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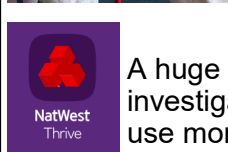

On Monday this week, Year 6 had Isobel from NATWEST Bank who came into our class to do a workshop all about fraud and how to stay safe using money. We all enjoyed investigating and finding out about how to deal with bank accounts and using a pin number.

The class also did some acting out scenarios from the bank. We had to create a scene where a person stole someone else's money or bank details. Two people pretended to be a witness and a police man or woman. We had to call them and tell them what the problem was and tell them to come and arrest the person who stole the money. It was SO much fun!

Isobel talked to us about lots of different things that could happen with money and our bank details. We learnt how to keep our bank details, pins and money to ourselves and to hide a pin when we put it in just in case anyone ever tried to steal any money from us or try to get our bank details. The Mental Health Support Team (MHST) is here to help your school to develop ways to look after the mental health of its students.

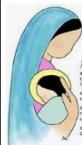

We want to share these tools with you so that you can look after your own wellbeing and build your resilience.
