

Our Mission - We, as members of Our Lady of the Desert Church, through the guidance of our Blessed Mother Mary, are a community of believers in Jesus Christ, from whom we have the mission of making His Gospel alive in our parish and in the world. By living out His Gospel, we help to shape a society with greater respect for human life, economic and environmental justice, cultural diversity, and global solidarity, so that we will build a church where everyone feels welcome and through it will find happiness and salvation.

Nuestra Misión - Nosotros, como miembros de la Iglesia de Nuestra Señora del Desierto, con la dirección de Nuestra Madre María, somos una comunidad de creencia en Jesús Cristo, que tenemos la misión de hacer su evangelio vivo en nuestra parroquia y en el mundo. Viviendo su evangelio, ayudamos a formar una sociedad con mayor respecto a la vida humana, a la economía y justicia al ambiente, diversidad cultural, y la solidaridad global, de modo que construyamos una iglesia donde todos se sientan bienvenidos con felicidad y salvación.

Jesus asks the Samaritan woman for a drink of water. She hesitates. How can a Jewish Rabbi ask a Samaritan woman for a drink. But for Jesus there are no boundaries. It doesn't matter if she's a Samaritan. It doesn't matter if she's a woman. I recognize the love of God. Jesus doesn't stop. Jesus says "if you knew the gift of God" "you would have asked him and he would have given you living water." The "gift of God" must be Jesus himself. There is no greater gift from God. And by his death and resurrection Jesus brought us the "living water." The living water must be God's love in the Holy Spirit. So Jesus brought us the living water which is God's love. Jesus tells her whoever drinks the water he will give will never thirst. Again, I recognize the love of God. Jesus begins talking about a shared human need—a spiritual thirst in the human heart. Jesus offers to satisfy that thirst for her. This living water will set us free from sin and make us a new creation in Christ so we are joined together with God now and forever.

What happens next is surprising. The Samaritan woman has a conversion. A desire for God's love is awakened in her heart. This desire is in each of us because we were created in God's image. She says "Sir, give me this water."

Then step by step Jesus and the woman reveal themselves to each other more deeply. She humbles herself when she admits she does not have a husband. Jesus keeps loving her. She says, "I can see that you are a prophet." They talk about how, the way they worship is different. Jesus says it doesn't really matter. Soon people will worship God in the Holy Spirit, which will be given by Jesus. Jesus keeps loving her. She begins to suspect he is the promised Messiah and Jesus says "I am he."

And she believes. She becomes a disciple. She goes to the town and tells the people to "come see a man who told me everything I have done." And it worked. Because of what the Samaritan woman said, the people began to believe in Jesus. But when they came and experienced Jesus they began to believe in a new and better way. They believed with their hearts because they experienced Jesus.

What can we learn from this? Remember how the Samaritan woman went into town and drew people to Jesus? Maybe sometimes God loves us when God uses us to share God's love with one another. Am I able to feel God's love when God uses me? Am I able to feel God loving through me when I forgive someone, when I pray with someone, and when I do something good for someone?

Jesus seems to say yes. When the disciples urged him to eat, he said, "My food is to do the will of the one who sent me." It's like Jesus is saying I find God's love for me and working through me when I do God's will. And remember how the townspeople began to believe with their hearts because they experienced Jesus.

How can we receive this living water from Jesus? We need to pray every day and read the bible every day. We need to receive Jesus in Holy Communion. And we need to beg for Jesus' forgiveness by going to confession. And once we have received the living water, let's bring it to other so they can experience the living water (Jesus Christ) in us!

Jesús le pide un vaso de agua a la mujer samaritana. Se vacila. ¿Cómo puede un rabino judío pedirle a beber a una mujer samaritana? Pero para Jesús no hay límites. No importa si es samaritana. No importa si es mujer. Reconozco el amor de Dios. Jesús no se detiene. Jesús le dice: "Si conocieras el don de Dios", "tú le pedirías a él, y él te daría agua viva." El "don de Dios" ha de ser el mero Jesús. No hay mayor regalo de Dios. Y con su muerte y resurrección Jesús nos trajo el "agua viva". El "agua viva" ha de ser el amor de Dios en el Espíritu Santo. Así que Jesús nos trajo el agua viva que es el amor de Dios. Jesús le dice que el que beba del agua que yo le daré, nunca más tendrá sed. Otra vez, reconozco el amor de Dios. Jesús empieza hablando sobre una necesidad humana que todos tenemos, una sed espiritual en el corazón humano. Jesús ofrece satisfacer esa sed. El agua viva nos liberará del pecado y nos convertirá en una nueva creación en Cristo, para que estemos unidos con Dios ahora y para siempre. Lo que sigue es una sorpresa. La mujer samaritana tiene una conversión. Un deseo para el amor de Dios se le despierta en el corazón. Este deseo existe en cada uno de nosotros, porque fuimos creados en la imagen de Dios. Ella dice: "Señor, dame de esa agua." Entonces, paso a paso, Jesús y la mujer se revelan el uno al otro con mayor profundidad. Ella se humilla cuando admite que no tiene marido. Jesús sigue amándola. Ella dice: "Señor, ya veo que eres profeta." Hablan de sus distintos maneras para adorar a Dios. Jesús dice que en realidad no importa. Pronto la gente adorará a Dios en el Espíritu Santo, que va mandar Jesús. Jesús sigue amándola. Ella empieza a sospechar que él es el Mesías prometido y Jesús le dice: "Soy yo."

Y ella cree. Se convierte en un discípulo. Va a la ciudad y les dice a la gente a "Vengan a ver a un hombre que me ha dicho todo lo que he hecho." Y trabajó. Debido al testimonio de la mujer, muchos creyeron en Jesús. Pero cuando llegaron a donde estaba Jesús y lo experimentaron, comenzaron a creer en una manera nueva y mejor. Creyeron con todo sus corazones, porque experimentaron a Jesús. ¿Qué podemos aprender de esto? Recuerda cómo la mujer samaritana fue al pueblo y atrajo la gente a Jesús? Quizás a veces Dios nos ama cuando Dios nos usa para compartir el amor de Dios con otros. ¿Soy capaz de sentir el amor de Dios cuando Dios me usa? ¿Soy capaz de sentir a Dios amando a través de mí cuando perdono a alguien, cuando rezo con alguien, y cuando hago algo bien por alguien? Parece que Jesús dice que sí. Cuando los discípulos le insistían "maestro, come," él dijo: "Mi alimento es hacer la voluntad del que me envió." Es como si Jesús estuviera diciendo, yo encuentro el amor de Dios por mí y el amor de Dios trabajando a través de mí cuando hago la voluntad de Dios. Y recuerda cómo la gente del pueblo comenzaron a creer con sus corazones, ya que experimentaron a Jesús? Mi corazón empezó a moverse. Empecé a sentir como si todo este tiempo yo estaba destinado para ser Jesús. ¿Cómo podemos recibir el agua viva de Jesús? Necesitamos rezar todos los días y leer la Biblia todos los días. Necesitamos recibir a Jesús en la Sagrada Comunión. Y necesitamos pedirle perdón de Jesús cuando voy a la confesión. Y una vez que hemos recibido el agua viva, vamos a traerla a los demás para que ellos puedan experimentar el agua viva (Jesucristo) en nosotros!



We can do it together with the everyone's support!


