NSPCC Speak out Stay Safe Assembly

A letter about the NSPCC Speak Out Stay Safe virtual assembly was sent out this week. The Speak out. Stay safe. is a programme for children aged 5-11 which aims to help children understand abuse in all its forms and to recognise the signs of abuse. Children are taught to speak out if they are worried, either to a safe adult or Childline.



This child friendly programme is aligned with the curriculum and consists of age-appropriate virtual assemblies and supporting classroom-based activities. The children will watch the virtual assembly on Monday 28th April with a follow up lesson during the week. Years 2, 5 and 6 will also have workshops on Monday 19th May led by NSPCC volunteers.

The content is delivered in an engaging and interactive way with the help of the NSPCC mascot Buddy.
