

Summer 2026 Programs

Children's House Montessori

Monday to Friday, 8:15 a.m. to 11:45 a.m.

Available to children ages 3 (by 9/1/2026) through 5 years old

Session 1: June 15 to July 10 \$920 (No Class June 19 and July 3)

Session 2: July 13 to August 7 \$1,020

An extension of our school year program, summer Montessori is the ideal introduction for newly enrolled students and those returning to Children's House in the fall. Taught by our Montessori certified instructors, this offers all the elements of our authentic school year program, including time outdoors in our natural playscape and garden.

This program often fills to capacity quickly; therefore, **only children enrolled at NSMS for the 26/27 school year will be accepted in the summer Montessori program.** Participating students must be independently toileting (no diapers/ pull ups) before summer programming begins. If your child will be in first grade in fall 2026, they are encouraged to enroll in the Elementary Explorers programs.

Elementary Explorers

Available to children ages 6 (by 9/1/2026) through 12 years old

Open to Montessori students entering first grade+ in fall of 2026. Combat the summer brain drain with daily academics, work in the garden, and themed weekly camps. Each day will start with guided reading followed by planned activities led by our multi talented staff.

Registration will be available in early February, 2026. Please register children individually for their program, and secure programming with a \$100 per child deposit via Paypal. The remaining balance will be invoiced through FACTS incidental billing in mid April. You will receive a 10 day email notice prior to the April invoice through FACTS.

Cancellations and program changes must be submitted at least 14 days prior to the program start date and are subject to a \$25 administration fee. There will be no refunds for programs canceled with less than 14 days' notice. The cancellation policy is not dependent on the status of summer program waitlists.
