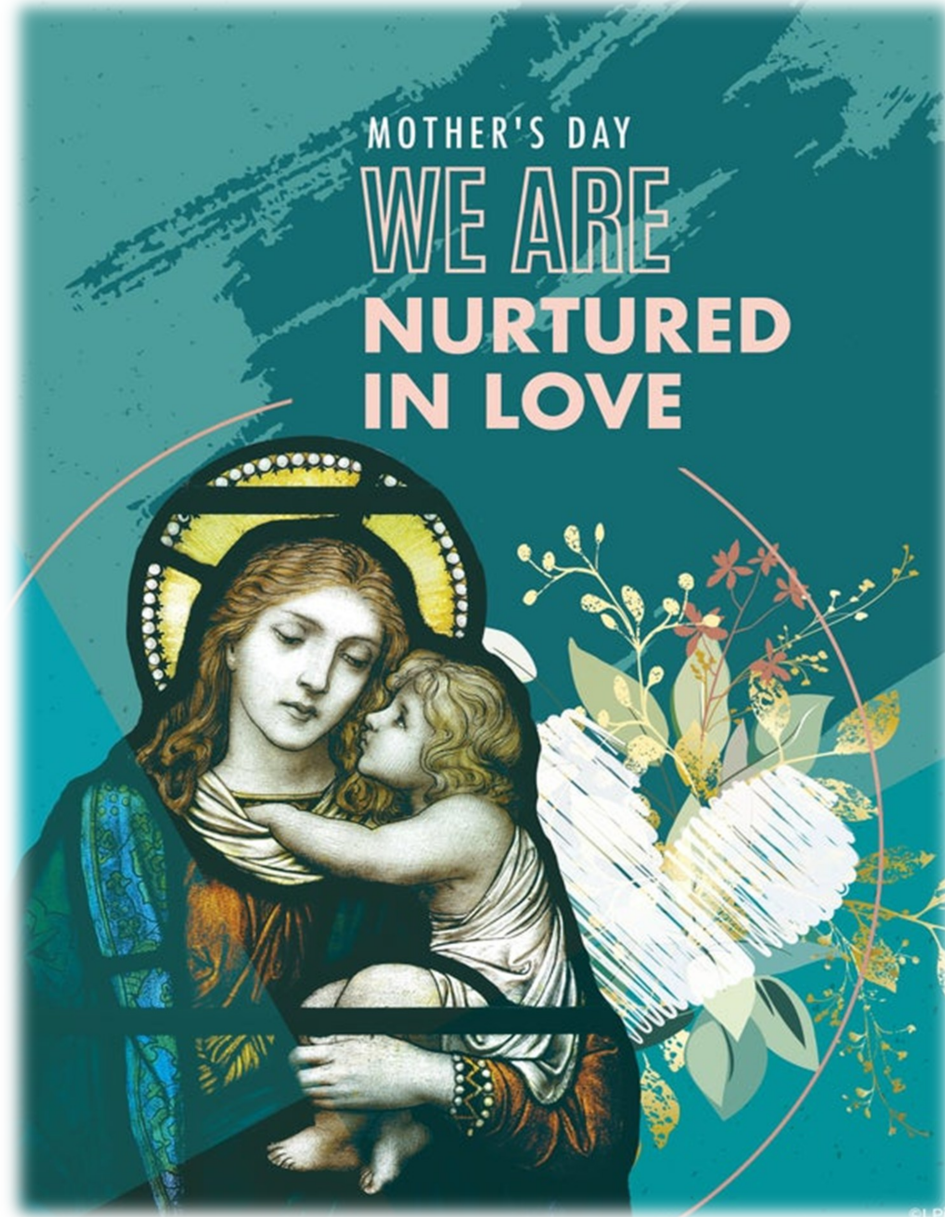

**Happy Mother's Day!****May all our mothers be blessed!**

There is a sad story about a mother whose son was so healthy, young, an athlete. Suddenly the doctors discovered leukemia and he begins dying. So the mother spends every moment with him in the hospital, suffering with him—in a sense dying with him. But do you know what he finally says to her? He says "Take a walk in the world for me." That is what every person we have ever loved and has died is saying to us: "Take a walk in the world for me." That is what the communion of saints—all the souls in heaven & purgatory—are saying to us: "take a walk in the world for me." Find the good in the world. Bring good into the world. Become the good that is Jesus...in the world for me. Today Jesus is saying the same thing to us: "take a walk in the world for me—become me for others." How? Jesus said "I will not leave you orphans." "I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth." The Spirit of Truth is the Holy Spirit of Jesus Christ. What Jesus is saying is that He will come back to the apostles in the power of His Holy Spirit to keep defending, helping and protecting them, just like He did before. And it happened. You can really see the change if you compare the apostles before and after Pentecost. Before Pentecost they were cowards who betrayed, denied and abandoned Jesus. But after Pentecost--that all changed. They all died as martyrs for Christ, except John who they tried to kill several times but because they couldn't they exiled him to an island. What does that tell you? It tells you just one thing. You are going to be transformed in the same way. And everything you have ever seen or heard about Jesus is going to become who you are. For example, in this mass...and in every mass...we re-live...I mean it really happens...Jesus dies and is resurrected on that altar. Do you know why that is so important? Because in that death and resurrection, Jesus reaches down and takes all your sacrifices and all the good things you have ever done...and joins them to his own. Now this is going to blow you away: Your sacrifice becomes His sacrifice and His sacrifice becomes your sacrifice. That means God's love for you, of dying for you on that cross—is going to come inside your heart and become a part of who you are. So what's the catch? First there is something you have to do. Jesus said: You will receive my Spirit, "if you love me and obey the commandments I give you." What are those commandments? They can be summed up in one supreme commandment Jesus gave us that covers everything: Love God by loving others. If you can love God by loving others, guess what? You will automatically love Jesus. You will automatically have the Spirit of Truth, the Spirit of Jesus inside your heart. So, love God by loving others and the Holy Spirit will set your heart on fire—so your heart burns with the Holy Spirit of Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit will bear witness to Jesus. The Holy Spirit will teach you and guide you and empower you to live the truths taught by Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit will give you all the faith, hope, and love you need to face any form of suffering, doubt and temptation. In fact, the Holy Spirit of Jesus will transform you into Jesus.

