WATER BILLS ARE DUE ON THE 28TH OF EACH MONTH

There are Many Ways to Pay

Your St. Paris water/sewer bill is due on the 28th of each month. There are several ways for you to pay this bill at your convenience. First of all, you can always come into our office and pay in person Mon. – Fri. 8:00 – 4:00. We accept cash, checks, Visa, Mastercard and Discover. A check can always be place in the drop box attached to the Northeast corner of the Municipal Building day or night. Residents can set up an account online by going to the Village website www.stparisohio.org. If you need help setting up an account, please feel free to call 937-663-4329. Payments can also be accepted over the phone with a credit card. There is no fee charge to you for using a credit card. If you decide to mail your payment, be aware that all mail goes to Columbus for processing before being place in your mailbox unless you place your mail in the ST. PARIS slot **inside** the post office. In that case it will most likely reach us the next day. FYI: If you pay online, there isn't a charge for this service. Some customers have been intercepted by a third party while paying online and are being charged a service fee. Be Careful!!

ST. PARIS ORDINANCE #904

Passed July, 2019

St. Paris Village Council passed an ordinance prohibiting disposal of leaves, grass and other waste matter into storm sewers within the Village of St. Paris, Ohio.

Ordinance #904 is hereby established, containing the following provisions:

- a) No person shall dispose or discharge waste matter including, but not limited to, leaves, grass clippings, waste oil or other non-aqueous materials into the street.
- b) Failure to comply with this section shall be deemed a minor misdemeanor, and each day of non-compliance shall be deemed a separate offense.
- c) A third violation of this section, charged within a two-year period as measured from the conviction date of the first offense, shall be deemed a third degree misdemeanor.
