Lady of Velankani Feast Day Celebration

Christianity has thrived in India since Saint Thomas the Apostle arrived in 52 A.D. In the 16th century, the Blessed Mother Mary appeared three times in Velankani, a coastal village in southern India, sparking hundreds of reported miracles.

For over 400 years, the annual feast on September 8th has drawn nearly 3 million pilgrims. The celebrations begin with flag hoisting, followed by nine days of novena, and culminate in a procession of Our Lady of Velankani's statue.

On November 3, 1962, Pope John XXIII elevated the shrine to Basilica status, calling it the "Lourdes of the East." Today, Velankani remains one of India's most visited religious sites, where Hindus, Muslims, and Christians worship together—a powerful symbol of faith, unity, and healing.