Hay una historia triste sobre una madre cuyo hijo estaba tan saludable, joven, un atleta. De repente, los médicos descubrieron leucemia y empieza a morir. Así que la madre pasa cada momento con él en el hospital, sufriendo con él—más o menos muriendo con él. ¿Pero sabes lo que su hijo por fin le dice? Él le dice: "Camina en el mundo por mí". Eso es lo que cada persona que hemos amado y que ha muerto nos está diciendo: "Camina en el mundo por mí". Eso es lo que la comunión de los santos—las almas en el cielo y el purgatorio—nos están diciendo: "Camina en el mundo por mí." Encuentra lo bueno en el mundo. Trae lo bueno al mundo. Conviértete en lo bueno que es Jesús ... en el mundo por mí. Hoy Jesús nos está diciendo la misma cosa: "Camina en el mundo por mí—conviértete en mí para los demás". ¿Cómo? Jesús dijo: "No los dejaré huérfanos." "Yo pediré al Padre, y él les enviará otro Consolador que esté siempre con ustedes, el Espíritu de verdad." El Espíritu de verdad es el Espíritu Santo de Jesucristo. Lo que Jesús está diciendo es que Él volverá a los apóstoles en el poder de Su Espíritu Santo para seguir defendiéndolos, ayudándolos y protegiéndolos, como lo hizo antes. Y sucedió. De veras puedes ver el cambio si comparas a los apóstoles antes y después de Pentecostés. Antes de Pentecostés eran cobardes que traicionaron, negaron y abandonaron a Jesús. Pero después de Pentecostés--todo cambió. Todos murieron como mártires por Cristo, excepto Juan, que intentaron matar varias veces, pero porque no pudieron matarlo, lo exiliaron a una isla. ¿Qué te dice eso? Sólo te dice una cosa. Tu vas a transformados de la misma manera. Y todo lo que has visto o oído hablar de Jesús se va a convertir en quien eres. Por ejemplo. En esta misa ... y en cada misa ... re-vivimos ... quiero decir que de veras sucede ... Jesús muere y resucita en ese altar. ¿Sabes por qué es tan importante? Porque en esa muerte y resurrección, Jesús baja la mano y toma todos tus sacrificios y todas las cosas buenas que has hecho ... y las une a las suyas. Ahora esto es impresionante: Tu sacrificio se convierte en Su sacrificio y Su sacrificio se convierte en tu sacrificio. Eso significa que el amor de Dios por ti, de morir por ti en esa cruz--va a entrar dentro de tu corazón y convertirse en una parte de lo que tu eres. Así que ¿cuál es la clave? Primero hay algo que tienes que hacer. Jesús dijo: Recibirás mi Espíritu, "si me amas y cumples mis mandamientos." ¿Qué son esos mandamientos? Pueden resumirse en un mandamiento supremo que Jesús nos dio que cubre todo: Ama a Dios amando a los demás. Si puedes amar a Dios amando a los demás, ¿sabes qué? Amarás automáticamente a Jesús. Tendrás automáticamente el Espíritu de Verdad, el Espíritu de Jesús dentro de tu corazón. Así que, ama a Dios amando a los demás y tu corazón se quedara ardiendo con el fuego del Espíritu Santo. El Espíritu Santo dará testimonio de Jesús. El Espíritu Santo te enseñará y te guiará y te fortalece a vivir las verdades que Jesús nos enseñó. El Espíritu Santo te dará toda la fe, la esperanza y el amor que necesitas para afrontar cualquier forma de sufrimiento, duda y tentación. De hecho, el Espíritu Santo de Jesús te va a transformar a ser Jesús.

