4-WAY STOP INTERSECTION

The intersection of Springfield Street and Troy Street is now a four-way stop. Stop signs at South Springfield and Troy have been reinstalled to help slow traffic entering town and improve safety for motorists and pedestrians. Drivers are reminded to use caution, follow posted signs, and yield appropriately when approaching the intersection.

CHAMPAIGN COUNTY 911 UPDATE

The Champaign Countywide 911 Center has launched a new emergency alert system, Everbridge, following the retirement of CodeRED after last year’s security breach.

Residents must register again to receive alerts — previous CodeRED registrations will not transfer. The system sends emergency notifications by text, email, desktop alert, and phone call.
