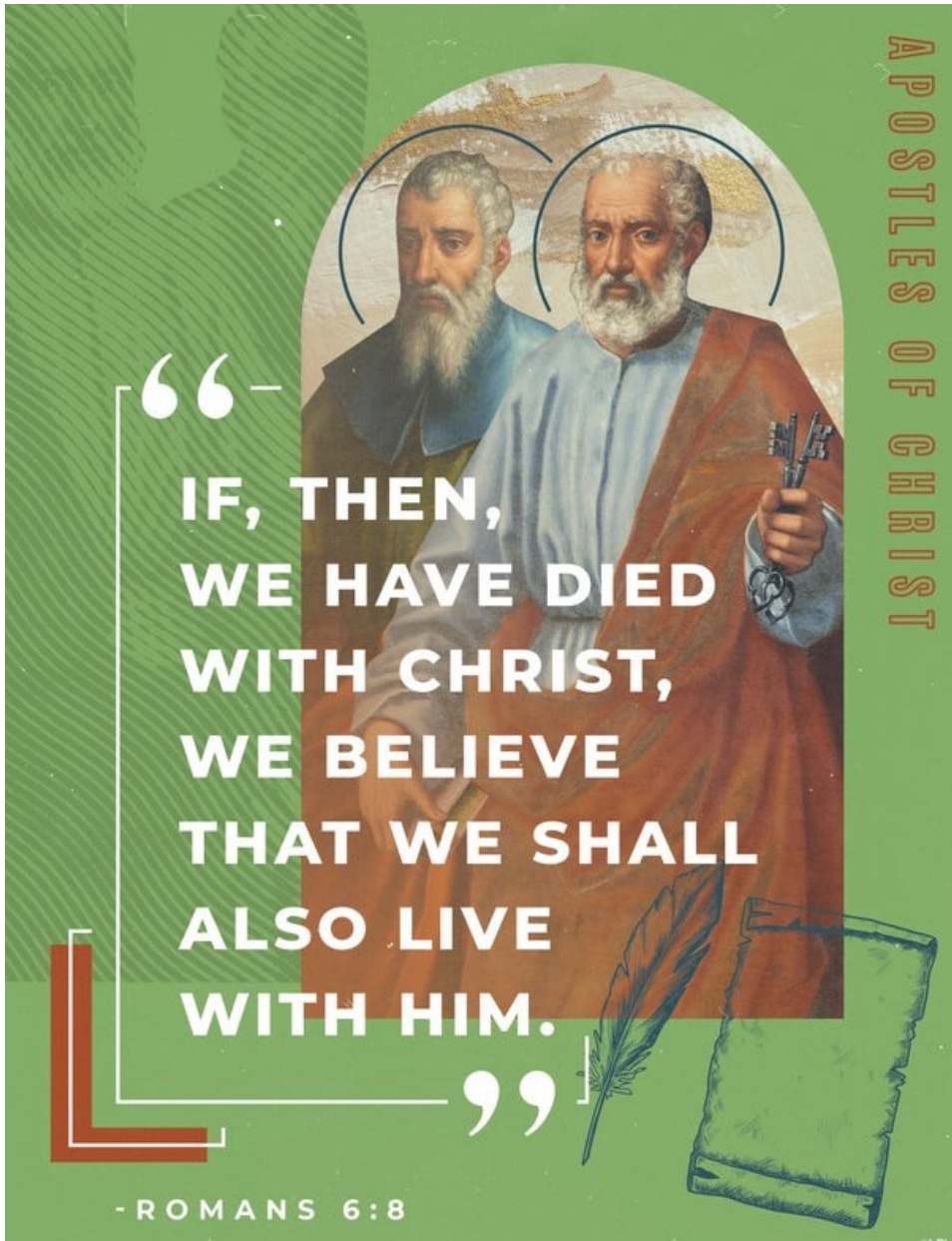

Our Mission - We, as members of Our Lady of the Desert Church, through the guidance of our Blessed Mother Mary, are a community of believers in Jesus Christ, from whom we have the mission of making His Gospel alive in our parish and in the world. By living out His Gospel, we help to shape a society with greater respect for human life, economic and environmental justice, cultural diversity, and global solidarity, so that we will build a church where everyone feels welcome and through it will find happiness and salvation.

Nuestra Misión - Nosotros, como miembros de la Iglesia de Nuestra Señora del Desierto, con la dirección de Nuestra Madre María, somos una comunidad de creencia en Jesús Cristo, que tenemos la misión de hacer su evangelio vivo en nuestra parroquia y en el mundo. Viviendo su evangelio, ayudamos a formar una sociedad con mayor respecto a la vida humana, a la economía y justicia al ambiente, diversidad cultural, y la solidaridad global, de modo que construyamos una iglesia donde todos se sientan bienvenidos con felicidad y salvación.

Jesus is sending us on a mission, like the 12 apostles, to proclaim the Good news and do what He did. And Jesus proclaimed the Good News by healing people and driving out demons. Are you ready? Then hear this. You will be opposed. Why? I suppose people will think you are trying to tell them how to live. I suppose people will think you are "implying" the way they live is wrong. That is why Jesus says "Be not afraid." Sound familiar? That is the first thing St. John Paul II said, on the balcony when he was elected pope.

Be not afraid of anyone who can hurt you physically or emotionally, or even kill you. But be very afraid of devils and demons who can tempt you to destroy your soul and rob you of eternal life. The best way to do that is to stand up for Jesus. Why? Because "Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father. But whoever denies me before others, I will deny before my heavenly Father." Stand up for Jesus. Take a risk and trust in God. If you don't believe me, look at the birds in the trees. God your Father watches over each one of them. Will not God watch over you more—you who were made in his own image?

