We have had many new families join the parish over this past year and this is such a great way to come together and strengthen the bonds of laith and fellowship among us. It's a community pot luck so bring something to share. The Knights of Columbus will be providing their famous BBQ including hamburgers and hotdogs. Come and enjoy a really fun afternoon.

AT ST. JUDE IN REDMOND, SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 7 AT 10:30 AM WE CELEBRATE THE BIRTH OF MARY, OUR LADY OF VELANKANNI AND ALL THE WAYS BLESSED VIRGIN MARY HAS MANIFESTED HERSELF ACROSS THE WORLD AS THE MOTHER OF GOD AND OUR MOTHER.

Our Lady of Velankanni is also known as Our Lady of Good Health. In approving devotion to Our Lady of Velankanni, the Vatican wrote: "There are beautiful traditions ascribed to the encounters that the Virgin had with poor and sick boys at this place of worship. Thus, the tenderness and closeness of Mary, whom Jesus desired to bequeath us as Mother of all, is manifested.

Through her intercession, Jesus Christ often pours out his strength and restores health to the sick. For this reason, in 2002, Saint John Paul II chose that place for the celebration of the World Day of the Sick. Thus the same Virgin Mary who manifested herself at Lourdes also manifested herself in India as the Mother of Health.

It is not merely a matter of bodily health, but also one that touches the soul. Contemplating the image of Mary we can all recognize the love of Jesus Christ that can heal our sadness, our anguish and our fears. If we pause before Mary, even in a brief moment of faith and love, her maternal gaze restores peace to us.

The first account, which is ancient, is filled with rich symbolism because the boy to whom Mary showed herself offered her the milk he had brought with him for the Child she was carrying in her arms. This was an expression of the generosity of those who are willing to give something to others, in their own poverty. You do not need to have much in order to be generous. May this call to share, to assist, to be close to those who need us always resonate in this place. Mary loves the generosity of her children, who put into action the words of Jesus: "What you did to one of the least of my brothers, you did to me" (Mt 25, 40)."

The celebrations will begin on **Sunday at 10:30AM** in the lower parking lot with a procession and rosary. All will be invited to process, singing and following the statue into the Church. The procession will include images of Mary from around the world from the various different cultures represented in at St. Jude. It will be a celebration of the universality of our Catholic faith and love of the Blessed Mother. Then the rosary will be led in different languages. At 11AM the Mass will begin and it will be followed by a meal downstairs in the Parish Hall. Please join us in asking the Blessed Mother's protection and healing upon our families and our parish.

Many thanks to all who are working so hard to prepare these celebrations. Come and pitch in, too! Many hands make light work. So, I urge us all to rest awhile in the Lord this weekend. Let us pray together, get to know one another, and celebrate our shared Catholic faith.





# NEXT SUNDAY! September 7, 2025 Lady of Velankanni Feast Day Celebration

Christianity has thrived in India since Saint Thomas the Apostle arrived in 52 A.D. In the 16th century, the Blessed Mother Mary appeared three times in Velankanni, a coastal village in southern India, sparking hundreds of reported miracles.

For over 400 years, the annual feast on September 8th has drawn nearly 3 million pilgrims. The celebrations begin with flag hoisting, followed by nine days of novena, and culminate in a procession of Our Lady of Velankanni's statue.

On November 3, 1962, Pope John XXIII elevated the shrine to Basilica status, calling it the "Lourdes of the East." Today, Velankani remains one of India's most visited religious sites, where Hindus, Muslims, and Christians worship together—a powerful symbol of faith, unity, and healing.


# Figure 2 Employment Connections Needed





# Ways to Give

## QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION

A qualified charitable distribution (QCD) is a direct transfer of funds from your IRA custodian, payable to a qualified charity. A QCD excludes the amount donated from taxable income, which is unlike regular withdrawals from an IRA. QCDs don't require that you itemize, which due to recent tax law changes, means you may decide to take advantage of the higher standard deduction but still use a QCD for charitable giving.

#### **IRA DISTRIBUTIONS (RMD)**

By utilizing an IRA for charitable giving, you can satisfy your required minimum distribution (RMD) obligations starting at age 73, while also supporting a cause you care about. The donated amount is excluded from your taxable income, which can provide a tax advantage, especially if you do not itemize deductions.
