

POP

The Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 June 2019 on **persistent organic pollutants** (abbreviated as POP) concerns the substances listed in Annexes I and II, which are harmful and dangerous to human health and the environment. The EU has created a regulation for these substances with Regulation No. 2019/1021/EU.

„Chemicals that have been identified as POPs include:

- *Pesticides (such as DDT)*
- *Industrial chemicals (such as polychlorinated biphenyls, which were widely used in electrical equipment)*
- *Unintended by-products resulting from industrial processes, decomposition or combustion (e.g. dioxins and furans)¹*

As a wholesaler and specialist retailer of screws, nuts and fasteners, we do not deal in items that fall under Regulation No. 2019/1021/EU.

We can confirm that our entire product range is free from persistent organic pollutants. Our range is based on various metals (Fe, Al, Cu), metal alloys (e.g. material 1.4305), various surfaces (galvanized, nickel-plated) and POP-free plastics (**without additives**) such as

PA = Polyamide

PE = Polyethylen

PEEK = Polyether ether ketone

PC = Polycarbonate

PVDF = Polyvinylidene-fluoride (not ECHA-listed)

PPS = Polyphenylene sulfide

Reny = glass-fiber-reinforced polyamide MXD6

PVC = polyvinyl chloride

Any contamination with POPs, should this occur, is attributable to environmental influences after delivery for which Schrauben-Preisinger GmbH is not responsible.
