



ORDINANCE 2026-009

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS IN THE 2026 ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS OF PUBLIC FUNDS FOR THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2026 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the Annual Appropriations for the year 2026, certain expenditures have differed from the anticipated expenditures; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1.

That within the **Cemetery Fund**, appropriations be **transferred** in the amount of **\$2,000** from appropriation account code 2031-240-400-0000 – Other Supplies and Materials to appropriation account code 2031-240-300-000 – Contractual Services. The purpose of this transfer is to provide appropriations to pay for mowing and trimming at the cemetery. This transfer does not change the appropriation budget for the cemetery fund and all funds will remain the same.

SECTION 2.

That Council hereby declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare; such an emergency arising out of the need to amend appropriations to be able to mow and trim at the cemetery. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by Council and approved by the Mayor.
