Role Overview	<p>Responsible for the patient care activities and related nursing services necessary in caring for the personal needs, safety, and comfort of the patient, as assigned.</p> <p>Reports to the Aide Coordinator</p>
Location	Daviess, Hancock, Hopkins, Muhlenberg Counties, KY
Core Responsibilities	<p>The responsibilities of this position enumerated below, involve significant physical activities including standing, sitting, lifting (up to 50 pounds unassisted), bending, stooping, pushing, pulling, twisting, manual and finger dexterity and eye-hand coordination. May be exposed to infectious waste/diseases, to include but not limited to TB, AIDS, COVID, and Hepatitis B viruses. Must be willing to work beyond normal working hours and on weekends and holidays when necessary.</p> <p>DUTIES:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Provides personal patient care (bathing, grooming hair, brushing teeth or dentures, shaving, dressing, etc.) and light housekeeping, if needed - Maintains regular communication with the Aide Coordinator and/or Case Manager to update patient conditions. - Works as part of an interdisciplinary team - Other duties as needed
Qualifications Needed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Completion of Nursing Assistant Certification program or proof of valid certification - Health care experience desired, preferably in a home care setting - CPR certification required - Must be able to pass background checks
Skills Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Communication Skills: Ability to convey information, both written and verbal, clearly and effectively and be able to work in a team - Must exemplify the core values of HPC, which include: hard-working, thorough, accountable, joyful, lighthearted, humorous, fun, eager to serve with compassion, respectful, encouraging, and empowering to everyone, including self
