The Dogtor's Orders: National Pet Week and Encouraging Pet Health

After the Running of the Roses, May is about celebrating National Pet Week (May 4-10), which was started by The American Veterinary Medical Association. As part of National Pet Week, we want to talk about pet behavioral health.

Whether it's a new puppy/kitten or an adult



dog/cat joining your family, there's always an adjustment period. During this time, pets may "act out" or display unwanted behaviors such as biting, scratching, or digging. While these can be seen as behavioral issues, this may be the first time these animals are in a home, having only known kennels or the streets. These behaviors could simply indicate that your pet needs more stimulation. In addition to having patience, enrichment items may help to resolve some of these issues. Enrichment items provide an outlet for these behaviors and encourage healthy play for your pet. The key to enrichment items is providing your pet with lots of options and activities until you find what they like the most. Your pet will be happier and healthier.

Enrichment items are especially necessary for the dogs and cats still waiting at the shelter to be adopted. You can help shelter animals by making enrichment items either at home or at MAS for some furry friends.
