

The man born blind recovered the ability to see with his heart. Jesus gave him the vision of faith so he could see. See what? He was able to see that Jesus Christ is God and that Jesus Christ was in his heart. But it was a gradual process of getting to know who Jesus is by entering into a personal relationship with Jesus.

First he told his neighbors he was healed, but he did not know who healed him. Then he told the Pharisees it was Jesus who healed him and he must be a prophet. Then he let them have it. He declared that his cure was evidence enough that Jesus is from God. And he had the audacity to ask: "Do you want to become his disciples too?" That was just too much. The Pharisees were furious and they threw him out of the community forever.

Where was Jesus? Where was Jesus when the man born blind was being questioned, insulted and attacked? Why was Jesus absent? The healed blind man was doing his best to answer the questions, but his knowledge of Jesus was weak, incomplete, and inadequate. Yet the more he was attacked, the more he grew in his faith and understanding of Jesus. And the bolder his witness to Jesus became. That is because Jesus was really present. Jesus was present in him and speaking through him by the power of the Holy Spirit.

When the Pharisees finally threw him out of the community—when he appeared to be at his weakest in the eyes of the world—Jesus came to him. Jesus found him. Jesus encountered him and gave him the vision of faith to see that Jesus Christ is God and to see Jesus Christ in himself. And so he fell to his knees and worshiped him.

The same thing happens to us when we suffer and we appear to be at our weakest in the eyes of the world—Jesus comes to us. Jesus finds us. Jesus encounters us and invites us into a personal relationship with him that will transform us. And if we say yes, Jesus will give us the vision of faith to see with the eyes of our heart and to see the same way God sees.

The good news is we already received it. We received the vision of faith when we were baptized. We have the ability to see Jesus Christ in ourselves. But we need more of it. We need to keep asking Jesus to give us more grace for the vision of faith when we pray and in the sacraments. That way we will be able to accomplish our new mission.

Our new mission will be to work together with Jesus to give others the vision of faith to see Jesus Christ in themselves. How can we do it? We have draw people to have a personal encounter with Jesus by letting them see Jesus Christ in us, in everything we say and everything we do.

El hombre ciego de nacimiento recuperó la capacidad de ver con el corazón. Jesús le dio la visión de la fe para que pudiera ver. ¿Ver qué? Él fue capaz de ver que Jesucristo es Dios y que Jesucristo estaba en su corazón. Pero fue un proceso gradual de conocer quién es Jesús por medio de entrar en una relación personal con Jesús.

Primero les dijo a sus vecinos que lo habían curado, pero no sabía quien lo curó. Luego les dijo a los fariseos que fue Jesús quien lo curó y ha de ser un profeta. Luego los puso en su lugar. Les declaró que su curación era prueba suficiente de que Jesús viene de Dios. Y tuvo la audacia de preguntarles: "¿Acaso también ustedes quieren hacerse discípulos suyos?" Eso fue demasiado. Los fariseos se enfurecieron y lo echaron fuera de la comunidad para siempre.

Dónde estaba Jesús? ¿Dónde estaba Jesús cuando el ciego de nacimiento fue interrogado, insultado, y atacado? ¿Por qué Jesús estaba ausente? Él ciego curado estaba haciendo su mejor esfuerzo para responder a las preguntas, pero su conocimiento de Jesús fue débil, incompleto e inadecuado. Sin embargo, lo más que fue atacado, lo más que creció en su fe y conocimiento de Jesús. Y su testimonio de Jesús se hizo todavía mas poderoso. Eso fue porque Jesús de veras estaba presente. Jesús estaba presente en él y hablando a través de él por el poder del Espíritu Santo.

Cuando los fariseos lo echaron de la comunidad—cuando pareció lo más débil en los ojos del mundo—Jesús vino a él. Jesús lo encontró. Jesús tuvo un encuentro con él y le dio la visión de la fe para ver que Jesucristo es Dios y para ver a Jesucristo en sí mismo. Y así se puso de rodillas y lo adoró.

Lo mismo nos pasa a nosotros cuando sufrimos y parecemos lo mas débil en los ojos del mundo -Jesús viene a nosotros. Jesús nos encuentra. Jesús tiene un encuentro con nosotros y nos invita a una relación personal con él que nos transformará. Y si decimos que sí, Jesús nos va dar la visión de la fe para ver con los ojos del corazón y para ver de la misma manera que Dios ve.

Las buenas nuevas son que ya lo recibimos. Recibimos la visión de la fe cuando fuimos bautizados. Tenemos la capacidad de ver a Jesucristo en nosotros mismos. Pero necesitamos más. Tenemos que seguir pidiéndole a Jesús que nos de mas gracia para la visión de la fe cuando oramos y en los sacramentos. De esa manera vamos a poder cumplir nuestra nueva misión.

Nuestra nueva misión va ser trabajar juntos con Jesús para dar a otros la visión de la fe para ver a Jesucristo en sí mismos. ¿Cómo podemos hacerlo? Tenemos que atraer a la gente para tener un encuentro personal con Jesucristo, al dejar que vean a Jesucristo en nosotros, en todo lo que decimos y hacemos.




