



When Jesus comes into our hearts, anything can happen—the impossible becomes possible. The ability to resist sin and temptation becomes possible. The ability to endure suffering becomes possible. The ability to forgive becomes possible. Salvation becomes possible. So the question is: what is the best way to do that?

Jesus shows us in today's gospel. Martha welcomes Jesus into her home. She is trying to feed Jesus and his disciples—which is no easy task. Does her sister Mary help her? No. She is sitting at Jesus' feet. So Martha is stuck doing all the work. How fair is that? Is it any wonder Martha says: "Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me to do all the work by myself? Tell her to help me." What does Jesus do? This may come as a shock. He says "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing." What is He talking about? What is that one thing?

In a word: the one thing is Jesus Christ. Encounter Jesus. Welcome Jesus. Love Jesus. Hope in Jesus. Trust in Jesus. Enter into a personal relationship with Jesus. Seek His will and do His will. Assimilate Jesus into your heart so that you will become Jesus for others.

Then what does Jesus mean when he says Mary has chosen the better part? (Lk 10:41-42). What is the better part? Was it Mary just sitting at Jesus' feet doing nothing? No. She was Listening to Jesus speak. And she was speaking to Jesus. She was encountering Jesus. She was sitting at Jesus' feet and loving Jesus. That is something each of us--as His disciples--need to do more of. We need to sit at his feet, listen to him, speak to him, and encounter him—so that He becomes a part of who we are. But there has to be a balance. There has to be a balance between the two most important commandments (1) love your God, and (2) love your neighbor. Last week we heard the parable about the Good Samaritan. It's a story about how important it is to love and serve our neighbor. The priest and the Levite walked by because they were so busy loving God they overlooked loving their neighbor. In contrast, Martha is so busy serving her neighbor by working in the kitchen that she becomes self-absorbed and overlooks loving God.

The important thing to realize is that Jesus is not telling us that Martha working in the kitchen is any less important than Mary sitting at Jesus' feet. What Jesus is telling us is that if we want to serve Him, we first have to listen to Him. We need to be disciples of prayer before we can be disciples of action.

Of course both of those things need to happen at the same time. Like St. Thomas Aquinas said, in order to live a life of grace, we need a constant supply of grace. We have to keep asking for it. We have to keep praying for it.

Cuando Jesús entra en nuestro corazón, cualquier cosa puede pasar--lo imposible se hace posible. La capacidad de resistir la tentación y el pecado se hace posible. La capacidad de soportar el sufrimiento se hace posible. La capacidad de perdonar se hace posible. La salvación se hace posible. Así que la pregunta es: ¿cuál es la mejor manera de hacer eso? Jesús no los muestra en el Evangelio de hoy. Marta da la bienvenida a Jesús en su casa. Ella está tratando de alimentar a Jesús y sus discípulos--lo cual no es nada fácil. ¿Su hermana María la ayuda? No. Ella está sentada a los pies de Jesús.

Así que Marta se quedó con todo el trabajo. ¿Y eso cómo fue justo? Te sorprende que Marta dice: "Señor, ¿no te has dado cuenta de que mi hermana me ha dejado sola con todo el quehacer? Dile que me ayude."

¿Qué hace Jesús? Esto viene como una sorpresa. Él dice: "Marta, Marta, muchas cosas te preocupan y te inquietan, siendo así que una sola es necesaria."

¿De qué está hablando? ¿Qué es esa cosa? En una palabra: la única cosa es Jesucristo. Ten un encuentro con Jesús. Recíbelo a Jesús. Amalo a Jesús. Ten esperanza en Jesús. Confía en Jesús. Entra en una relación personal con Jesús. Busca su voluntad y haz su voluntad. Asimila a Jesús en tu corazón para que tu te conviertas en Jesús para los demás. Entonces, ¿qué quiere decir Jesús cuando dice que María escogió la mejor parte? (Lc 10: 41-42).

¿Cuál es la mejor parte? ¿Sera que María estaba sentada a los pies de Jesús no hacer nada? No. Ella estaba escuchando a Jesús hablar. Y ella estaba hablando con Jesús. Ella estaba teniendo un encuentro con Jesús. Estaba sentada a los pies de Jesús y amando a Jesús. Eso es algo que cada uno de nosotros - como Sus discípulos – necesitamos de hacer más. Hay que sentarnos a sus pies, escucharlo, a él, hablar con él, y tener un encuentro con él—para que Él se convierte en una parte de lo que somos. Pero tiene que haber un balance. Tiene que haber un balance entre los dos mandamientos más importantes (1) ama a tu Dios, y (2) ama a tu prójimo. La semana pasada escuchamos la parábola del buen samaritano. Es una historia sobre lo importante que es amar y servir a nuestro prójimo. El sacerdote y el levita pasaron por un lado porque estaban tan ocupados amando a Dios, que no se fijaron en amar a su prójimo. Por el contrario, Marta esta tan ocupada sirviendo a su prójimo, trabajando en la cocina, que se concentra solo en ella y no se fija en amar a Dios. Lo importante es darte cuenta de que Jesús no nos está diciendo que Marta trabaja en la cocina es menos importante que María sentada a los pies de Jesús. Lo que Jesús nos está diciendo es que si queremos servirlo, primero tenemos que escucharlo. Necesitamos ser discípulos de la oración antes de que podamos ser discípulos de acción.

Por supuesto, ambas cosas tienen que ocurrir a la misma vez. Así como dijo Santo Tomás de Aquino, para vivir una vida de gracia, se necesita una constante cantidad de gracia. Tenemos que seguir pidiendo por ella. Tenemos que seguir orando por ella.



