From the desk of the Administrator...

Hello July and this coming July 4th, we celebrate the 250th Anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. This once in a lifetime milestone marks a quarter- millennium of American self-government and the life, liberty, and pursuit of happiness!

As we are in the warmer part of the year, construction tends to follow, so for this month, I would like to share and remind everyone of our Zoning Regulations.

Jackson Center Zoning Regulations

- Before constructing home, building, addition, storage building, fence, pool, sign, or making other improvements to your property, contact the **Village Zoning Enforcement Officer**, Ed Maxwell at [937-596-6314](tel:937-596-6314)
- **No building or other structure** shall be erected, moved, added to, or structurally altered; nor shall any building, structure, or land be established or changed in use; nor shall any accessory use or structure, sign, or swimming pool be installed without a **Zoning Permit** issued by the Zoning Enforcement Officer.
- Zoning Permit Applications can be found at the Village Office or on the Village's website (<https://www.jacksoncenter.com/zoning-regulations>)
- Residential Zoning Permit Application and filing fee is **\$25.00** & Commercial/industrial is **\$50.00**
- Zoning Permits issued by the Village, **are not replacements** for Building Permits.
- Building permits are required for a variety of items. If you are planning to construct a new building or make a change to your property in the Village, you may obtain all the necessary information and forms at the "one stop" customer service counter at the **Sidney-Shelby County Board of Health Office, 202 W. Poplar St., Sidney, OH**
- A Zoning Permit **is** required to obtain a Building Permit!

If you have a project in mind and you're not sure, please don't hesitate to reach out to the Village Zoning Enforcement Officer, Ed Maxwell. For your protection and the protection of your neighbors, we encourage you to reach out! The **goal** of Zoning is not to prohibit progress but to do so that it protects you and your neighbors!
