Our Mission - We, as members of Our Lady of the Desert Church, through the guidance of our Blessed Mother Mary, are a community of believers in Jesus Christ, from whom we have the mission of making His Gospel alive in our parish and in the world. By living out His Gospel, we help to shape a society with greater respect for human life, economic and environmental justice, cultural diversity, and global solidarity, so that we will build a church where everyone feels welcome and through it will find happiness and salvation.

Jesus is the bread of life.

Life is having Jesus inside our heart, always with us so we can overcome every obstacle, suffering, and temptation knowing that this life is only the beginning of a bigger eternal life with God.

Jesus comes into our heart when we pray and especially when we celebrate the Eucharist by listening to the Word of God and in going to communion. In the mass the bread and wine are really transformed into Jesus. It is called the "real presence." And when we consume them, Jesus becomes really present in our heart.

When Jesus comes into our heart it transforms us. The Eucharist transforms how we think, who we are, how we act, and gives us our purpose in life. It transforms us into God's love. It gives us grace: the power to obey God, to die to our self interests and to live to help others. Our hearts are filled with hope and with a new outlook on life.

(Now we will still get bad thoughts, that is part of being human. But when those thoughts come we can just say: "Jesus remove these thoughts" so that they will go away)

Afterward, we bring our transforming experience home. We apply it to the rest of our lives. When others see us they witness our transformation and it is contagious.

The Eucharist empowers us to share in Jesus' sacrifice because we offer our own lives and sufferings together with Jesus' to God. It transforms our suffering into a gift to God.

The Eucharist begins our spiritual resurrection right now. Jesus promises that if we eat his body and drinks his blood we will have eternal life and we will be resurrected on the last day.

Most important, the Eucharist causes Jesus to come into our heart and live in us, and we live in Jesus.

That means two things. Jesus is in our heart always with us so we can overcome every obstacle, temptation, and suffering. And, now that Jesus is in us, we are in Jesus. So we have now been transformed into the bread of life. We have become food for Jesus. We now have to give our own flesh, our lives, for the salvation of the world.

Today when we come up to receive communion, let us thank Jesus for the wonderful gift of the bread of life, and ask Jesus to come into our heart and transform us so that we too can become the bread of life, and give our life to save the world.

Jesús es el pan de vida.

Vivir es tener a Jesús adentro de su Corazón, siempre con nosotros para que podemos conquistar cada obstáculo, sufrimiento, y tentación sabiendo que esta vida es solamente el principio de una vida más grande y eterna con Dios.

Jesús viene adentro de nuestro corazón cuando rezamos y especialmente cuando celebramos la eucaristía escuchando la Palabra de Dios y en comulgando. En la misa, el pan y vino de veras se convierten en Jesús. Esto se llama la presencia real. Y cuando lo comemos y tomamos, Jesús de veras se hace presente en nuestro Corazón.

Cuando Jesús viene adentro de nuestro Corazón, nos transforma.

La eucaristía transforma la manera que pensamos, quienes somos, como actuamos, y nos da nuestro propósito en la vida. Nos transforma en el amor de Dios. Nos da la gracia: el poder para obedecer a Dios, para morir a nuestros intereses de sí mismo, y para vivir para ayudar a otros. Nuestros corazones se llenan con esperanza y una nueva perspectiva de la vida.

Luego llevamos a casa nuestra experiencia de transformación. Lo aplicamos al resto de nuestras vidas. Cuando los demás nos ven, se convierten en testigos de nuestra transformación y es contagiosa. La eucaristía nos da el poder para compartir en el sacrificio de Jesús porque ofrecemos nuestras vidas y sufrimientos juntos con los de Jesús a Dios.

Transforma nuestro sufrimiento en un regalo para Dios.

La eucaristía empieza nuestra resurrección ahora mismo. Jesús nos promete que si comemos su cuerpo y bebemos su sangre vamos a tener la vida eterna y vamos a resucitar en el último día.

Lo más importante es que la eucaristía causa que Jesús venga adentro de nuestro Corazón para que viva en nosotros, y que nosotros vivamos en Jesús. Eso quiere decir dos cosas. Jesús esta adentro de nuestro corazón siempre acompañándonos para que podemos conquistar cualquier obstáculo, sufrimiento, y tentación. Y ahora que Jesús esta adentro de nosotros, nosotros estamos adentro de Jesús.

Entonces nosotros mismos somos transformados en el pan de vida. Ahora somos comida para servir a Jesús. Ahora tenemos que dar nuestra propia carne, nuestra vida, para la salvación del mundo.

Hoy cuando venimos a recibir la comunión, vamos a darle gracias a Jesús por este maravilloso regalo de el pan de vida, y vamos a pedirle a Jesús que entre adentro de nuestro Corazón y que nos transforme para que nosotros también podamos convertirnos en el pan de vida, y dar nuestra vida para la salvación del mundo.

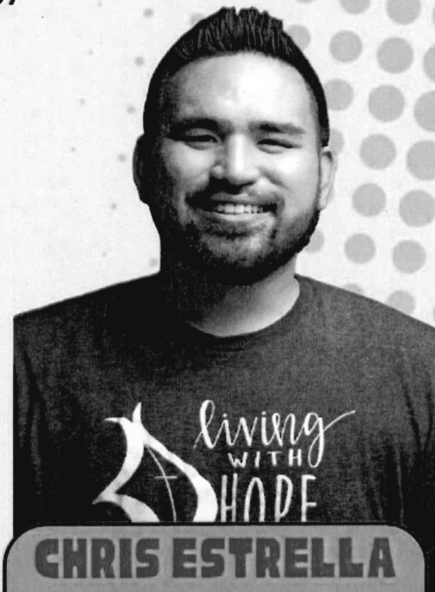

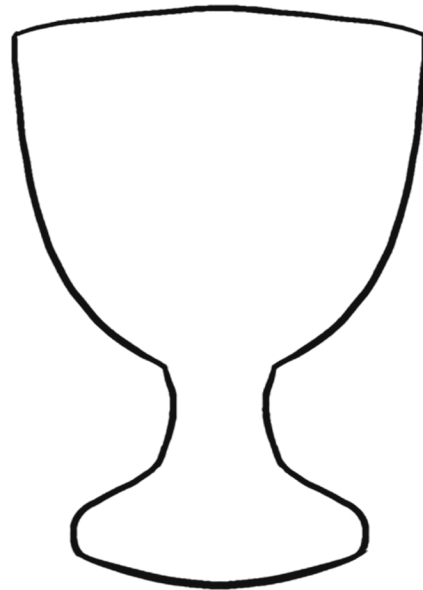
