2. New Business:

Town Hall Meeting

Due to the church shooting in Minnesota recently, Fr. Matt shared that the Diocese has provided each parish with guidelines for Parish Safety and Security. Our immediate plans include camera(s) and locking down the parish center when students are in the building. Further investigation will take place.

Parish Picnic

Annual Picnic was moved this year from July to September. It will take place on Saturday, September 27th from 12-3:30. There will be a flyer in the bulletin on 9/14. Gift baskets will be offered again this year. Request to make donations of gift baskets will be added to the flyer.

Trivia Night

Will take place on Saturday, November 8, 2025 after the 4 pm Mass. There will be two parts - Catholic trivia and Raynham trivia. In between will be music trivia. There will be pot luck with folks asked to sign up to bring food. There will be raffles.

- 3. Faith Formation update- Getting ready to kick off the year. Registrations are consistent with the past few years for students attending grades 1-9. We have 23 teachers working with our students and a few more volunteers helping out with the office/operations. We added Venmo this year as a form of payment. It has been very well received.
- 4. Deacon's Report Deacon Joe updated us as to the current class of Deacons. They are in Year 3 (of a 4 year program). There are currently 11 men in the program. As this group is heading towards their ordination, the next class is beginning.
