**"Alleluia! He has risen!"** We have the power! Let us use our lives to share the good news with the whole world that Jesus Christ has risen. Imagine what it must have felt like for Mary Magdala. She went to the tomb and Jesus was gone. Suddenly, at the same time she is utterly confused, scared to death, and bursting with joy. Is it possible? She runs breathless, filled with a superhuman power of hope. We can hear her heart pounding and bursting with joy. We see tears of joy running down her cheeks past her upturned ecstatic smile. Can it be? Alleluia He has Risen!

Like Mary Magdala who ran to tell Peter and John that Jesus was risen, let's tell the whole world with our lives that Jesus has risen for us. Today (Yesterday) all over the world we welcomed new disciples into our communities in baptism and confirmation. And today we will renew our baptismal promises. They remind us that in baptism we were consecrated to be priests, prophets, and kings. What does that mean?

We are prophets when we give witness to Christ in everything we say and do. We are priests when we receive Gods' love and pass it on to others. When we make the sacrifice of giving up our own interests for the interests of others. We are kings when we use every effort to transform the world into Gods' kingdom. The good news of Easter is that we do not have to do this alone. Jesus Christ gives us the power to do it when we pray and in the sacraments, especially in Holy Communion. It is the power that raised Jesus from the dead to life. Today that power is ours. "Alleluia! He has Risen!"

Why should we do all this? Because the new promise from God is if we do it, God will raise us from the dead just like Jesus. We are the people of the resurrection. Let us prove it in everything we say and do. Let our testimony be the Holy Spirit of the Risen Christ in our hearts. This Holy Spirit gives us the faith, hope, and love to believe that when we die we will be resurrected into a new life with God and Christ. Our resurrection begins today, in the life we are living right now. We have the power. Today let us start making small resurrection gifts to God. So let us receive God's love and share it with others. Let us give up our own interests to live for others. Let us forgive those who offend us even when they don't ask for it. Let us love God just because we love God and for no other reason. Each and every time we make these small gifts to God, we will begin resurrecting our own soul right now in the life we are living.

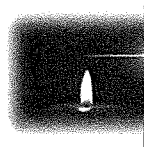

## About Restoring Me Retreats

Restoring Me is a Catholic retreat program of the Diocese of San Bernardino consisting of a series of one-day healing retreats for anyone who has suffered neglect, physical, sexual, emotional, or spiritual abuse. The retreats are focused on the restoration of the dignity and identity of the person, created in the image and likeness of God.

The purpose of Restoring Me retreats is to provide a Christ-centered Catholic faith-based healing environment, where participants feel welcomed, listened to, accompanied, know that they are not alone, and can share their personal experiences in a **safe, sacred, and confidential** setting.

Our goal is to help participants experience God's love and presence in their lives through Scripture, prayer, spiritual exercises, personal reflection, and faith sharing.

It is important to understand that although sharing experiences is an important part of the healing process, participants are not obligated to talk about their personal lives or painful experiences. Participants are encouraged to share only what they feel they are ready to share when they are ready to share.

The team that facilitates the Restoring Me retreats is formed by trained volunteers with a great compassion for our brothers and sisters living in grief from hurtful abuse experiences.

Restoring Me retreats are not intended to replace professional mental health services, but to provide faith-based peer, spiritual, and pastoral support and accompaniment for participants throughout their healing journey.

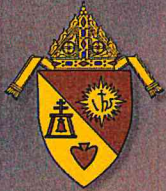

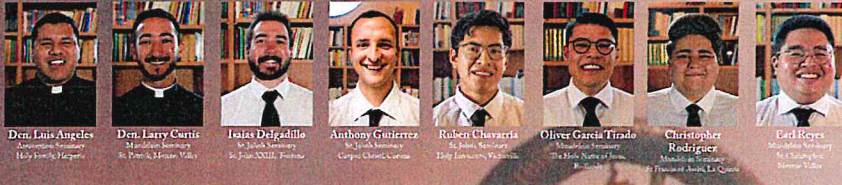

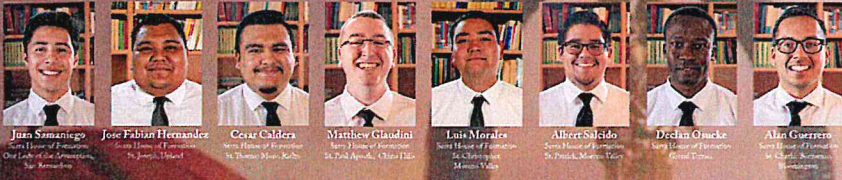
