Not All Heroes Wear Capes, But Ours Do! Long-Stay Champions Program

Champions are individuals who have overcome obstacles, succeeded despite adversity, and risen above the rest. Metro Animal Services (MAS) is full of animals that we consider "Champions." To help these animals succeed and find their furever home, FOMAS funds the Long-Stay Champions Program, which focuses on animals that have been at the shelter for at least 45 days or longer.



The average length of stay at MAS for dogs is 14 days, while the average stay for cats is 9 days. While some animals find their homes within this time period, some animals are unfortunately overlooked. There are several factors, like size, age, and health condition, that impact how soon animals at the shelter are adopted. Our Long-Stay Champions Program is intended to highlight those animals so that we can improve their odds at getting adopted.

In addition to FOMAS covering the adoption fee, adopters who take home a Champion receive a free VIP package valued at over \$500. The VIP Package includes items such as: core vaccinations (covered for 3 years); Jefferson County Pet license (3-Year); heartworm preventative (6 months supply); a freedom harness with a leash; a bag of starter food; and a large crate (upon request). This package sets the Champion's new family up for success with their newest member. If you are looking to grow your family, please consider meeting a Champion. These animals have a lot to offer a loving family.



A Peek into the Void: Black Cats' Bad Reputation and Troubling History

With Halloween quickly approaching, we wanted to take a minute to explore the history and superstitions surrounding black cats. While in places like Egypt and Japan, black cats are generally associated with good luck, black cats have been widely associated with bad omens in many cultures. In medieval Europe, they were considered witches' companions, and this connection to witchcraft made them targets during the Salem Witch trials in North America. During the Bubonic Plague, black cats were hunted and blamed for the epidemic, when in reality, they were some of the best frontline fighters against the spread. As Halloween became a more mainstream holiday throughout the world, black cats were used as a poster child for the spooky and mysterious.



This is all fun and games until it impacts an animal's ability to get adopted. Some studies have found a historic "Black Cat Bias" that resulted in a higher rate of euthanasia and a lower rate of adoption for these furry felines, which was likely due to superstition and mythology. The good news is that the narrative for black cats appears to be shifting in recent years. Black cat adoption rates appear to be on the rise for the first time in history.

During the month of October, we want to shine a light on black cats and combat any historic misconceptions about these loveable and playful creatures. Let's finally embrace these cats and dispel the old myths surrounding them. So if a black cat crosses your path don't let it ruin your day, embrace it!
