## NEW COMMUNICATION SYSTEM FOR VILLAGE RESIDENTS

The village of St. Paris is excited to announce **St. Paris Connect**, a new notification communication system launching **at the beginning of January**. This system will deliver important updates to residents by voice call or text message.

Alerts will include village news, special events, water service disruptions, boil advisories, snow removal updates, road closures, account and service information, and more.

To ensure you receive these notifications, **please provide the Village with your current phone number**. Keeping your contact information up to date helps us reach you quickly when important information becomes available.

## WINTER REMINDER: SNOW & ICE REMOVAL IN THE VILLAGE

During heavy snowfall, the Village prioritizes keeping main roads clear first, including Springfield, Main, Troy, and High. Crews may make multiple passes on these high-traffic roads during a storm to ensure safe travel. Secondary roads like Lynn, Plum, Church, and Elm are cleared once main roads are passable.

Please note: plowing moves snow, it doesn't eliminate it – so you may notice snow pushed along streets and into driveways. Keep a shovel handy, and plan for a little extra time during your morning commute.

Don't forget to clear fire hydrants near your home for emergency access. Your patience and cooperation help keep the community safe during winter weather.
