## GAUDETE SUNDAY

Dear friends in Christ,

This weekend we celebrate Gaudete Sunday, the third Sunday of Advent, and we rejoice in the nearness of the Lord. Rose vestments are worn and the reading exhorts us to rejoice always. Today, I offer you a reflection of this Advent Sunday given by Pope Benedict in 2011. He offers us a wonderful reflection on the nature of the "Joy" with which we await the coming of the Lord:

*The liturgy of this Sunday, known as "Gaudete" Sunday, is a special invitation to us to joyfulness, to a vigilance that is not sad but happy. "Gaudete in Domino semper", St Paul wrote: "Rejoice in the Lord always" (Phil 4:4). True joy is not a fruit of "divertirsi" [having a good time] understood in the etymological sense of the word divertere (di-version), that is, shirking the commitments of life and one's responsibilities.*

*True joy is linked to something deeper. Of course, in the all too often frenetic pace of daily life it is important to find time for rest and relaxation, but true joy is linked to our relationship with God. Those who have encountered Christ in their own lives feel a serenity and joy in their hearts that no one and no situation can take from them. St Augustine understood this very well; in his quest for truth, peace and joy, after seeking them in vain in many things he concluded with his famous words: "and our heart is restless until it rests in God" (Confessions, I, 1, 1).*

*True joy is not merely a passing state of mind or something that can be achieved with the person's own effort; rather it is a gift, born from the encounter with the living Person of Jesus and, making room within ourselves, from welcoming the Holy Spirit who guides our lives. It is the invitation of the Apostle Paul who says: "May the God of peace himself sanctify you wholly; and may your spirit and soul and body be kept sound and blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Thess 5:23).*

*In this Season of Advent let us reinforce our conviction that the Lord has come among us and ceaselessly renews his comforting, loving and joyful presence. We should trust in him; as St Augustine says further, in the light of his own experience: the Lord is closer to us than we are to ourselves: "interior intimo meo et superior summo meo" ("higher than my highest and more inward than my innermost self") (Confessions III, 6, 11).*

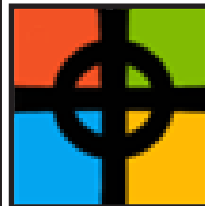

## Putting Faith into Action Across Western Washington

### Addressing Homelessness with Compassion and Care

Across Washington state, homelessness continues to rise, with a 25% increase in our homeless population since 2022. Our neighbors experiencing homelessness deserve love, respect, and solutions. CCS provides comprehensive, innovative support to help our neighbors find long-term stability. Our Family Housing Network helps families like Michelle and Brent, who you read about in our most recent letter, quickly transition from homelessness to stable housing. This spring, our Junction Point shelter added 40 new pallet beds for adults experiencing homelessness. Junction Point resident Lisa says, "Junction Point is very uplifting — it gives you a reason to want to do better."

### Stepping Up to Serve Critical Nutrition

As thousands of our neighbors across Western Washington lose access to federally funded SNAP benefits, CCS remains committed to serving our neighbors facing food insecurity with love and compassion. In July, we welcomed the Queen Anne Food Bank into our program network to ensure it has the support and resources it needs to continue its decades of impact. With CCS, the Food Bank has been able to remain a vital part of their community, serving an average of 125 people every weekday. For seniors facing food insecurity, our Home Delivered Meals program brings food right to their doorstep. One senior with the Home Delivered Meals program, Sarada, says, "Catholic Community Services is a godsend."

### Providing Housing that is Stable, Affordable, and Permanent

Housing affordability is a growing problem in Western Washington. That's why CCS provides permanent affordable housing for our neighbors unable to otherwise access housing. Our housing sites are home to neighbors of all ages and backgrounds and include housing dedicated to families, farmworkers, people with disabilities, and veterans. One family living in farmworker housing is Maria, Daniel, and their two young sons. In a Catholic Housing Services home, they've finally found a safe place to raise their family. "Catholic Housing Services is a great help and made a big difference for our family," Daniel says.

## Ways to Give Beyond Cash

### QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION (QCD)

A QCD is a direct transfer of funds from your IRA custodian, payable to a qualified charity. A QCD excludes the amount donated from taxable income, which is unlike regular withdrawals from an IRA. QCDs don't require that you itemize, which due to recent tax law changes, means you may decide to take advantage of the higher standard deduction but still use a QCD for charitable giving.

### IRA

By utilizing an IRA for charitable giving, you can satisfy your required minimum distribution (RMD) obligations starting at age 73, while also supporting a cause you care about. The donated amount is excluded from your taxable income, which can provide a tax advantage, especially if you do not itemize deductions.

### DONOR-ADVISED FUNDS (DAF)

A DAF is like a charitable investment account for the sole purpose of supporting charitable organizations. When you contribute cash, securities or other assets to a donor advised fund, you are generally eligible to take an immediate tax deduction. Funds are disbursed at your discretion.

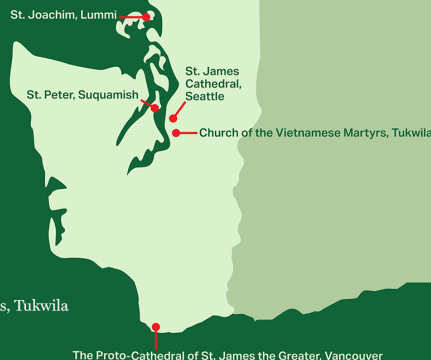

In union with bishops throughout the world, Archbishop Etienne will celebrate a solemn Mass marking the end of the local observance of the Jubilee Year 2025 at St. James Cathedral in Seattle.

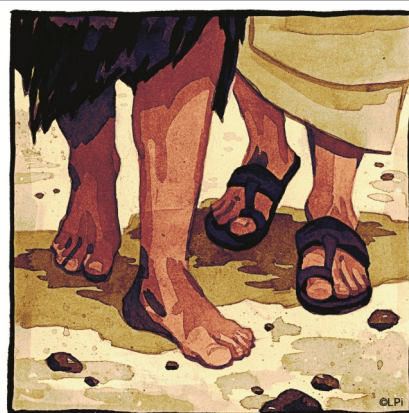
