The ultimate price had to be paid for the ultimate crime of all our sins against God. The ultimate sacrifice of suffering and death on the cross had to be made for the victory of love over sin and death. And so the joy of the palms was turned into the sorrow of the cross. Step by step every human reason for loving and trusting in God was taken away. Jesus suffered the fear and agony in the garden. Judas betrayed Jesus for 30 pieces of silver. Jesus was arrested. Peter denied Jesus. All the disciples abandoned him.

Jesus was falsely accused of blasphemy, tried, and convicted to die. Jesus was tortured, mocked and nailed to the cross. And there on the cross at Calvary, as he was dying, he suffered the worst thing of all—he felt completely abandoned by God. "My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?"

That too is your journey to the resurrection and to God, but you have to pass by way of the cross. You too will be tested and suffer until there is no longer any human reason to love and trust in God.

Sometimes it will feel like God doesn't even listen to your prayers. It will feel like God has abandoned you. And you will cry out with Jesus on the cross, "My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?" But something wonderful and beautiful is going to happen. Jesus persevered. Jesus crossed through the threshold of suffering, abandonment and doubt. He found the faith to keep loving and trusting in God. His last dying words said it all: "Father into your hands I commend my spirit." Then he breathed his last.

The same thing is going to happen to you. Somewhere down deep inside the recesses of your heart you will find the strength in your faith to keep loving and trusting in God. You will persevere. Why? Because Jesus already did it for you. Because when Jesus suffered and died for you on that cross he gave you the power of grace to overcome sin, to overcome suffering and death, and to obey God's commandments.

All you have to do is transform your pain and suffering into your love for God and Jesus—offering it up as a gift of love. Just say it: Jesus I am adding the sacrifice of my life and all my pain and suffering to your sacrifice of pain and suffering on that cross for the salvation of the world. Jesus let me love you so much, that I can't help but love you in others.

Together with Jesus Christ you will rise up and you will be victorious. That is the real ending of the story. The real ending is our victory of the resurrection—the victory of love over sin and death.

Yes there is a cross, but now you have the power to pass through that cross together with Jesus Christ, to the Resurrection. Why? Because Jesus loved God so much in you that He died for you. Now it is your turn to love Jesus so much that you love Jesus in others.

Se tuvo que pagar el precio máximo por el crimen máximo de todos nuestros pecados contra Dios. Se tuvo que hacer el sacrificio máximo de sufrir y morir en la cruz para la victoria del amor sobre el pecado y la muerte.

Así que la alegría de los ramos se convirtió en el dolor de la cruz. Paso a paso cada razón humana para amar y confiar en Dios se desapareció. Jesús sufrió el miedo y la agonía en el huerto. Judas lo traidoró por 30 monedas de plata. Jesús fue arrestado. Pedro lo negó. Todos los discípulos lo abandonaron. Jesús fue acusado falsamente de blasfemia, juzgado y condenado a morir. Jesús fue torturado, escarnecido y clavado en la cruz. Y allí, en la cruz del Calvario, cuando se estaba muriendo, sufrió lo peor de todo—se sintió completamente abandonado por Dios.

"Dios mío, Dios mío, ¿por qué me has abandonado?" Eso también es tu camino a la resurrección y a Dios, pero tienes que pasar a través de la cruz. Tu también vas a ser probado y vas a sufrir hasta que ya no hay ninguna razón humana para amar y confiar en Dios. A veces se va a sentir como si Dios ni escucha tus oraciones. Va a sentir como si Dios te ha abandonado. Y vas a gritar con Jesús en la cruz: "Dios mío, Dios mío, ¿por qué me has abandonado?"

Pero algo maravilloso y bellísimo va a ocurrir. Jesús perseveró. Jesús cruzó a través del umbral del sufrimiento, el abandono y la duda. Encontró la fe para seguir amando y confiando en Dios. Sus últimas palabras antes de morir lo dijeron todo: "Padre, en tus manos encomiendo mi espíritu." Entonces murió. Lo mismo te va a pasar a ti. En lo más profundo de tu corazón vas a encontrar la fuerza en tu fe para seguir amando y confiando en Dios. ¿Por qué? Porque Jesús ya lo hizo por ti. Porque cuando Jesús sufrió y murió por ti en esa cruz él te dio el poder de la gracia para vencer el pecado, para vencer el sufrimiento y la muerte, y para obedecer los mandamientos de Dios.

Todo lo que tienes que hacer es transformar tu dolor y sufrimiento en el amor por Dios y Jesucristo—ofreciéndolo hacia arriba como un regalo de amor. Sólo tienes que decir: Jesús agrega el sacrificio de mi vida y todo mi dolor y sufrimiento a tu sacrificio de dolor y sufrimiento en la cruz para la salvación del mundo. Jesús déjame amarte tanto, que no puedo menos que amarte en los demás.

Junto con Jesucristo vas a levantarte y vas a ser victorioso. Ese es el verdadero final de la historia. El verdadero final es nuestra victoria de la resurrección—la victoria del amor sobre el pecado y la muerte.

Sí hay una cruz, pero ahora tienes el poder de pasar a través de la cruz junto con Jesucristo, a la Resurrección. ¿Por qué? Porque Jesús amo a Dios tanto en ti, que murió por ti. Ahora te toca a ti—amarlo a Jesús tanto que amas a Jesús en los demás.
