The disciples told Thomas the exact same thing Mary Magdalene told them: "We have seen the Lord." But Thomas did not believe them. Can you blame him? "Unless I see his wounded flesh...I will not believe." He wasn't the kind of person who was going to blindly accept whatever others told him.

Then a miracle happens. Jesus appears again in the midst of the disciples. But this time he comes down to Thomas' level and removes all his doubts by giving him God's divine mercy. It was almost like he was saying: "Ok, go ahead—if this is what it takes go ahead—put your finger into the nail marks and put your hand into my side." We don't know if Thomas actually touched Jesus. But we do know Thomas was changed forever.

That was the Easter power of God's love. That was God's divine mercy in action. Suddenly he believed: My Lord and my God!" Thomas was transformed. Later Thomas would go on to become a missionary to India and die as a martyr for his belief in Jesus Christ.

And what Jesus did for Thomas, Jesus does for us. Jesus comes down to our level with God's divine mercy so that we can encounter Him and be transformed into him. We encounter His divine mercy in the Word of God proclaimed from the ambo. We encounter His divine mercy in the sacrifice of the mass on the altar. We encounter His divine mercy when we receive His Body and Blood so that He comes to live inside of us. We encounter His divine mercy when we kneel before a priest, confess our sins and hear those beautiful words of absolution.

And now, since you have received all that divine mercy, Jesus is sending you on a mission. Now you are going to bring God's divine mercy to everyone. Jesus is saying "As the Father has sent me, so I send you" (Jn. 20:21). "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful" (Lk 6:36). The question is this: How are you going to do that? By living with His attitude and in His Spirit. You need to let Him inspire everything you say and do. For starters, you need to constantly reflect on His life and open your heart to become who He is.

You need to be merciful to everyone around you—in your home, in your family, in your community. You can begin by making everyone feel like they can talk to you and you will listen to them. Try it. Walk up to someone and say "hey, I'd like to pray for you, give me something I can pray about for you." And it doesn't matter who it is. Every person outside these doors is important enough to encounter the divine mercy of the Risen Christ in you. When the Risen Christ appeared to Sister Faustina Kowalska, He promised us a plenary indulgence so that our sins will be forgiven and all temporal punishment will be completely removed. These are the requirements: 1. Go to confession 8 days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday. 2. Receive communion during those 16 days. 3. Pray for the intentions of the Pope. 4. Pray the Chaplet and other devotions venerating the sacred image of divine mercy, or in the presence of the blessed sacrament pray the Our Father and the Creed, adding "Merciful Jesus I trust in you!"

El no era el tipo de persona que iba creer cualquier cosa que le dijeran. Entonces ocurre un milagro. Jesús aparece de nuevo en medio de los discípulos. Pero esta vez se reduce a nivel de Tomás y elimina todas sus dudas—dándole la divina misericordia de Dios. Era casi como si dijera: "Ok, adelante, si esto es lo que se necesita sigue adelante, pon el dedo en los agujeros de los clavos y mete tu mano en mi costado." No sabemos si de veras Tomás tocó a Jesús. Pero sí sabemos que Tomás se cambió para siempre. Ese fue el poder Pascual del amor de Dios. Esa fue la divina misericordia de Dios en acción. De repente, él creía. Señor mío y Dios mío!" Tomás se transformó. Más tarde Tomás va a ser misionero a la India y va morir como un mártir por su fe en Jesucristo. Y lo que Jesús hizo por Tomás, Jesús lo hace por nosotros. Jesús viene a nuestro nivel con la divina misericordia de Dios para tener un encuentro con El y convertimos en El. Tenemos un encuentro con su divina misericordia en la Palabra de Dios proclamada desde el ambo. Tenemos un encuentro con su divina misericordia en el sacrificio de la misa en el altar. Tenemos un encuentro con su divina misericordia cuando recibimos su Cuerpo y Sangre, para que Él venga a vivir dentro de nosotros. Tenemos un encuentro con su divina misericordia cuando nos ponemos de rodilla frente de un sacerdote, confesamos nuestros pecados y escuchamos las bellas palabras de la absolución. Y ahora, ya que has recibido todo esa divina misericordia, Jesús te esta mandando en una misión. Ahora tu vas a traer la divina misericordia de Dios a todo el mundo. Jesús te está diciendo "Como el Padre me ha enviado, así también los envío yo" (Jn 20:21). "Sean misericordiosos como el Padre de ustedes es misericordioso" (Lc 6:36). La pregunta es esta: ¿Cómo vas a hacer eso? Viviendo con su actitud y en su Espíritu. Tienes que dejar que Él inspire todo lo que dices y haces. Para empezar, es necesario reflexionar constantemente sobre su vida y abrir tu corazón para convertirte en lo que El es. ¡Tienes que ser misericordioso con todos alrededor de ti- en tu hogar, en tu familia, en tu comunidad. Puedes empezar haciendo a todos sentir como si pueden hablar contigo y tú los vas a escuchar. Pruébalo. Acércate a alguien y diles "hola, me gustaría orar por ti, dame algo para que pueda orar por ti." Y no importa quién sea. Cada persona fuera de estas puertas es lo suficientemente importante para tener un encuentro con la divina misericordia de Cristo resucitado en ti. Cuando el Cristo Resucitado apareció a la hermana Faustina Kowalska, El nos prometió una indulgencia plenaria para que nuestros pecados sean perdonados y toda la pena temporal sea eliminada por completo. El alma será tan puro como lo fue en el día de tu bautismo. Estos son los requisitos: 1. Ve a confesión 8 días antes o después del Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. 2. Recibe la comunión durante esos 16 días. 3. Ora por las intenciones del Papa. 4. Reza la coronilla y otras devociones para venerar la sagrada imagen de la divina misericordia, o en vez de eso--en la presencia del Santísimo Sacramento reza el Padre Nuestro y el Credo, añadiendo que "Jesús Misericordioso en ti confío!"

