By living out His Gospel, we help to shape a society with greater respect for human life, economic and environmental justice, cultural diversity, and global solidarity, so that we will build a church where everyone feels welcome and through it will find happiness and salvation.

Today, Jesus the Risen Christ is calling you saying "You are My witness to the Resurrection" (Lk 24:48)...So start living it. How will you witness to the resurrection? Three things. Encounter Jesus. Become Jesus. Bring Jesus.

Encounter Jesus like the disciples. Remember when Jesus said "where two or three are gathered in name, I am there among them?" (Mt 18:20) Guess what? Jesus is here... in this mass.

Jesus is also here, in the Word proclaimed. Jesus opened the disciples' minds...and Jesus opens your mind...to understand that Jesus fulfilled the scriptures. How? Jesus is the offspring of the woman who will crush the serpent's head (Gen 3:15). Jesus is Abel unjustly killed by his brother Cain (Gen 4:8). Jesus is Isaac who carried the wood for sacrifice like Jesus carried the cross (Gen 22:6). But Jesus is the lamb who will be sacrificed.

Jesus is Moses whose sacrifice will lead us on our Passover from sin into salvation. Jesus is Isaiah's suffering servant who bore our sins for our redemption (Is 53). Jesus is Jonah who will rise from the belly of the earth after 3 days (Jon 2:10) like Ezekiel's dry bones resurrected into life (Ez 37:10). And like Daniel prophesied, Jesus will overcome sin and bring us everlasting righteousness (Dn 9:24). Good to know. But that isn't enough. You have to do more than encounter Jesus. You have to become Jesus. And, you have to bring Jesus...into the world. How? Live like Jesus. Walk with Jesus. Talk like Jesus. Act like Jesus. Like St. John said in the second reading. If you really want to become like Jesus...then obey his commandments (1 Jn 2:3). "Love one another as I have loved you" (Jn 13:34). Serve one another..."Just as I have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet" (Jn 13:14). Then bring Jesus! Walk out through those doors as a witness to His resurrection.

Bring Jesus! Because...there are so many people—the drug addicts, the alcoholics, the suffering, the suicidal, even mean people who do terrible things—are all looking for the meaning and peace and salvation that come from Jesus Christ. This is your place. Bring Jesus. This is your time. Bring Jesus. Pick up your cross. Roll away the stone. And bring Jesus...the Risen Christ...to them. (over) Live like Jesus. Talk like Jesus. Act like Jesus. Love like Jesus. So that everyone you ever meet will have an encounter with the Risen Christ inside of you.

Hoy, Jesús el Cristo Resucitado te llama diciendo: "Tú eres Mi testigo de la Resurrección" (Lc 24:48) ... Así que comienza a vivirlo. ¿Cómo darás testigo a la resurrección? Tres cosas. Un encuentro con Jesús. Conviértete en Jesús. Tráelo a Jesús. Ten un encuentro con Jesús como los discípulos. ¿Recuerdas cuando Jesús dijo "donde están dos o tres reunidos en mi nombre, allí estoy yo entre ellos?" (Mt 18:20) ¿Sabes qué? Jesús está aquí ... en esta misa. Jesús también está aquí, en la Palabra proclamada. Jesús les abrió el entendimiento a los discípulos ... Jesús te abre a ti el entendimiento ... para comprender que Jesús cumplió las escrituras. ¿Cómo? Jesús es la descendencia de la mujer que pisará la cabeza de la serpiente (Gen 3:15). Jesús es Abel asesinado injustamente por su hermano Caín (Gen 4: 8). Jesús es Isaac quien cargó la leña para el sacrificio como Jesús cargó la cruz (Génesis 22: 6). Pero Jesús es el cordero que será sacrificado. Jesús es Moisés, cuyo sacrificio nos guiará en nuestra Pascua del pecado a la salvación. Jesús es el siervo sufriente de Isaías que cargó con nuestros pecados para nuestra redención (Is 53). Jesús es Jonás que se levantará del vientre de la tierra después de 3 días (Jon 2:10) como los huesos secos de Ezequiel resucitados a la vida (Ez 37:10). Y como Daniel profetizó, Jesús vencerá el pecado y nos traerá la justicia eterna (Dn 9:24).

