LET US SHARE THE FAITH!

Dear friends in Christ,
Faith is a great gift. We know how our relationship with the Lord, our Catholic faith, our Church, and our parish, have nourished and enriched our lives and helped amid joys and sorrows. Faith in Jesus Christ sustains us in so many ways. Our faith and our relationship with Jesus, who has so convincingly demonstrated the Love of God, shouldn't be hidden! Our faith is meant to be shared. It is good news! The best news!

Jesus never ceased to invite others to follow him. Sometimes his invitations were ignored, sometimes accepted, and sometimes, even many times, vehemently rejected. Yet Jesus never stopped proposing the Gospel and inviting people to follow him. Jesus, entrusted this same mission - that of announcing the Good News of the kingdom - to the Apostles and to all of us, his disciples. We ought not to expect any better treatment than he got, but ought to have the same persistence and zeal to share what we have received.

WHO DO WE KNOW THAT MIGHT WANT TO BECOME CATHOLIC?

I want to encourage each of us to think of the circles we run in, the people we encounter, our family, our friends, acquaintances, coworkers, associates. Who is in need of Jesus? Who is in need of this new way of living, this new way of seeing the world, a relationship with the Lord, Christ's presence, mercy, grace in their lives? Then pray specifically for those persons. Ask God's help to be a witness, an instrument of God's grace, a proclaimer of God's word in their lives. Finally, ask the Holy Spirit to guide you, to place his word in your mouth to show you the way to approach and invite them. The Holy Spirit might encourage you to share a word of encouragement, to share a word of scripture, to share about events and services at our parish, to share a story of your life of faith, to share an article on Catholicism, or invite you to deeper prayer or conversion yourself. Then act on those promptings of the Holy Spirit.

BECOMING CATHOLIC SESSIONS START SOON

Very soon, the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA), the process by which adults are formed to become Catholic, to receive the sacraments and become full members of the Catholic Church, will begin soon. It starts with a period of inquiry and exploration of the faith, of each person's faith journey, and the questions people may have. If you know of someone who has been thinking about becoming Catholic and or simply might like to learn more, let them know about OCIA and invite

them to contact Deacon Reuben D'sa at St. Jude at reuben@stjude-redmond.org, or for Holy Innocents and St. Anthony contact Leticia Alexander, through the parish office. Consider offering to be that person's sponsor or attend some OCIA sessions with them.

**LET US PASS ON THE FAITH TO THE NEXT GENERATIONS**

Just as important is passing on the faith to the next generations. Starting up soon in September are our Faith Formation and Sacramental Preparation programs for children and youth. At the heart of all of these efforts is facilitating an encounter with Jesus Christ, Savior and Lord, the wellspring of love, joy and hope. All of our programs are aimed at supporting parents as the first and best teachers of the faith.

There are faith formation programs for children and wonderful teen groups forming to help our youth grow in their faith.

Be sure to sign up your second graders for preparation for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. If you have a 7th grader, this is the age for Confirmation. Please be sure to register 7th Graders, 8th Graders and any High School to prepare this wonderful sacrament of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit.

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



IS 22:19-23; PS 138:1-3, 6, 8; ROM 11:33-36; MT 16:13-20

Today's Gospel from Matthew invites us to examine whether our lives truly give God the glory He deserves. It begins with a question Jesus asks His disciples. First He asks, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" They offer several responses. Then Jesus makes the question personal: "But who do you say that I am?" Peter answers without hesitation: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

Jesus asks each of us that same question today. As Christian stewards and disciples, we would likely answer just as Peter did.

We believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God.

But does the way we live reflect that profession of faith? If we truly believe Christ came to save us from our sins and lead us to heaven, then our lives should proclaim that truth as clearly as our words. Do my priorities and ambitions reflect that Christ is my Savior? Does the way I use my time, talents, and treasure show that I am His disciple?

Every blessing God has entrusted to us is meant to be used for His glory. The greatest praise we can offer Him is a life lived in grateful response to His unfathomable love. That is the beauty and power of the stewardship way of life.

