Our Mission - We, as members of Our Lady of the Desert Church, through the guidance of our Blessed Mother Mary, are a community of believers in Jesus Christ, from whom we have the mission of making His Gospel alive in our parish and in the world. By living out His Gospel, we help to shape a society with greater respect for human life, economic and environmental justice, cultural diversity, and global solidarity, so that we will build a church where everyone feels welcome and through it will find happiness and salvation.

God's love is so great for us, that He came into the world as Jesus to search for us His "stray sheep." His love for us is so great that it turns God against Himself. God had every right to rain down His justice upon us...to condemn us forever.

But instead God loves us. God forgives us. And God dies on that cross for us...so that one day we can be together with God in heaven. That is how much God loves us. And you are part of that love story.

Why is that important? Let me ask you this: How many times have you gotten up in the morning just to face the same old drudgery day after day—bills to pay, traffic jams, everyone is rude. You go to the work, go home, watch TV, go to bed. And you have to wonder: "what is the meaning and purpose of my life?"

Do you want to know? The answer is: Jesus. Like Jesus says "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me (Jn. 14:6).

What does that mean? That means Follow Me...and you will find the meaning and purpose of your life.

Jesus is the "way" to the Father, because if you follow Jesus, you will achieve salvation. Jesus is the "truth" because He shows us God; He shows us God's will; and He shows us how much God loves us. Jesus is the "life" because He forgives our sins and takes us from death into eternal life in heaven.

But Jesus wants you to do more than just follow Him. Jesus wants you to become him. Why? Because Jesus chose you. You are His disciple. So Jesus is calling you to become the Way, the Truth and the Life in Him—for others. How are you going to do that? You have already been committed.

When you were baptized you were consecrated into the priesthood of Jesus Christ. I'm not talking just about priests and nuns you see in the Church. I'm talking about you. You have been chosen by God to be a holy priesthood to offer spiritual sacrifice acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

What is your spiritual sacrifice? The only sacrifice that really matters...the same sacrifice Jesus offered on that cross: Love God by loving others. How? Feed the hungry, cloth the naked, give drink to the thirsty, welcome the stranger, care for the sick, and visit those in prison.

In this mass, Jesus' sacrifice--of obeying the will of God and dying for you on that cross--is going to come alive again. Then Jesus is going to take your sacrifice and join it to His sacrifice on that altar, and offer it up to God for the salvation of the world. It sounds like your life has a very important purpose.

Then something even more incredible is going to happen. Jesus is going to give you His power. You are going to put His body and His blood into your body and your blood...so that He abides in you and you abide in Him.

El amor de Dios es tan grande para nosotros, que Él vino al mundo como Jesús para buscarnos a nosotros Sus "ovejas perdidas". Su amor por nosotros es tan grande que se niega a Sí mismo. Dios tenía todo el derecho de derramar su justicia sobre nosotros ... a condenarnos para siempre.

Pero al contrario, Dios nos ama. Dios nos perdona. Y Dios muere en esa cruz por nosotros ... para que un día podamos estar juntos con Dios en el cielo. Eso es lo mucho que Dios nos ama. Y tú eres parte de esa historia de amor.

¿Por qué es importante? Déjame preguntarte esto:

¿Cuántas veces te has levantado en la mañana sólo para aguantar la misma cosa, día tras día—cuentas que pagar, atascos de tráfico, todo el mundo es grosero. Vas al trabajo, vuelves a casa, miras la televisión, y vas a la cama. Y hay que preguntarse: "¿Qué significa y cuál es el propósito de mi vida?"

Quieres saber? La respuesta es: Jesús. Como Jesús dice: "Yo soy el camino, la verdad y la vida. Nadie va al Padre si no es por mí (Juan 14: 6). Qué significa eso? Eso significa: Sígueme ... y vas a encontrar lo que significa y el propósito de tu vida.

Jesús es el "camino" al Padre, porque si sigues a Jesús, lograrás la salvación. Jesús es la "verdad" porque Él nos enseña a Dios; Él nos enseña la voluntad de Dios; Y Él nos enseña cuánto nos ama Dios. Jesús es la "vida" porque Él perdona nuestros pecados y nos lleva de la muerte a la vida eterna en el cielo.

