Sports Day at CTK:

Our Annual CTK Sports Day is on the morning of **Friday 23rd May** followed by a family picnic on the school field (weather permitting).



9:15am Reception and KS1 Sports day starts (the side gate on Easton Hill Road will be opened at 9:00am for families to come onto the school field)

10:45am Easton Hill Rd side gate will be opened for KS1 families to leave by the car park gate and KS2 families to ioin us on the school field.

11:00am KS2 Sports Day starts.

All families are welcome to join us on the field for the morning and to stay for a picnic at lunchtime. Our lunchtime will start at approximately 12:30pm to 1:15pm. At 10:45am, when the KS1 sports days finishes, the side gate on Easton Hill Road entrance (used by Breakfast Club) will be opened to let any KS2 families in and KS1 families who would like to leave. Everyone is welcome to return for lunchtime when the side gate will re-open at 12:30pm. The side gate cannot be opened during the sporting events due to safeguarding of the school community.

Please bring your own picnic rugs and chairs to sit on during sports day. The gate will be re-opened once KS2 Sports Day is finished for any families leaving or coming for the picnic. There will be no access out of the school grounds during lunchtime. Please if possible arrive on time as there will be no access to the school through the office area only the side gate.

Once the races are finished all children will return to their classes for a drink and will be brought out to join their families for lunch.

During the morning at CTK, no adults are allowed to enter the school and if you need the staff toilets you must be accompanied by a member of the school team. This is due to safeguarding all our children at CTK. Please bear in mind all staff will be supporting children during the morning and you may have to wait for a member of staff. There will be a member of staff standing by the hall door entrance and if there is no one there, please wait for their return. Due to safeguarding please do not wander into school without a member of staff.

Lunchtime for all children will start at 12:30pm and finish at 1:15pm approximately. Children will be coming from their classrooms onto the field and will only be allowed to sit with their families unless we have been notified of other arrangements, please email the school office. At 1:15pm, all children will be called by their class teacher to go into their classrooms for registration and leave school at 1:30pm by their classroom doors onto the KS1 playground except our Reception Class who leave by the Easton Hill Road Entrance. The school will close to all pupils at 1:30pm. There is no After School Club provision after Sports Day.

The local ice cream van will be available on the KS2 school Playground from approximately 12:45pm to 1:30pm.

All children to come into school wearing PE kits with appropriate trainers. All children run for their houses for points and they are welcome to wear a house coloured plain t-shirt. (red, blue, yellow and green).

The school kitchen is providing a picnic takeaway box which will include a ham or cheese rolls, a cookie and a piece of fruit, please order your child's meal on Parent Pay. If you are bringing a packed lunch for your child from home please click a packed lunch option on ParentPay for that day. Please could all meals be pre-ordered due to kitchen being unable to cater for extra picnic lunches on the day.

We are very much looking forward to our Sports Day.
