Casket Interment Services

Full Service includes: lead in and attendant; opening and closing of the grave, crypt or mausoleum; one tent; 12 chairs; lowering device; artificial grass covering; and runners to tent during inclement weather.

No Interments on Sundays or the following Holidays:

New Years Day, Easter, Memorial Day (*Observed*), Fourth of July, Labor Day (*Observed*), Thanksgiving and Christmas.

An outer burial container is required for all ground burials, a vault is required for all double depth burials.

Notification and Authorization: Prior to the interment or entombment, the person(s) legally responsible for the final disposition of the deceased must sign the interment authorization and be present at the cemetery to confirm the location for interment. Authorization must be executed on forms provided by the cemetery no later than 48 hours prior to the scheduled interment service. Failure to authorize within said time may cause the interment to be postponed.

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THE INTERMENT SERVICE FEE

Listed below are many operations and/or costs involved in performing this service properly.

1. Discuss the arrangements for burial with your funeral director and/or family member.
2. Examine the record of lot owner to determine ownership.
3. Check permanent files for any special instructions issued by lot owner or affidavits affecting the burial.
4. Make necessary telephone calls.
5. Make entry in interment log.
6. Prepare interment order authorizing burial.
7. Record the interment in cemetery records system.
8. Prepare instructions to superintendent for grave opening operation.
9. Staff must perform a layout assessment of grave for family's verification.
10. An independent staff member, after the family has verified the site, will perform a blind check of the site and match to records to ensure appropriate site has been laid out and flagged.
11. Deliver necessary equipment to grave site (canvas and boards to protect surrounding areas and hand tools and wheelbarrows, as needed, power equipment and tools for breaking hard ground).
12. Excavate interment space, by machine or by hand if necessary.
13. Haul away surplus dirt, dump and level dirt.
14. Haul away all digging equipment.
15. Help set up lowering device, casket carrier, artificial turf, and chairs, when needed.
16. Direct driver delivering vault and assist, when necessary, in placing vault.
17. Attendants assist in carrying and arranging flowers, when necessary.
18. Attendant leads funeral cortege from entrance to interment site and remains with casket until the vault is covered.
19. Staff to supervise parking of cars.
20. Waiting time of attendant and grounds crew.
21. Staff members needed to help close outer burial container after service, help remove lowering device, fill in grave and assist in rearranging flowers.
22. Superintendent supervises and checks entire service.
23. Remove excess dirt and clean up grave site.
24. Remove flowers when wilted.
25. When necessary, remove snow from area around grave and clear path from road to grave, as well as clearing roads.
26. Refills and seeds grave after the interment.
