From the desk of the Administrator... Greetings! Hope everyone is off to a great year, anyone ready for spring yet? This month I'm sharing the Water/Sewer, Electric rate adjustments, trash, and recycling updates. Both Water & Sewer funds completed cost of service studies this past year that reviewed each funds financial wellness and outlook. Our goal as a utility is to provide reliable and safe drinking water while being fiscal responsible to make sure, we sustain our operations. Because Village Council has done a great job of getting our rates where they need to be, there will be no rate increase for water and sewer in 2026. However, in 2027 and 2028 the Water minimum usage (0-2000) will increase 2% year to year. In addition, the Sewer at this time is not expected to increase. The 1st reading on the proposed Water/Sewer rate changes will be on January 26th, the Village will hold 3 readings on this legislation and will be in effect **March 1st 2026**. *The minimum allowance (0-2000 gallons) will be increasing \$0.81 in **2027** and \$0.82 in **2028** as of now. We will be monitoring our rates each year (s) to make sure we stay on course.

*There will be **no** rate increase to our sewer rates for 2026-2028 as of now. The Village will be conducting an asset management plan/condition assessment this year as we continue to focus on improving our infrastructure, we will review our rates throughout the year (s) to make sure we stay on course.

2025 vs 2026 Electric

For 2025, the cost per kilo-watt hour (kWh) was 11.671 cents with a \$26.00/mo. customer charge. Per Ordinance 2023-006, the customer charge will increase from \$26.00 to \$30.00/mo. and the cost per kilo-watt hour (kWh) decreases to 11.738 cents. In addition, our Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) will continue which enable us to adjust rates based on power supply costs allowing the raising or lowering the power charge as needed. Currently our PCA is a negative (**\$0.0010/kWh**)

Bill Example: 850 kWh Residential Usage

850 kWh	Rate
Customer Charge	\$30.00
Energy Charge (.11738 - .0010) *850kWh	\$98.92
KW Tax	\$3.95
Total	\$132.88

*Under existing rates, 850 kWh usage would be \$129.15. The new rate as shown above, will make the total \$132.88, which is a \$3.72 increase for a customer that used 850 kWh. This will be in effect **March 1st, 2026** (February's Usage).

Trash and Recycling

Per Ordinance 2024-005, The Trash and Recycling will increase on March 1st.

*As a reminder, trash bags will be phased out on **March 1st, 2027** and the Village will be strictly totes from then on.

**Additional reminder for everyone using the Recycle Center on Jerry Dr.: Please break down all cardboard boxes before placing them in the bins. This helps ensure there's enough space for everyone and keeps the area respectful for all who use it.