Pero Jesús quiere que hagas algo más que solo seguirlo. Jesús quiere que te conviertas en Él. ¿Por qué? Porque Jesús te escogió. Tú eres Su discípulo. Así que Jesús te está llamando a ser el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida en Él, para los demás. Cómo vas a hacer eso? Ya eres comprometido. Cuando fuiste bautizado, fuiste consagrado al sacerdocio de Jesucristo. No estoy hablando sólo de los sacerdotes y monjas que ves en la iglesia. Estoy hablando de ti. Tu has sido escogido por Dios para ser un sacerdocio santo, destinado a ofrecer sacrificios espirituales, agradables a Dios, por medio de Jesucristo. ¿Cuál es tu sacrificio espiritual? El único sacrificio que de veras importa ... el mismo sacrificio que Jesús ofreció en esa cruz: Ama a Dios amando a los demás. ¿Cómo?

Alimente al hambriento, ponle ropa al desnudo, dale de beber al sediento, dale la bienvenida al extraño, cuida a los enfermos y visita a los encarcelados. En esta misa, el sacrificio de Jesús - de obedecer la voluntad de Dios y morir por ti en esa cruz - va a revivir de nuevo. Entonces Jesús va a tomar tu sacrificio y unirlo a Su sacrificio en ese altar, y ofrecerlo a Dios para la salvación del mundo. Suena como si tu vida tiene un propósito muy importante. Entonces algo todavía más increíble va a suceder. Jesús te va a dar Su poder. Vas a poner Su cuerpo y Su sangre en tu cuerpo y tu sangre ... para que Él permanezca en ti y tu permanezcas en Él.

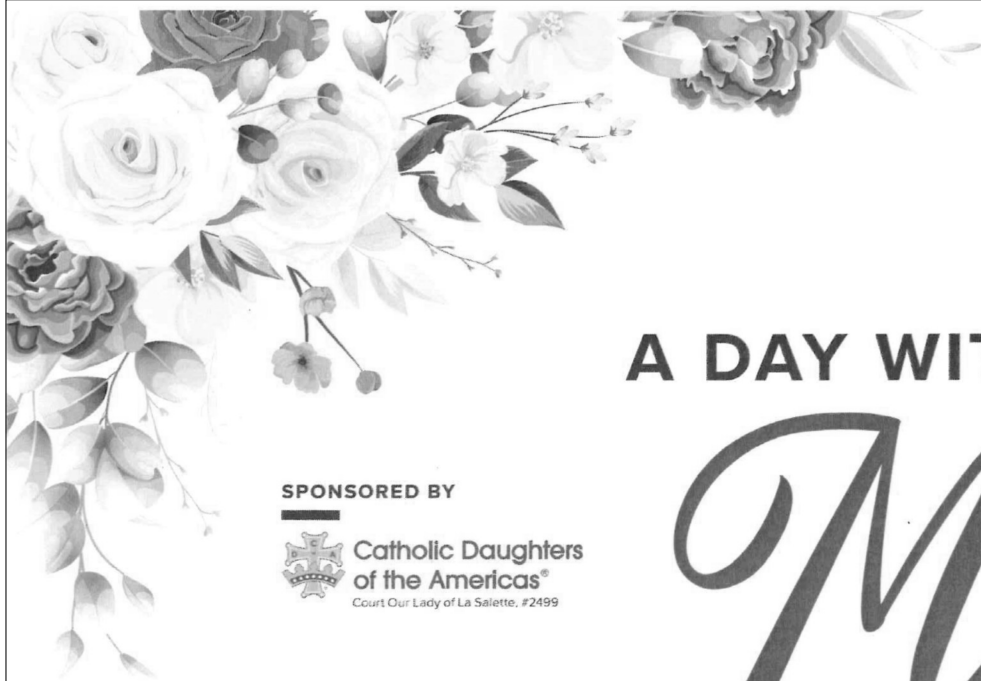
