Title: The Power of the Blood

Main Point 1: The Necessity of Blood for Cleansing

Summary: Forgiveness requires blood shed; no remission

without it.

Application: Accept Christ's cleansing blood.

Learning: Sin demands substitutionary payment.

Main Point 2: The Sanctifying Power of Blood

Summary: Blood sets apart believers holy unto God.

Application: Live as sanctified saints.

Learning: Holiness stems from Christ's blood.

Main Point 3: The Limitation of Old Blood Sacrifice and Promise of Redemption

Summary: Only blood sheds forgiveness of sins fully.

Application: Trust Christ's ultimate sacrifice.

Learning: The blood secures eternal redemption.

Call to Action

- Reflect on cleansing.
- Persist in holiness.

- Live anticipating Christ's return.

 - Reflect: Do I see my need for cleansing?
 - Apply: Journal confessions with gratitude.

- Focus: Realize sanctification (Hebrews 9:22).
- Reflect: Am I committed to God's holy law?
 - Apply: Choose one obedience goal.

Wednesday:

- Focus: Response in action.
- Reflect: How do I obey practically this week?
 - Apply: Serve or pray specifically.
 Thursday:
 - Focus: Commitment consistency.
 - Reflect: Am I a doer or passive hearer?
 - Apply: Set faithfulness goals.

Friday:

- Focus: Celebrate blood's work.
- Reflect: How has God blessed me this week?
 - Apply: Share testimony publicly.
