Dear friends in Christ,

This Sunday is already the Fourth Sunday of Lent. Holy week begins in just two weeks. It is important to get ready. One the best ways we can prepare to celebrate these Holy Days is by going to Confession, asking God's grace to do a little spring cleaning of our souls. The Penance Service at Holy Innocents was this last Thursday, but **this Monday there is another opportunity for Confession at the PENANCE SERVICE AT 7 PM AT ST. JUDE. Six confessors will be there, so this will be the ideal opportunity. Holy Innocents and St Jude both have Confessions on Fridays from 6-6:50 PM during Lent.** St. Anthony in Carnation will have a special time coming up, too. Let us heed the central message of Jesus' teaching: "Repent and believe the good news."

Pope Francis loved the Sacrament of Reconciliation. He frequently encouraged everyone to approach the Lord Jesus in the sacrament and experience the mercy of the Lord and be reconciled to God. He wrote: *Do not be afraid of Confession! When one is in line to go to Confession, one feels all these things, even shame, but then when one finishes Confession one leaves free, grand, beautiful, forgiven, candid, happy. Go, the priest will be good. Jesus is there, and Jesus is more benevolent than priests, Jesus receives you, he receives you with so much love. Be courageous and go to Confession! POPE FRANCIS*

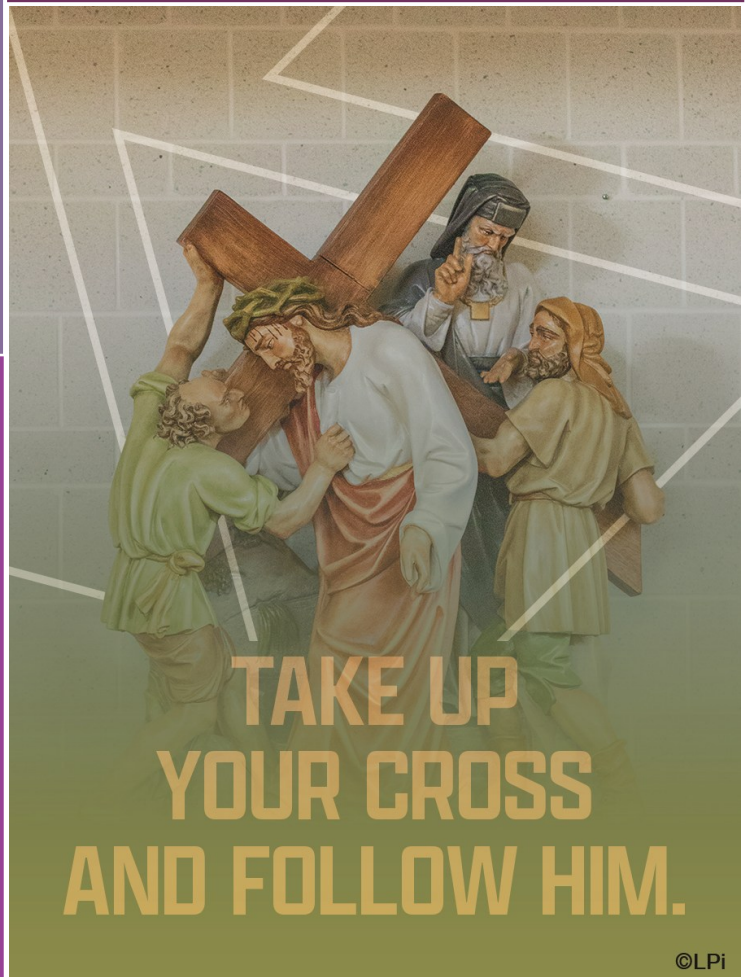

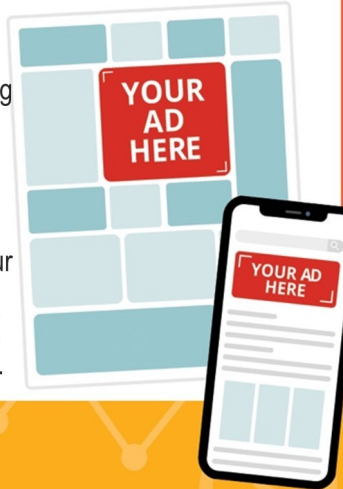