The Parish Family Advisory Council (PFAC) plays a key role in the Partners in the Gospel process by providing consultation to the pastor, as we become one parish.

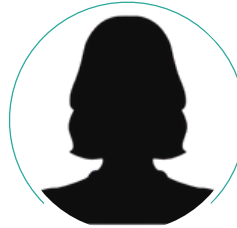

Frequently Asked Questions About the One Parish Plan Process

One Parish Planning

As part of Partners in the Gospel, the Archbishop has given to our three churches the mission of coming together as one parish and entrusted us with the task of figuring out how best to do this as we serve God and the people of Redmond, Duvall and Carnation. This is what the One Parish Planning process is all about. In the past year, we have been getting to know each other and working together in a number of concrete ways. This coming fall and throughout the rest of this year we will be engaging in a concerted effort of preparing this One Parish Plan. We will need your help and participation in this process. There will be surveys, listening sessions, and opportunities to provide your input. We very much will need that input—so we invite you to pay attention to parish media and announcements, so you can take an active part.

Q: Why One Parish Planning?

A: The One Parish Planning process will help parish families develop their vision and plan for how to re-envision parish life as they become one new canonical parish. All parish families in the archdiocese will be going through this process, and all parishioners will have the opportunity to participate.

Q: What is the timing for One Parish Planning?

A: This planning process will occur over the next 12 months to set the vision and plan for achieving it. The goal is to have the plan ready to submit next summer. This plan will outline activities and goals that can be accomplished over the following five years, once it is approved.

Q: Who is leading our Partners in the Gospel Process?

A: This process will be guided by the Parish Family Advisory Council and will act as the main consulting and working group for the pastor. They will be supported by the Parish Family Leadership Team comprised of staff from each parish, as well as support from Parish Liaisons and Chancery staff.

Soon we will be providing you more information on the schedule and events happen that will happen this fall. Please continue to pray for our parish family and the fruitfulness of this process, that through it we may grow in faith, hope, and love and together accomplish the mission Christ has entrusted to us all.

Q: How will people be involved in Partners in the Gospel?

A: This process is built on the foundational concept of co-responsibility, which means that all baptized are responsible for the mission of the Church. Everyone will have multiple opportunities to provide feedback, input and recommendations for how to re-envision parish life.

Q: What if we struggle to come to an agreement?

A: The Parish Family Advisory Council and Parish Family Leadership Team will use the input from parishioners to begin discerning the future. They will make recommendations and ultimately, after consultation and discernment, the pastor will make the final call on a topic that may not have clear consensus.

Q: How will decisions be communicated?

A: For each of the listening sessions, there will be an official synthesis of the feedback that was collected during the events that will be shared with the parish family. Additionally, as draft plans are created, they will be shared with the parish family for feedback. Be sure to read parish media for updates.

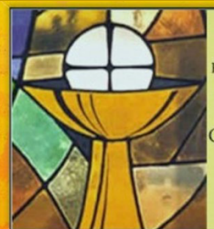

Parish Refugee Ministry Update Embracing with Compassion



St. Jude Parish continues to accompany refugee families with practical support, friendship, and welcoming community. Recently, parish volunteers hosted a joyful picnic for more than **12 Ukrainian families—over 40 people**. It was a peaceful afternoon of food, fellowship, and rest for families who are enduring displacement, uncertainty, and hardship. One family shared their

heartfelt gratitude, calling the gathering “a true celebration here in the USA” and “a beautiful, peaceful, and blessed time of rest.” Another mother expressed it even more eloquently: “Thank you for your mercy, your open hearts, and for generously sharing your love.” Their words remind us that this ministry is about far more than material assistance. It is about welcoming others with dignity, recognizing Christ in those who suffer, and helping families know they are not alone. **“For I was a stranger and you welcomed me.” — Matthew 25:35**

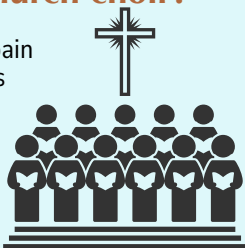
