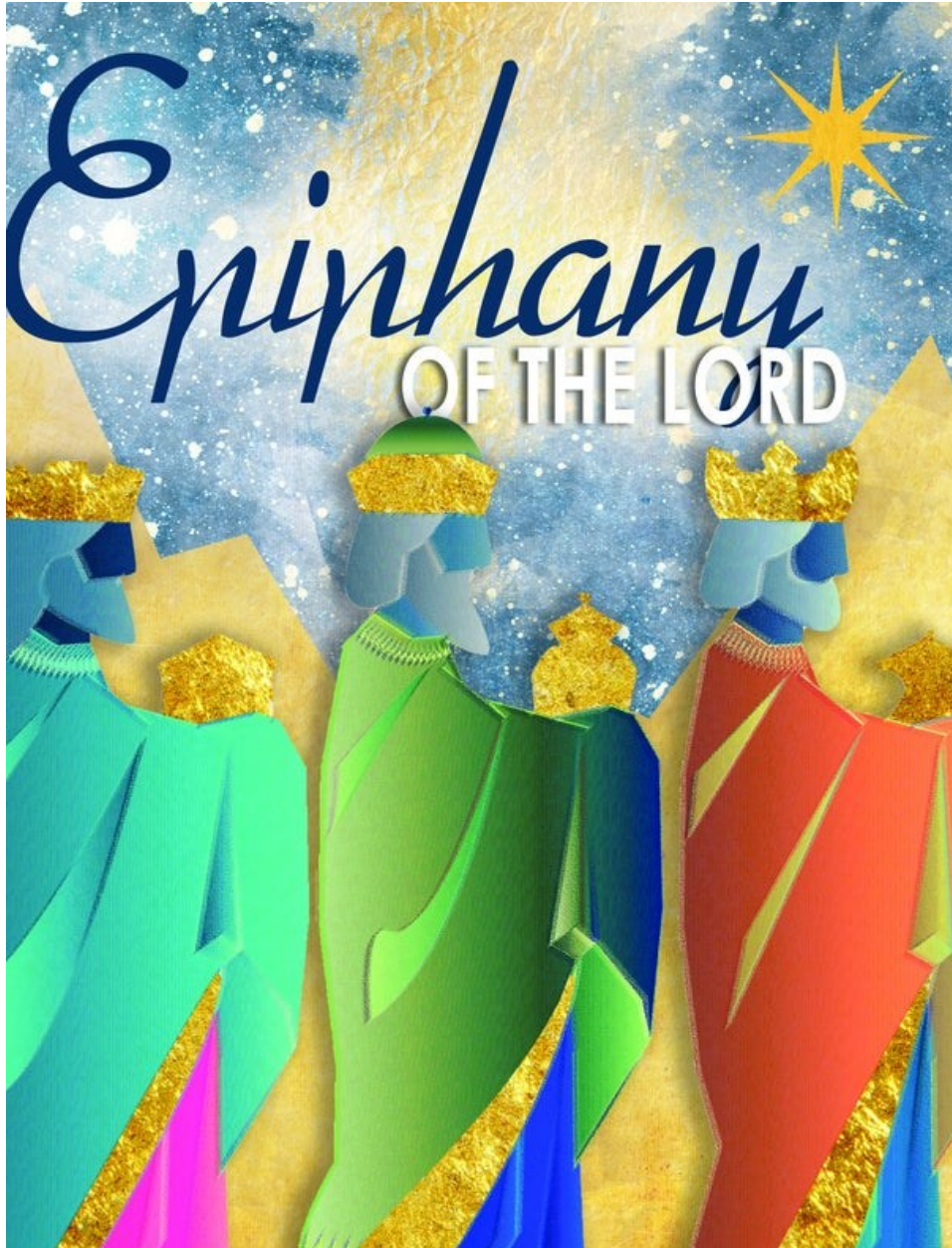

Our Mission - We, as members of Our Lady of the Desert Church, through the guidance of our Blessed Mother Mary, are a community of believers in Jesus Christ, from whom we have the mission of making His Gospel alive in our parish and in the world. By living out His Gospel, we help to shape a society with greater respect for human life, economic and environmental justice, cultural diversity, and global solidarity, so that we will build a church where everyone feels welcome and through it will find happiness and salvation.

The dictionary defines an epiphany as any manifestation of God. We might call it a God experience. For the Magi, who were not Jewish, their epiphany was to experience God drawing them to Jesus, and then to experience God's love in Jesus, and for them to realize that the God who they thought belonged only to the Jews really belongs to everybody. I wonder what it was like. Maybe it was something like this: Something has been awakened in me. Something has been born. I feel faith, hope, and love...for a child, the coming of the Messiah. The God of another people, but it's not the God of another people, it's my God calling me. I can't get the star out of my mind. It is calling me. It is pulsating with life, my life. That star is part of me. I yearn for it to guide me. It obsesses me. It draws me. Nothing else matters. I will follow. I am being transformed and I want it to happen. I am overwhelmed with joy and peace, joy and peace like I've never felt before. My home is in it. In my heart I know it. It is my God calling me to fulfill my purpose, to come to God. I am coming home.

