WHAS11 Telethon: A Day of Difference



The Friends of Metro Animal Services (FOMAS)/WHAS11 Telethon was a powerful display of the community coming together for animals in need. We are immensely grateful for the generosity displayed on August 27th by the community. Over the course of 14 hours, more than 260 donors joined forces with us, along with volunteers, WHAS11, and Metro Animal Services (MAS) to raise over \$31,000. This generosity will transform an old salt dome on MAS property into an indoor dog enrichment area, giving shelter dogs a safe place to go during inclement weather throughout the year.

This project will provide far more than shelter. It will give dogs the freedom to be themselves. With space to run, play, and interact, the enrichment

area will ease stress, improve health, and help each dog shine, making them more adoptable and increasing their chances of finding forever homes. Moreover, the telethon raised awareness about volunteering, fostering, and adoption. Thanks to the incredible impact of the telethon, countless dogs will now have a better chance at finding their forever homes. 
