Honorary Pallbearers – You may want to list a group name. Examples: The deceased's Sunday School Class or A Civic Organization that the deceased attended_
There is a place in the service folder that the family may put a special poem, Bible chapter like Psalm 23, or lyrics of a song. What would your family like to use?
When selecting clothing for a burial, long sleeves and conservative necklines are best. When you go to the funeral home to make the funeral arrangements, you should take the clothing for the deceased including undergarments. You will also want to take a photo of the deceased that you would like used on the website and the service folder. Pictures from cell phones can also be used.