We follow the star. It leads us to the poorest of the poor. It leads us to a helpless, defenseless, baby called Jesus. But none of that matters anymore. We see God before us. We hear God before us. We feel the power of God before us. We feel God's love for us and it overwhelms us. We fall to our knees, crying and worshiping him. Nothing else matters. None of us matter. What is the message for me? God brought me to Jesus to reveal God's love for me. The more I know Jesus, the more I know God. The more I know Jesus, the more I experience God's love for me. The more I know Jesus, and the more I experience God's love for me, the more I'm transformed to become like God and Jesus. In the seminary we called this the most wonderful "exchange." One of the Fathers of the Church, Irenaeus of Lyons described it like this: God became human, like us, so that we might become divine like God. This most wonderful exchange is God's offer of salvation.

And how should I respond to God's offer of salvation. Should I respond like the Magi? Am I willing to leave everything behind and give the gift of my most valuable possession, my very life, to God? Will I fall to my knees and worship him, in faith, hope, and love, even when there is so much I don't understand and know about him? God is calling me into a new relationship with Jesus. It is a new relationship that never ends. I am being called to be a disciple. I am being called to study Jesus and to let Jesus transform me to become like Jesus. I am being called to participate in Jesus' mission. It won't be easy. It means facing hardships. Can I do this? Can I work with God to transform the world? Yes we can. Together with God and Jesus, and with our Blessed Mother the Virgin Mary we can do it. Together with the power of grace they give us we can become the epiphany of Jesus Christ that transforms the world!

El Dios de otro pueblo, pero no es el Dios de otro pueblo, es mi Dios que me llama. Esa estrella. No la puedo sacar de mi mente. Me está llamando. Está latiendo con vida, mi vida. Esa estrella es parte de mí. Deseo que me guíe. Me obsesiona. Me atrae. Nada más importa. Tengo que seguirla. Me esta transformado y quiero que lo agüe. Estoy lleno con alegría y paz, un alegría y paz como nunca he sentido. Mi hogar esta aquí. En mi corazón lo sé. Es mi Dios que me llama para cumplir mi propósito, para regresarme a Dios. Siento como si estoy volviendo a mi casa. Seguimos la estrella. Nos trae a los más pobres de los pobres. Nos lleva a un indefenso, bebé, llamado Jesús. Pero nada de esto nos importa. Vemos a Dios enfrente de nosotros. Escuchamos a Dios enfrente de nosotros. Sentimos el poder de Dios delante de nosotros. Sentimos el amor de Dios por nosotros y nos abruma. Caemos de rodillas, llorando y adorándolo. Nada más importa. Ninguno de nosotros importa. ¿Cuál es el mensaje para mí? Dios me trajo a Jesús para revelar el amor de Dios para mí. Lo más que conozco Jesús, lo más que conozco a Dios. Lo más que conozco a Jesús, lo más que experimento el amor de Dios para mí. Lo más que conozco a Jesús, y lo más que experimento el amor de Dios para mí, lo más que me voy transformando a ser como Dios y Jesús. En el seminario lo llamábamos el más maravilloso "intercambio." Uno de los Padres de la Iglesia, llamado Ireneo de Lyon, lo describió de esta manera: Dios se hizo hombre como nosotros, para que nosotros pudiéramos hacernos divinos como Dios. Este intercambio tan maravilloso es la oferta de Dios para nuestra salvación. ¿Y cómo debo responder a esta oferta de salvación? ¿Debo responder como los Reyes Magos? ¿Estoy dispuesto a dejar todo atrás y dar el regalo más valioso que tengo, mi propia vida, a Dios? Me caeré de rodillas para adorarlo, con fe, esperanza, y amor, anqué haya tanto que no entiendo y que no se de el? Dios me llama a una nueva relación con Jesús. Es una nueva relación que jamás termina. Me llama para ser un discípulo. Me llama para estudiar a Jesús y para dejar que Jesús me transforme para ser como el. Me llama para participar en la misión de Jesús. No va a ser fácil. Quiere decir que voy a enfrentar las dificultades. ¿Puedo hacerlo? ¿Puedo trabajar con Dios para cambiar el mundo? Sí se puede. Juntos con Dios y Jesús. y con nuestra Madre la Virgen Santísima podemos hacerlo. Juntos con el poder de la gracia que ellos nos dan, podemos convertirnos en la epifanía de Jesucristo que transformara el mundo!

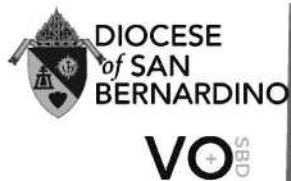

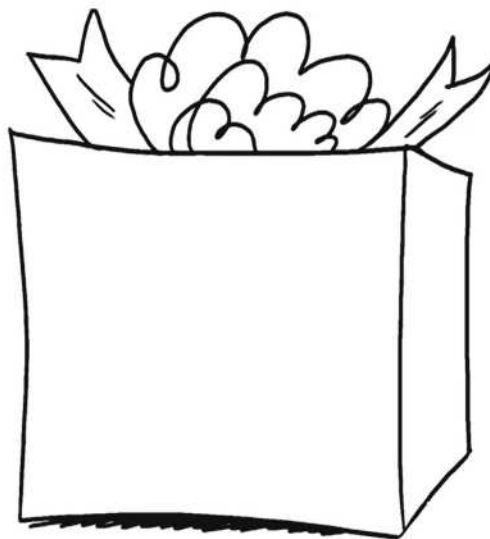

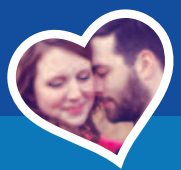
