ST. PARIS ORDINANCE #904

Passed July, 2019

St. Paris Village Council passed an ordinance prohibiting disposal of leaves, grass and other waste matter into storm sewers within the Village of St. Paris, Ohio.

Ordinance #904 is hereby established, containing the following provisions:

- a) No person shall dispose or discharge waste matter including, but not limited to, leaves, grass clippings, waste oil or other non-aqueous materials into the street.
- b) Failure to comply with this section shall be deemed a minor misdemeanor, and each day of non-compliance shall be deemed a separate offense.
- c) A third violation of this section, charged within a two-year period as measured from the conviction date of the first offense, shall be deemed a third degree misdemeanor.

PONY WAGON DAYS

On Thursday, September 7 The Pony Wagon Days Parade will march down Main Street heading east starting at High Street. After the parade, there will be the traditional basket auction held at the Municipal Building. The downtown area will be closed off from traffic for games and food venders. On Saturday September 9 the festivities continue on S. Springfield Street with food venders, crafters, games and a car show. Every Other Wednesday at Dusk

Every other Wednesday beginning on May 10, 2023 St. Paris will be sprayed for mosquitoes with A1 Able Pest Doctors using Aqua PermX 30/30. The following dates are scheduled for St. Paris: June 7 & 21, July 5 & 19, August 2, 16 & 30, September 13 & 27. From time to time the date may be changed due to rain. Generally, the rain date is the following day.