Bueno saberlo. Pero eso no es lo suficiente. Tienes que hacer más que solo un encuentro con Jesús. Tienes que convertirte en Jesús. Y, tienes que traer a Jesús ... al mundo. Como? Vive como Jesús. Camina con Jesús. Habla como Jesús. Actúa como Jesús. Como dijo San Juan en la segunda lectura. Si de veras quieres llegar a ser como Jesús ... entonces obedece sus mandamientos (1 Jn 2: 3). "Ámense los unos a los otros como yo los he amado" (Jn 13, 34). Sírvanse los unos a otros ... "Así como yo les he lavado los pies, también ustedes deben lavarse los pies unos a otros" (Jn 13:14).

Entonces ¡Tráelo a Jesús! Sal por esas puertas como testigo de su resurrección. ¡Tráelo a Jesús! Porque ... hay tantas personas -los drogadictos, los alcohólicos, los sufrientes, los suicidas, hasta la gente mala que hacen cosas terriblesestán buscando el significado, la paz y la salvación que provienen de Jesucristo. Este es tu lugar. Tráelo a Jesús. Este es tu tiempo. Tráelo a Jesús. Recoge tu cruz. Rueda la piedra. Y Tráelo a Jesús ... el Cristo Resucitado ... a ellos. Vive como Jesús. Habla como Jesús. Actúa como Jesús. Ama como Jesús. Para que cualquiera que te conozca, tenga un encuentro con el Cristo resucitado dentro de ti.





That Sacred Ordination is to be numbered among the Sacraments of the Church, the Council of Trent has established by the same line of reasoning as we have already used several times... the Bishop, handing to him who is ordained a chalice with wine and water, and a paten with bread, says: Receive the power of offering sacrifice, etc. In these words, pronounced along with the application of the matter, the Church has always taught that the power of consecrating the Eucharist is conferred, and that the character is impressed on the soul which brings with it grace necessary for the due and

proper discharge of that office, ... pg. 295, Ibid.
NUMBER OF ORDERS. Now, to use the words of the holy Council: The ministry of so sublime a priesthood being a thing all divine, it is but befitting its worthier and more reverent exercise that in the Church's well-ordered disposition there should be several different orders of ministers destined to assist the priesthood by virtue of their officeorders arranged in such a way that those who have already received clerical tonsure should be raised up, step by step, from lower to higher orders. (Session 23. De Ord. C. 2.)

It should be taught, therefore, that these orders are seven in number, and that this has been the constant teaching of the Catholic Church. These orders are those of porter, lector, exorcist, acolyte, subdeacon, deacon and priest. That the number of ministers was wisely established thus may be proved by considering the various offices that are necessary for the celebration of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and the consecration and the administration of the Blessed Eucharist, this being the principal scope of their institution. They are divided into major or sacred, and minor orders. The major or sacred orders are priesthood, deaconship and sub-deacon; while the minor orders are those of acolyte, exorcist, lector and porter,.. The Catechism of the Council of Trent, issued by order of Pope Saint Pius V, 1556, Baronius Press, pgs. 295-296. A MAJOR ORDER, SUBDEACON. From the minor orders, which are not sacred,... one lawfully enters and ascends to major and Sacred Orders. Now the subdiaconate is the first degree of (major orders). Its function, as the name itself indicates, is to serve the deacon at the

altar... The various duties that pertain to the subdeacon are indicated by the solemn ceremonies used at his ordination. In the first place the Bishop warns him that the obligation of perpetual continence is attached to this order and declares that no one is to be admitted among the subdeacons who is not ready and willing to accept the obligation in question. Then, after the solemn recitation of the Litanies, the Bishop enumerates and explains the duties and functions of the subdeacon... the Bishop pronounces these words: See what sort of ministry is entrusted to you; I admonish you therefore, to show yourself worthy to please God. Ibid, pgs. 299-300.

THE HONOR DUE TO BISHOPS AND PRIESTS. Of Bishops and other pastors, it is written: Let the priests that rule well be esteemed worthy of double honor, especially they who labor in the word and doctrine. (1 Tim. V. 17.) ... The priest is also entitled to receive whatever is necessary for his support.... The Apostle also teaches that they are entitled to obedience: Obey your prelates...for they watch as being to render an account of your souls....lbid pgs. 381-382. Before all others, the pastors of our souls have a right to our prayers. Ibid. pg.449.