On Sundays, the OCIA group attends Mass together with dismissal after the homily until the end of Mass.

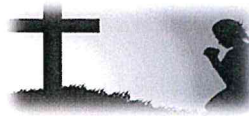
Those who have completed all their sacraments and are interested

**Mission of Light Column for 2024: LOW SUNDAY: APRIL 7; ANNUNCIATION OF THE B. V. MARY: APRIL 8.**

The name for "**Spy Wednesday**" in Holy Week, was used in Ireland and spread from thence to the U.S. The allusion seems to be to Judas Iscariot (in the passion read at Mass on that day) as traitor, "spy". *pg. 473, A Catholic Dictionary, Editor Donald Attwater.* The name "**Maundy Thursday**", in Holy Week, is corrupted from the Latin word "*Mandatum*", or commandment. It comes from the Antiphon: John 13:34, which is "*Mandatum novum do vobis: ut diligatis invicem, sicut diléxi vos,...*" "A new commandment I give unto you: That you love one another, as I have loved you,..." *Ibid., pg. 315.* This applies to the rite of foot-washing.

**LOW SUNDAY** is the first Sunday after Easter, so called in contrast to the High Feast of Easter. This Sunday is also called "*Quasimodo*", from the first words of the Introit, "*Quasi modo géniti infántes* ("As newborn babes")... Or it is called "*Dominica in Albis*"...from the fact that on this day the newly baptized had laid aside their white vestments, or "*Pascha Clausum*" because it finishes the Easter Octave. **LOW SUNDAY COLLECT:** Grant, we beseech Thee, O almighty God, that we who have celebrated the Paschal solemnity, may by Thy bounty show forth its effects in our life. *pgs. 650-651, The St. Andrew Daily Missal, Imprimi Potest, 1945, P. Joannes Delacroix, O.S.B.* **LOW SUNDAY, Sermon Program: Dogmatic Subject:** The Sacrament of Penance. -- "Receive ye the Holy Ghost. Whose sins you shall forgive, they are forgiven them; and whose sins you shall retain, they are retained. **Moral Subject:** Contrition. -- as Dogmatic Subject above. *pg. xlv, The Catechism of the Council of Trent, issued by order of Pope Saint Pius V, 1556.*

**THE ANNUNCIATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY.** It very frequently happens that March 25 falls between Palm Sunday and Low Sunday: on these occasions, the feast of our Lady's Annunciation, being out of keeping both with the dolorous mysteries of Holy Week and with the splendour of the Resurrection, is deferred to the Monday following Low Sunday [and is a Holy Day of Obligation in the Ancient Roman Rite.] *pg. 310, The Liturgical Year, Vol. 7, Abbot Guéranger, O.S.B.*

Mary's words, "May it be done unto me according to thy word," changed human history forever. Her "Yes" is called "Fiat". In Latin it means, "Let it be done" ... Mary's words were not about power, but powerlessness. It is not about increase but decrease. It is not about becoming greater but becoming smaller. In a word, it is surrender. If we can surrender that way, we become an ark like the Virgin Mary – where the same God Who became incarnate within her comes to live inside of us. *Excerpts from homily for 2023 Annunciation, by Rev. 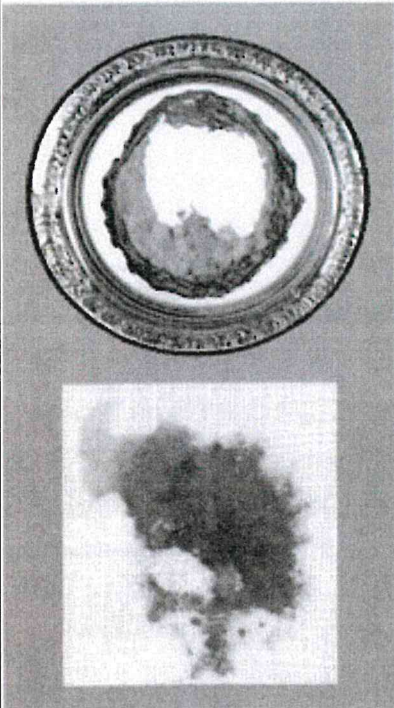
