



RESOLUTION 2026-009

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINSTRATOR TO EXECUTE AND FILE AN APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL ASSITANCE WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF NATRUAL RESOURCES THROUGH THE LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND AND DECALARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the federal **Land and Water Conservation Fund** program, and;

WHEREAS, The Village of Jackson Center desires financial assistance under the Land and Water Conservation Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON CENTER, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1.

That the Council of the Village of Jackson Center approves filing this application for financial assistance.

SECTION 2.

That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

SECTION 3.

That the Council of the Village of Jackson Center does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the Land and Water Conservation Fund.

SECTION 4.

That Council hereby declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare; such an emergency arising out of the need to timely apply for financial assistance. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.
