



From the desk of the Administrator...

Greetings! We are quickly approaching the 1st day of Spring (March 20th), which I don't know about you, but I'm ready for warmer weather!

This month, I would like to provide an update about your March 1st Electric bills and the Power-Cost-Adjustment (PCA) review.

For 2025, the cost per kilo-watt hour (kWh) was .11771 cents with a \$26.00/mo. customer charge. Per Ordinance 2023-006, the customer charge will increase from \$26.00 to \$30.00/mo. and the cost per kilo-watt hour (kWh) decreases to .11738 cents. In addition, our Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) will continue which enable us to adjust rates based on power supply costs allowing the raising or lowering the power charge as needed. After analyzing, the PCA is a positive rate of **\$0.0050/kWh for the next 6-months (February 2026 through July 2026)**

The purpose of the Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) ensures that all power supply related costs are collected from customers. This is accomplished by reviewing the projected power supply costs from previous six (6) months and comparing them to actual power supply costs for the same period. The next task involves comparing the actual power supply revenue to actual power supply costs for the previous six months to assess if revenue collected all power supply costs. The third task is to project energy sales for the projected six-month period. The fourth task is to project power supply costs for the projected six-month period.

Below is an example showing you the cost per kilo-watt hour with the new PCA rate of \$0.0050/kWh.

Bill Example: 850 kWh Residential Usage

850 kWh	Rate
Customer Charge	\$30.00
Energy Charge (.11738 +.0050) *850kWh	\$104.023
KW Tax	\$3.95
Total	\$137.97