DECREE DISPENSING FROM THE OBLIGATION TO ATTEND SUNDAY MASS

By the Grace of God and the Apostolic See, Alberto Rojas, Bishop of San Bernardino
To all the faithful of the Diocese of San Bernardino

In light of the pastoral needs of our diocese and the concerns expressed by many of our brothers and sisters regarding fears of attending Mass due to potential immigration enforcement actions by civil authorities, I, as your shepherd, issue this decree in accordance with my authority under the Code of Canon Law, particularly Canon 87 §1, which states: "A diocesan bishop, whenever he judges that it contributes to their spiritual good, is able to dispense the faithful from universal and particular disciplinary laws issued for his territory or his subjects by the supreme authority of the Church."

Recognizing that fear of immigration enforcement, such as raids by the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), may deter some members of our diocese from fulfilling the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation (cf. Canon 1247), and acknowledging that such fear constitutes a grave inconvenience that may impede the spiritual good of the faithful, I hereby decree the following:

- **Dispensation from the Obligation to Attend Mass:** All members of the faithful in the Diocese of San Bernardino who, due to genuine fear of immigration enforcement actions, are unable to attend Sunday Mass or Masses on holy days of obligation are dispensed from this obligation, as provided for in Canon 1247, until such time as this decree is revoked or amended.
- **Encouragement of Alternative Spiritual Practices:** Those dispensed from attending Mass are encouraged to maintain their spiritual communion with Christ and His Church through acts of personal prayer, reading of Sacred Scripture, or participation in devotions such as the Rosary or the Divine Mercy Chaplet. Where possible, the faithful may also participate in televised or online Masses offered by the diocese or other reputable Catholic sources.
- **Pastoral Care and Assurance:** Pastors, parochial vicars, and other pastoral ministers are to provide compassionate support to those affected by this fear, ensuring that they feel welcomed and safe in our communities. Parishes are encouraged to explore alternative means of catechesis and sacramental preparation for those unable to attend regularly.
- **Duration and Scope:** This dispensation applies to all affected faithful within the territorial boundaries of the Diocese of San Bernardino and remains in effect until further notice or until such time as the circumstances necessitating this decree are sufficiently resolved.

In issuing this decree, I am guided by the Church's mission to care for the spiritual welfare of all entrusted to my care, particularly those who face fear or hardship. I entrust this diocese to the intercession of Our Lady of Guadalupe, patroness of the Americas, and invoke God's blessing upon all the faithful.



DECRETO DE DISPENSA DE LA OBLIGACIÓN DE ASISTIR A MISA EL DOMINGO

Por la gracia de Dios y de la Sede Apostólica, Alberto Rojas, Obispo de San Bernardino,
a todos los fieles de la Diócesis de San Bernardino

En vista de las necesidades pastorales de nuestra diócesis y la preocupación que han expresado muchos de nuestros hermanos y hermanas sobre el miedo de asistir a Misa por temor a posible actividad en contra de inmigrantes por parte de las autoridades civiles, en calidad de su pastor, emito este decreto en virtud de la facultad que me confiere el Código de Derecho Canónico, en particular el Canon 87 §1, que dice: «El Obispo diocesano, siempre que, a su juicio, ello redunde en bien espiritual de los fieles, puede dispensar a éstos de las leyes disciplinarias tanto universales como particulares promulgadas para su territorio o para sus súbditos por la autoridad suprema de la Iglesia».

Considerando que el temor a las medidas de control migratorio, como las redadas por parte del Servicio de Inmigración y Control Aduanas de los Estados Unidos (ICE), puede disuadir a algunos en nuestra diócesis de cumplir con la obligación de asistir a Misa los domingos y fiestas de precepto (cf. Canon 1247), y reconociendo que dicha aprehensión constituye un grave inconveniente que puede perjudicar el bien espiritual de los fieles, por este conducto decreto lo siguiente:

- **Dispensa de la obligación de asistir a la santa Misa:** Todos los fieles de la Diócesis de San Bernardino que, debido a un temor real a las actividades de las autoridades migratorias, no puedan asistir a la santa Misa los domingos o fiestas de precepto, quedan dispensados de esta obligación, según dispone el Canon 1247, hasta que se revoque o enmiende este decreto.
- **Fomento de prácticas espirituales alternativas:** Se exhorta a quienes quedan dispensados de asistir a la santa Misa a que mantengan su comunión espiritual con Cristo y su Iglesia ofreciendo su oración personal, leyendo las Sagradas Escrituras o participando en devociones como el Santo Rosario o la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia. Siempre que sea posible, los fieles pueden también participar en misas televisadas o en línea ofrecidas por la diócesis u otras fuentes católicas reconocidas.
- **Atención y acompañamiento pastoral:** Los párrocos, vicarios parroquiales y otros ministros pastorales deben brindar apoyo compasivo a los afectados por este temor, asegurándose de que se sientan bien recibidos y seguros en nuestras comunidades. Hago un llamado a las parroquias a que exploren alternativas de catequesis y preparación sacramental para quienes no puedan asistir según el programa establecido.
- **Duración y ámbito de aplicación:** Esta dispensa favorece a todos los fieles afectados dentro de los límites territoriales de la Diócesis de San Bernardino y queda en vigor hasta nuevo aviso o hasta que las circunstancias que hacen necesario este decreto se resuelvan lo suficiente.

Siguiendo la misión de la Iglesia, emito este decreto para velar por el bien espiritual del pueblo que Dios me ha encomendado, y en particular de los que enfrentan temor o dificultades. Encomiendo esta diócesis a la intercesión de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, patrona de las Américas, e invoco la bendición de Dios sobre todos los fieles.