Karl Sauter

1938 – 2026

*Rest in God's Peace Dad and Grandpa – we love you*

Karl Sauter died in April 2026 surrounded by the love of his family at the age of 87. He was preceded in death, 5 years prior, by his beloved wife of 55 years, Margaret of Jesup, Iowa. He is survived by his five children and their spouses: Kurt and Jackie Sauter, Monica and Jack Kiernan, Christine Sauter, Mark and Julie Sauter, Paul and Maureen Sauter, and nine grandchildren: Megan, Jessica, Audrey and Abigail, Jackson and Kelsea, Claire and Sophia, and Luke.

Karl was born in Ravensburg, Germany in 1938. He lost his younger half-brother, Günther, to illness during the war. Karl immigrated by ship to America at the age of 13 to join his mother Theresia, who had immigrated the year prior to Newark, NJ. In New Jersey he completed grade school, high school, and began studies at Rutgers University until joining the US Air Force in 1957 and becoming a US citizen at the age of 19. In the Air Force he serviced RADAR equipment while being stationed at Thule Air Base, Greenland, 700 miles north of the Arctic Circle.

Upon completing his service, he briefly entered Jesuit novitiate training at Sacred Heart Seminary in Los Gatos, CA until moving to the San Fernando Valley in 1961. He attended college while also working as an electronics technician at several companies, including TRW's Microwave Division in Canoga Park, until graduating from UCLA with a Bachelor of Arts degree in German in 1964. He met a neighbor at his apartment building who would be the love of his life, Margaret. Karl and Margaret were married at St. Elizabeth Church in Van Nuys in 1965.

Karl and Margaret were soon blessed with a growing family (Kurt, Monica, Christine) while Karl began his teaching career. He completed his master's degree in German at UCLA in 1970, welcomed two more newborns, Mark and Paul, and completed his PhD in German Language and Literature at USC in 1977. Karl's 30-year teaching career centered on language and math. He taught at several high schools in the San Fernando Valley, at Drake University in Iowa, and briefly served as a German language instructor at the Defense Language Institute in Monterey, CA. He was especially fond of his years at St Francis High School in La Cañada in the 1980s, teaching German and math, advising the student German Club, and being known affectionately as 'Doc Sauter'.

Karl remained steadfast in his faith and his love for his wife, children, grandchildren and mother. He loved a good cup of coffee, a well-played hand of bridge, John Wayne and western movies, Tolkien, classical music, a washed and shined VW bug, Bob Hope, Laurel and Hardy, a neatly mowed lawn, road trips, chess, sci-fi, Disneyland, freshly baked pie, dampfnudeln, his mother's spätzle, good bread, Pavarotti, a flexible return policy, socks with leather sandals, slot machines, a comfortable chair in a quiet backyard, friendly dogs, cats and animals of every kind, the serenity of the high desert, and afternoon drives with his beloved Margaret.

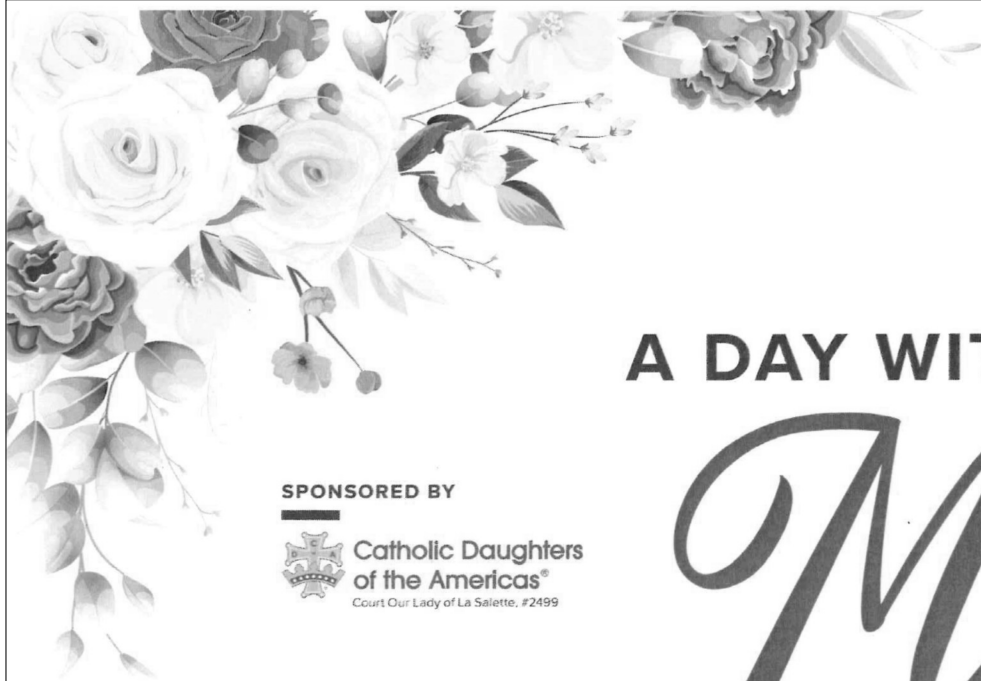
