Our new Thornbury Mayor, Helen Ball visited CTK last week. Helen had a tour of the school and visited all the classes to meet our wonderful children. She spent time with our Year 6 learners asking them about their views and comments on Thornbury and improvements which could be made to the area. Our Year 6 children had 24 points in which Thornbury could be improved and Helen responded by email to each point. Their main concerns were about the rubbish bins and recycling, more bike and pedestrian crossings in Thornbury, more nature space in the area, a train station, a greater range of shops, better access for disabled people and families with pushchairs, supporting the homeless, sports fields and the water at the Mundy's playing field.



Helen was very impressed at the children's concern for all members of the Thornbury Community especially the elderly.

Helen finished her visit with a whole school assembly and the children asked questions about her role as Mayor.

We hope Helen will be able to visit our school again.