So be not afraid. If you and I have total trust in God and in Jesus Christ...guess what? Everything is possible. We can do anything. You and I will be able to proclaim the Good News. You and I will be able to drive out demons and heal the sick in Jesus' name (Mk 16:17-18). But keep this in mind ...if someone really is possessed by a demon, we need to call an exorcist.

But if a person is possessed by the demons of pornography, alcohol & drugs; the demons of homelessness, poverty and injustice; and the demons of illness, depression and incarceration...we can do something about it. We can pray for deliverance and healing. And Jesus will act in us and through us to drive out those demons.

We can pray the Our Father and the Rosary. Call down the power of almighty God! Call down the power of almighty Jesus Christ! And call down the power of our Mother the almighty Blessed Virgin Mary! They call down her power in every exorcism. She is the mediatrix...the sender of almighty God's power of grace. God has declared her the archenemy of the devil. Her offspring will crush the serpent (Gen 1:3-15) and she herself will defeat the dragon (Rev 12).

We should also pray the litany of saints. The favorite saints for exorcists are St Padre Pio, St. Catherine, and St. John Paul II. And we should pray for help from the angels, especially the archangels: St. Michael, St. Gabriel and St. Rafael. So be not afraid. You have all the power of almighty God. Proclaim the Good News, heal the sick and drive out their demons. In the name of the Father, the Son, the Holy Spirit, our Mother the Blessed Virgin Mary, and all the angels and saints.

Jesús nos envía en una misión, como los doce apóstoles, para proclamar la Buena Nueva y hacer lo que El hizo. Y Jesús proclamó la Buena Nueva curando a la gente y expulsando demonios. ¿Estás listo? Entonces escucha esto. Vas a ser opuesto. ¿Por qué? Supongo que la gente pensará que estás tratando de decirles cómo vivir. Supongo que la gente pensará que estas "insinuando" que su manera de vivir no es correcta. Por eso Jesús dice: "No tengas miedo." ¿Te suena familiar? Es lo primero que dijo san Juan Pablo II en el balcón cuando fue elegido papa. No tengas miedo de cualquiera que pueda hacerte daño físicamente o emocionalmente, o hasta matarte. Pero que tengas mucho miedo de los diablos y demonios que pueden tentarte a destruir tu alma y robarte de la vida eterna. La mejor manera de hacer eso, es defender a Jesús. ¿Por qué? Porque "A quien me reconozca delante de los hombres, yo también lo reconoceré ante mi padre, que está en los cielos; pero al que me niegue delante de los hombres, yo también lo negare ante mi padre, que está en los cielos."

Defiende a Jesús. Arriégate y confía en Dios. Si no me crees, mira los pájaros en los árboles. Dios tu Padre vela por cada uno de ellos. ¿Acaso Dios no cuidará de ti todavía más--tú que estas hecho en su propia imagen? Así que no tengas miedo. Si tu y yo tenemos confianza total en Dios y en Jesucristo ...¿sabes qué? Todo es posible. Podemos hacer todo. Tú y yo podremos proclamar la Buena Nueva. Tú y yo podremos expulsar a los demonios y sanar a los enfermos en el nombre de Jesús (Mc 16, 17-18). Pero toma en cuenta...que si alguien de veras está poseído por un demonio, hay que llamar a un exorcista.

Pero si una persona está poseída por los demonios de la pornografía, el alcohol y las drogas; los demonios de la falta de hogar, la pobreza y la injusticia; Y los demonios de la enfermedad, la depresión y la cárcel... podemos hacer algo sobre eso. Podemos orar por la liberación y la curación. Y Jesús actuará a través de nosotros para expulsar a esos demonios.

Podemos orar el Padre Nuestro y el Rosario. ¡Llama al poder de Dios todopoderoso. Llama al poder de Jesucristo todopoderoso! Llama al poder de nuestra Madre la Virgen María todopoderosa! Ellos llaman a su poder en cada exorcismo. Ella es la mediadora ... la que manda el poder de gracia de Dios todopoderoso. Dios la declaro el enemigo principal del diablo. Su descendencia aplastará a la serpiente (Gen 1: 3-15) y ella misma derrotará al dragón (Ap 12).

También debemos orar la letanía de los santos. Los santos favoritos para los exorcistas son San Padre Pío, Santa Catalina y San Juan Pablo II. Y debemos orar pidiendo ayuda a los ángeles, especialmente a los arcángeles: santo Miguel, santo Gabriel y santo Rafael.

Así que no tengas miedo. Tienes todo el poder de Dios. Proclama la Buena Nueva, cura los enfermos y expulsa los demonios. En el nombre del Padre, el Hijo, el Espíritu Santo, nuestra Madre la Virgen Santísima, y todos los ángeles y los santos.

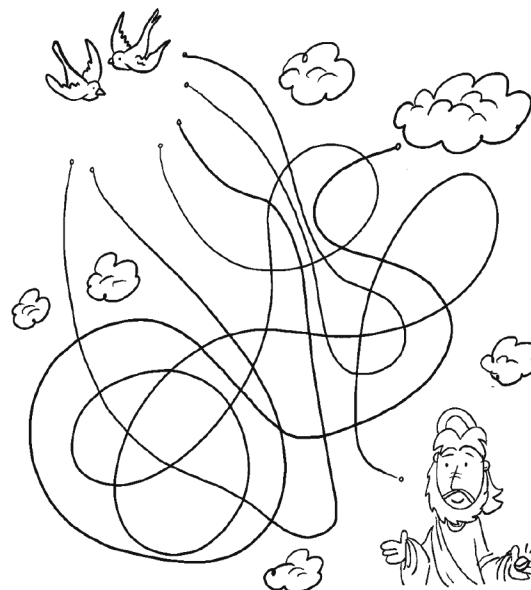
